# Essentials Watercolor Texture



Throw Quilt: 59 1/2" x 74"

  
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Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning.

All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.

## 1. Cut the following:

*If using FAT CUTS, you may need to cut additional width-of-fabric strips.*


**Fabric A** - Cut (2) 4" strips, subcut (20) 4" squares


Cut (7) 3-1/2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 3-1/2" x 68-1/2" and (2) 3-1/2" x 60" borders

**Fabric B** - Cut (1) 4" strip, subcut (10) 4" squares

**Fabric C** - Cut (1) 4" strip, subcut (10) 4" squares  
Cut (8) 2-1/2" strips (binding)

**Fabrics D, E, F, G, H, I, J, and K** - From each fabric:

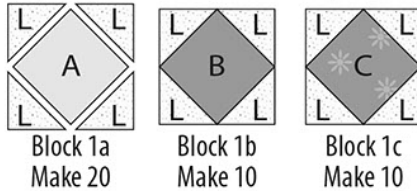
Cut (1) 6-1/4" strip, subcut (4) 6-1/4" squares then cut in half diagonally twice  for 16 triangles

**Fabric L** - Cut (18) 3-3/8" strips, subcut (208) 3-3/8" squares then cut in half  diagonally for 416 triangles

Cut (17) 2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (9) 2" x 65-1/2" strips and (2) 2" x 54" borders

## 2. Piecing Order:

1. Sew 4 **Fabric L** 3-3/8" triangles to a **Fabric A** 4" square. Make a total of 20 **Block 1a** (5-1/2" square unfinished). In the same manner, make 10 each **Blocks 1b** and **1c** with fabrics shown.



Block 1a Make 20      Block 1b Make 10      Block 1c Make 10

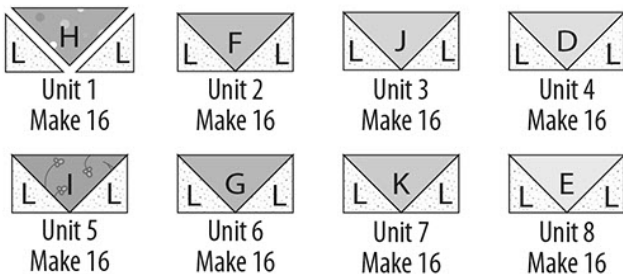
2. Sew 2

**Fabric L** 3-3/8" triangles

to short edges of a **Fabric D** 6-1/4" triangle.

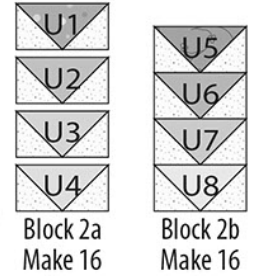
Make a total of 16 Unit 1 (3" x 5-1/2"

unfinished). In the same manner, make 16 each Units 2-8 with fabrics shown.



Unit 1 Make 16      Unit 2 Make 16      Unit 3 Make 16      Unit 4 Make 16  
Unit 5 Make 16      Unit 6 Make 16      Unit 7 Make 16      Unit 8 Make 16

3. Arrange 1 each Units 1-4 in a vertical row as shown.



Stitch into row. Make a total of 16 **Block 2a**

(5-1/2" x 10-1/2" unfinished).

In the same manner, make 16 **Block 2b** with Units 5-8.

4. Refer to Quilt Layout (Page 2) for arrangement and placement of blocks, strips, and borders.

5. Arrange blocks in 8 vertical rows. Stitch into rows (5-1/2" x 65-1/2" unfinished).

6. Alternate rows of blocks and 9 **Fabric L** 2" x 65-1/2" strips. Sew **Fabric L** strips and rows together (54" x 65-1/2" unfinished).

7. Sew **Fabric L** 2" x 54" borders to top and bottom of quilt.

8. Stitch **Fabric A** 3-1/2" x 68-1/2" borders to right and left sides of quilt. Add **Fabric A** 3-1/2" x 60" borders to top and bottom of quilt.

