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# Snow What Fun!

Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning.

All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.

## 1. Cut the following:

*If using FAT CUTS, you may need to cut additional width-of-fabric strips.*

**Fabric A** - PLEASE NOTE: Panels do not always print the size intended. For this pattern, the panel has a coping border added then trimmed so the panel will fit the quilt correctly.


Fussy cut 1/4" beyond outside edges of panel to approximately 23-1/2" x 42"


**Fabric B** - Referring to the quilt image, fussy cut strips, the length of fabric parallel to selvage: (2) 5-1/2" x 90" and (2) 5-1/2" x 66" scenic stripe borders and (2) 3" x 55" and (2) 3" x 34" presents stripe borders


**Fabric C** - Cut (1) 24-1/2" strip, subcut (4) 8-1/2" x 24-1/2" pieces  
Cut (2) 8-1/2" strips, subcut (2) 8-1/2" x 32-1/2" pieces

**Fabric D** - Cut (7) 2-1/2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 2-1/2" x 72-1/2" and (2) 2-1/2" x 52-1/2" borders  
Fussy cut (6) 4-1/2" squares with motifs centered

**Fabric E** - Cut (2) 3-1/4" strips, subcut (2) 3-1/4" x 27" strips  
Cut (8) 2-1/2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 2-1/2" x 86-1/2" and (2) 2-1/2" x 66-1/2" borders  
Cut (2) 2" strips


**Fabric F** - Cut (3) 8-1/2" strips, subcut (12) 8-1/2" squares, (1) 5-1/4" square [cut in half diagonally  twice for 4 triangles], and (12) 2-1/2" squares

**Fabrics G and J** - From each fabric:  
Cut (1) 3-1/4" strip, subcut (12) 3-1/4" squares then cut in half diagonally twice  for 48 triangles

**Fabric H** - Cut (1) 5-1/4" strip, subcut (1) 5-1/4" square then cut in half diagonally  twice for 4 triangles. Cut remaining strip into (2) 2-1/2" x 32" strips, subcut (24) 2-1/2" squares  
Cut (2) 3" strips, subcut (2) 3" x 32-1/2" strips

**Fabric H** - (continued)

Cut (9) 2-1/2" strips (binding)  
Cut (3) 1-1/2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 1-1/2" x 51-1/2" strips

**Fabric I** - Cut (2) 6-1/2" strips, subcut (12) 6-1/2" squares  
Cut (1) 5-1/4" strip, subcut (5) 5-1/4" squares then cut in half diagonally  twice for 20 triangles

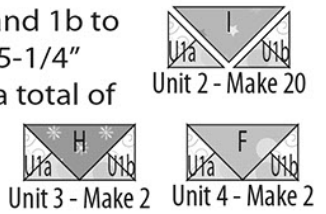
NOTE: Not all Fabrics F and H 5-1/4" triangles are used.

## 2. Piecing Order:

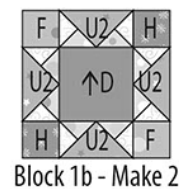
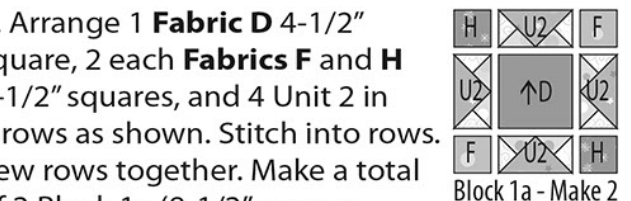
1. Sew 1 each **Fabrics G and J** 3-1/4" triangles together along 1 short edge as shown to make a total of 24 each Units 1a and 1b (2-7/8" x 2-7/8" x 4-1/8" unfinished).



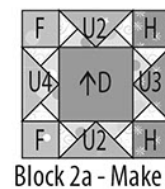
2. Stitch 1 each Units 1a and 1b to short edges of a **Fabric I** 5-1/4" triangle as shown. Make a total of 20 Unit 2 (2-1/2" x 4-1/2" unfinished). In the same manner, make 2 each Units 3 and 4 with 5-1/4" triangle indicated.



