

#### Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!






#### From each fat quarter, cut:

three 5" x length of fabric strips, then subcut: twelve 5" squares

#### From the Binding Fabric, cut:

seven 2-1/2" x WOF strips

#### Assemble the Quilt



- **Step 1:** Arrange the units into fifteen rows of twelve squares. Note the fabric placement and block orientation in the Quilt Assembly Diagram.
- **Step 2:** Sew the blocks together to form rows. Press the rows to the left in the odd numbered rows and to the right in the even numbered rows.
- **Step 3:** Sew the rows together to form the quilt center. Press the row seams open.

Your quilt top is complete! Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!
