

Fabric and Supplies Needed

Fabric amounts based on yardage that is 42" wide.

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

Cutting Instructions

From Fabric A, cut:

twenty-five 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut: forty-two 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles forty-two 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles forty-two 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangles forty-two 2-1/2" squares

From Fabric B, cut:

seven 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut: one hundred-five 2-1/2" squares

From Fabric C, cut:

seven 2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim: two 2" x 70-1/2" side inner borders two 2" x 63-1/2" top/bottom inner borders

From Fabric D, cut:

two 5-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut: nine 5-1/2" squares seven 4" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim: two 4" x 73-1/2" side outer borders two 4" x 70-1/2" top/bottom outer borders

From each of Fabrics E-K, cut:

two 5-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut: nine 5-1/2" squares

From each of Fabrics L and M, cut:

one 5-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut: six 5-1/2" squares

From the Binding Fabric, cut:

eight 2-1/2" x WOF strips

Assemble the A Blocks



Step 1: Gather:

one 5-1/2" square from each of Fabrics D, E, F, and G


Arrange the units into two rows of two. Note the fabric placement in the Block Assembly Diagram.

Step 2: Sew the squares together to form the rows. Press the seams in opposite directions.

Step 3: Sew the rows together, nesting the seams and pressing the seams to one side to form the block.

The A Block should measure 10-1/2" square. Repeat to make a total of twenty-one A Blocks. Use a random assortment of prints, or carefully match print and locations with the blocks shown in the Quilt Assembly Diagram.

Assemble the B Blocks



Step 4: Gather: five Fabric B squares two Fabric A squares two Fabric A 4-1/2" rectangles two Fabric A 6-1/2" rectangles two Fabric A 8-1/2" rectangles

Arrange the units as shown.


Step 5: Sew the Fabric B squares to the ends of the units shown. Press toward Fabric B.

Step 6: Sew the three center units together to form the B Block center. Press.

Step 7: Sew the 6-1/2" Fabric A rectangles to the left and right edges of the Block center. Press.

Step 8: Sew the remaining units to the top and bottom edges of the Block center. Press.

The B Block should measure 10-1/2" square. Repeat to make a total of twenty-one B Blocks.









Assemble the Quilt



Step 9: Arrange the blocks into seven rows of six blocks. Note the fabric placement and block orientation in the Quilt Assembly Diagram.

Step 10: Sew the blocks together to form rows. Press the rows to the left in the odd numbered rows and to the right in the even numbered rows.

Step 11: Sew the rows together to form the quilt center. Press the row seams open.

Step 12: Sew the side inner borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom inner borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Step 13: Sew the side outer borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom outer borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Your quilt top is complete! Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!

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