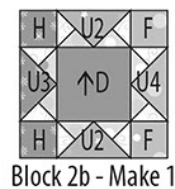
3. Arrange 1 **Fabric D** 4-1/2" square, 2 each **Fabrics F and H** 2-1/2" squares, and 4 Unit 2 in 3 rows as shown. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 2 Block 1a (8-1/2" square unfinished). In the same manner, make 2 **Block 1b** and 1 each Blocks 2a and 2b with fabrics and units indicated.

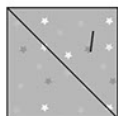

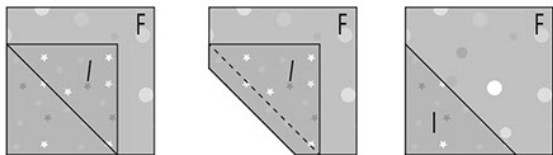
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4. Draw a diagonal line across the wrong side of all **Fabric I** 6-1/2" squares and remaining **Fabric H** 2-1/2" squares.

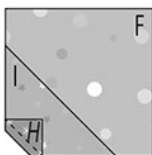


*Letters in italics indicate wrong side of fabric.*

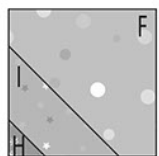
5. Arrange a marked **Fabric I** 6-1/2" square right sides together on a **Fabric F** 8-1/2" square as shown. Stitch along the marked line. Trim seam allowance to 1/4". Press corner out.



6. Arrange a marked **Fabric H** 2-1/2" square right sides together on the **Fabric I** corner on unit from Step 5 as shown. Stitch along the marked line. Trim seam allowance to 1/4". Press corner out.

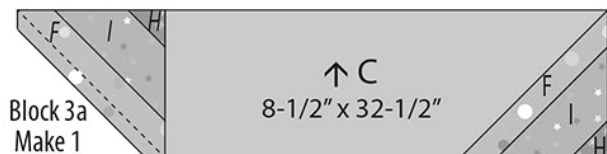


7. Repeat Steps 5 and 6 to make a total of 12 Unit 5 (8-1/2" square unfinished). Draw a diagonal line across the wrong side of **Fabric F** corner to corner, parallel to the seams.



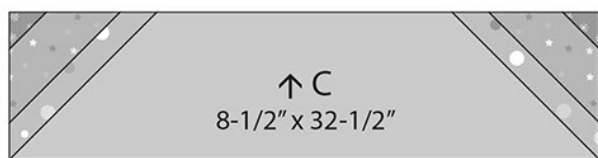
Unit 5 - Make 12

8. Arrange 2 Unit 5 right sides together on bottom corners of a **Fabric C** 8-1/2" x 32-1/2" piece. Stitch along marked lines. Trim seam allowances to 1/4". Press corners out to complete **Block 3a** (8 1/2" x 32 1/2" unfinished).



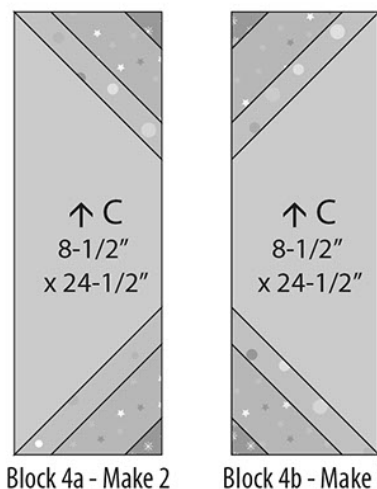

9. In the same manner, make 1 **Block 3b** with 2 Unit 5 added to top corners.

10. In the same manner, make 2 each **Blocks 4a** and **4b** each with 2 Unit 4 and **Fabric C** 8-1/2" x 24-1/2" piece as shown (8-1/2" x 24-1/2" unfinished).