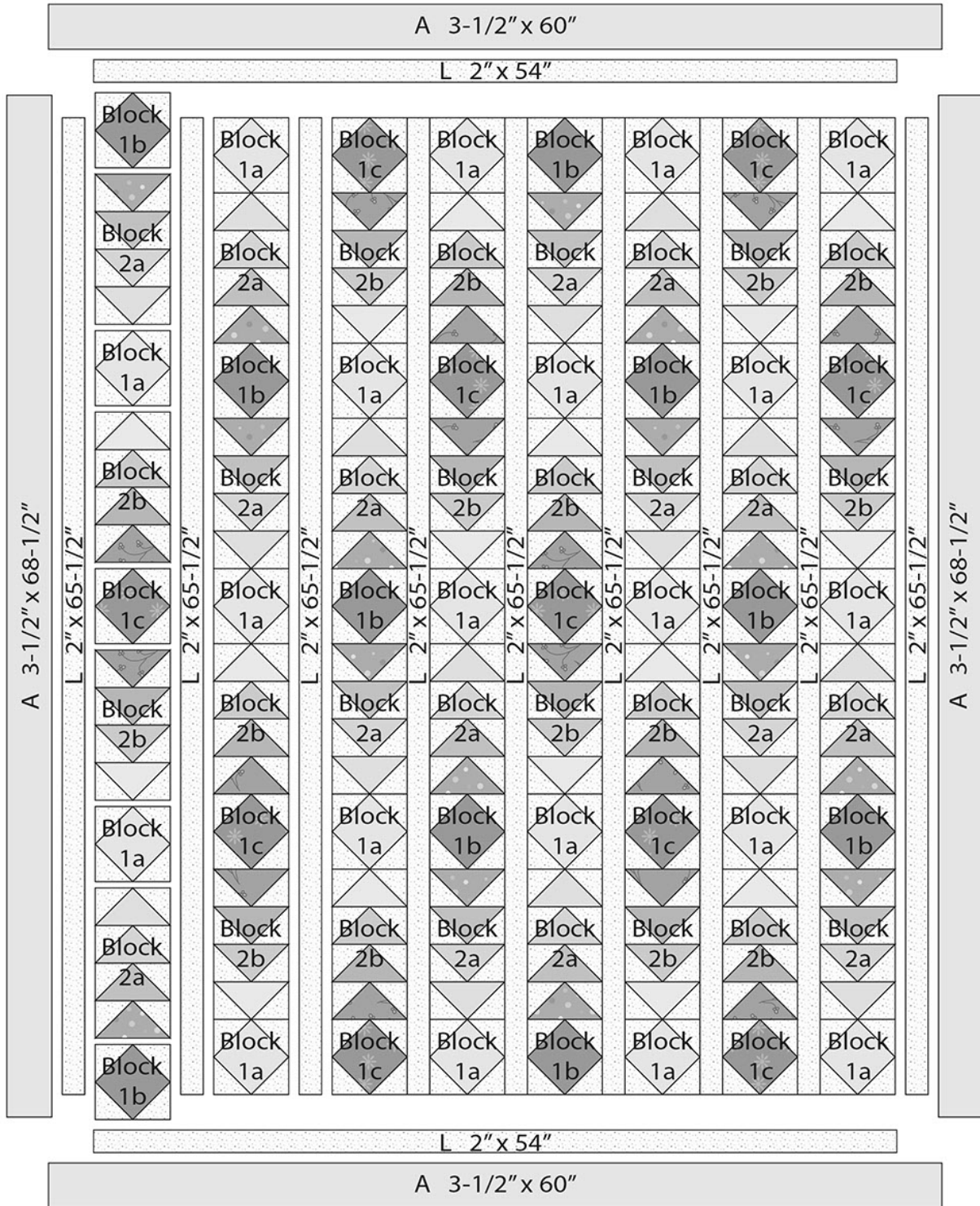
9. The quilt measures approximately 60" x 74-1/2" (unfinished). Make backing (**Fabric M**) approximately 8" larger than the top.

10. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric C**) and enjoy!!

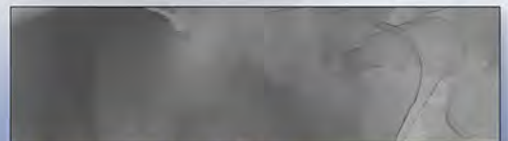
