#### PIECED BLOCKS (TEMPLATE PIECING)

Note: Foundation piecing templates are provided for alternate method to construct the pieced blocks.

Refer to whole and half block diagrams to make the correct number and color of each.

Sew (2) A Template 2 pieces to the top right and bottom left sides of (1) B Template 3 piece, followed by (2) J Template 1 pieces to the top left and bottom right of same B piece to complete (1) Whole Block unit, measuring 8-1/2" x 14-1/2". Make (4).



2. Repeat Step 1 to make a total number of whole blocks for the following fabrics:



3. Sew (1) J Template 1 piece to the top and (1) A Template 2 piece to the bottom of (1) B Half Template 4 piece to complete (1) Half Block unit, measuring 8-1/2" x 7-1/2". Make (2).



#### **QUILT TOP ASSEMBLY**


- 5. Refer to quilt image for fabric placement and Half Block rotation. Arrange and sew together:
  - (5) Whole Blocks to make pieced rows 1, 3, 5, 7, 9, 11
  - (4) Whole Blocks and (2) Half Blocks to make pieced rows 2, 4, 6, 8, 10
- **6.** Sew together pieced rows to complete quilt top.







#### **QUILT DIAGRAM**




**FINISHING:** Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich. Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using **A** 2-1/4" strips.