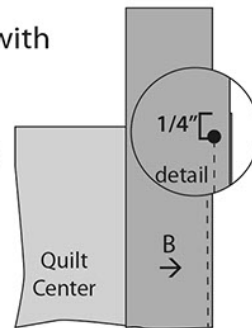

11. Refer to Quilt Layout (Page 4) for arrangement and placement of panel, strips, blocks, and borders.

12. Stitch **Fabric E** 2" x width of fabric strips to sides of the **Fabric A** panel. Trim strip ends even. Add 3-1/4" x 27" **Fabric E** strips to top and bottom of panel. **Trim bordered panel to 25-1/2" x 46-1/2" (unfinished).**

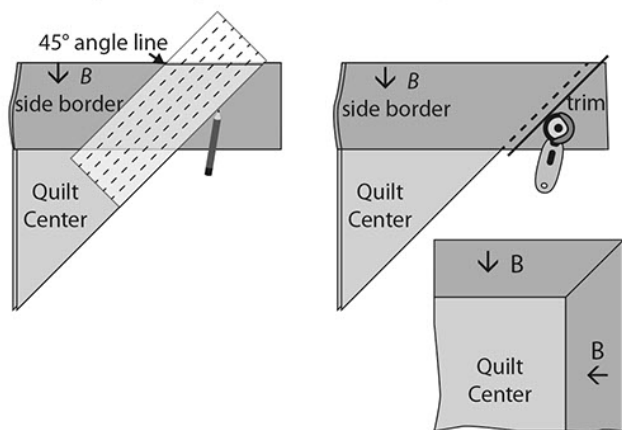
13. Center **Fabric B** 3" x 55" borders on right and left sides of bordered panel and **Fabric B** 5" x 34" borders on top and bottom of bordered panel with top of print next to quilt center. Stitch borders to sides starting and stopping 1/4" from corners of bordered panel. Do not trim. Press borders out.

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14. Working with 1 corner at a time, fold the quilt right sides together so the outside edges of the borders line up. Using a 45-degree ruler, mark from the end of border seams to outer edges of borders. Stitch along marked line. Trim seam allowance to 1/4". Press corner seam open. Repeat on remaining corners.



15. Sew **Fabric H** 1-1/2" x 51-1/2" borders to right and left sides of mitered border. Add **Fabric H** 3" x 32-1/2" borders to top and bottom of mitered border. Quilt center measures 32-1/2" x 56-1/2" (unfinished).

16. Arrange 1 **Block 2a** and 2 **Block 4a** in a vertical row on the left side of quilt center. Stitch together into left border (8-1/2" x 56-1/2" unfinished). Sew to left side of quilt center.

17. Arrange 1 **Block 2b** and 2 **Block 4b** in a vertical row on the right side of quilt center. Stitch together into right border (8-1/2" x 56-1/2" unfinished). Sew to right side of quilt center.

18. Arrange 1 each **Blocks 1a, 1b,** and **3a** in a vertical row above the quilt center. Stitch together into top border (8-1/2" x 48-1/2" unfinished). Sew to top of quilt center.

19. Arrange 1 each **Blocks 1a, 1b,** and **3b** in a vertical row below quilt center. Stitch together into bottom border (8-1/2" x 48-1/2" unfinished). Sew to bottom of quilt center.

20. Sew **Fabric D** 2-1/2" x 72-1/2" borders to right and left sides of quilt. Add **Fabric D** 2-1/2" x 52-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt.

21. Referring to Steps 13 and 14, add **Fabric B** 5-1/2" x 90" borders to sides and **Fabric B** 5-1/2" x 66" borders to top and bottom of quilt.

22. Sew **Fabric E** 2-1/2" x 86-1/2" borders to right and left sides of quilt. Add **Fabric E** 2-1/2" x 66-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt.

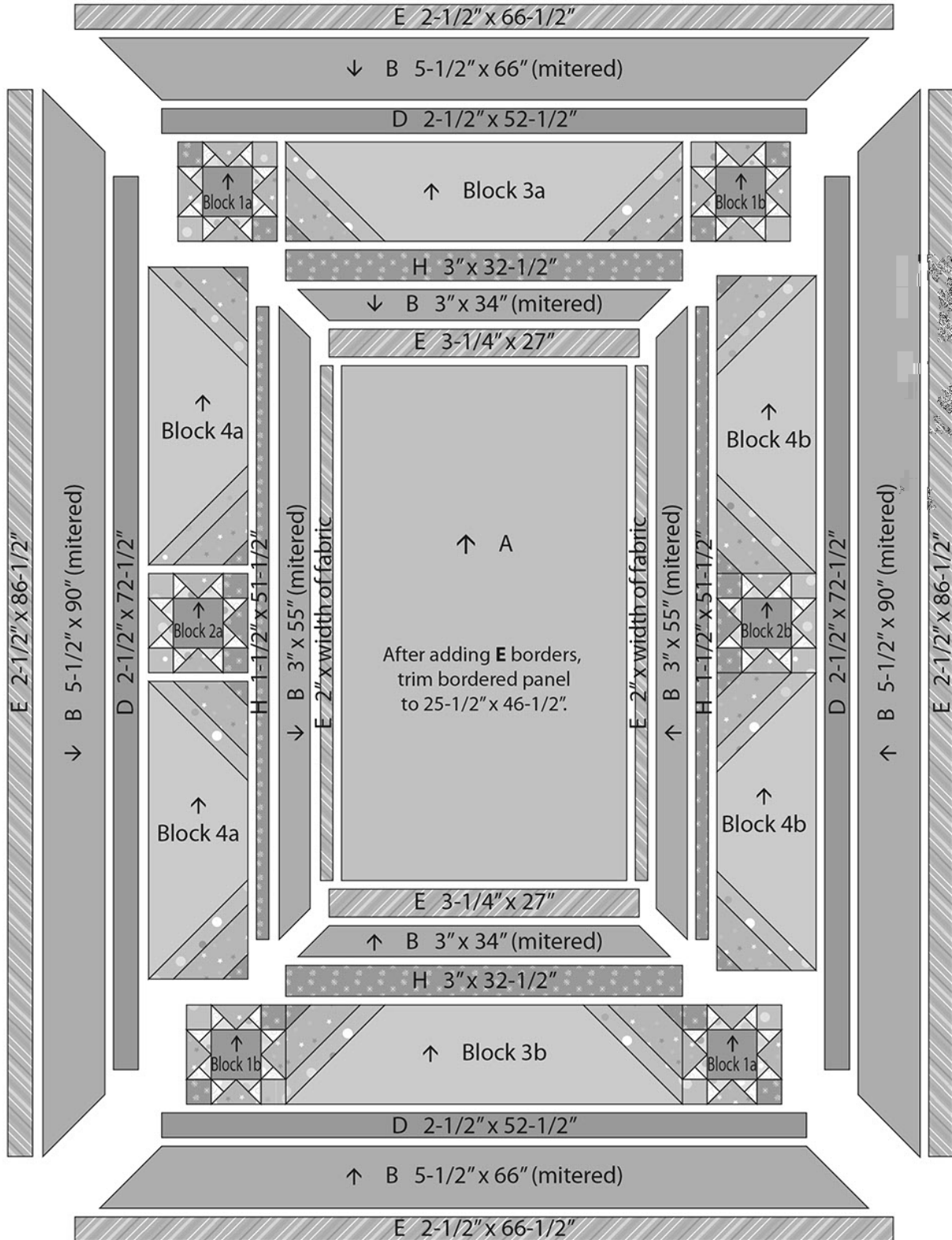
23. The quilt measures approximately 66-1/2" x 90-1/2" (unfinished). Make backing (**Fabric J**) approximately 8" larger than the top.

24. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric H**) and enjoy!!
