

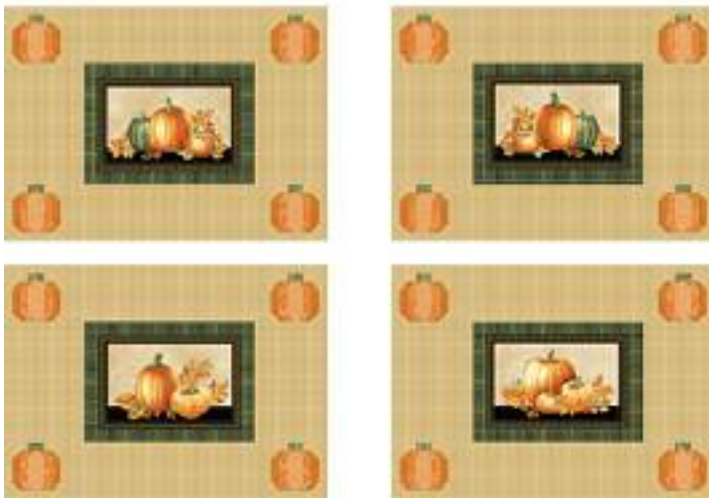

## Autumn Elegance & Wave Texture Jackie Robinson & Benartex



### Yardage & Cutting- Cont

Wave Texture Tangerine (2966-39) 1/4 yd

Cut (1) 3" strip into:

(40) 3" x 1"

Cut (2) 1" strips into:

(80) 1" squares

Tonal Plaid Bisque (1671-07) 1-1/8 yds

Cut (1) 8" strip into:

(8) 8" x 5"

Cut (5) 4" strips into:

(2) 4" x 22"

(2) 4" x 16"

(8) 4" x 13-1/2"

Cut (1) 4" strip into:

(20) 4" x 1"

(20) 3-1/2" x 1"

Cut (1) 1-1/2" strip into:

(40) 1-1/2" x 1"

Cut (2) 1" strips into:

(80) 1" squares

Pumpkin Allover Bisque (1669M-07) 1-5/8 yds

Cut (2) 15" strips into:

(4) 15" x 20-1/2" Placemat Backings

Cut (1) 23" strip into:

(1) 23" x 29" Runner Backing

Pellon Fleece – or similar firm poly filler 1-1/2 yds

Cut (2) 15" strips into:

(4) 15" x 20-1/2" Placemat Batting

Cut (1) 23" strip into:

(1) 23" x 29" Runner Batting

### Yardage & Cutting:

Number in parenthesis is the quantity to cut

Autumn Elegance Panel (1664M-99) 1 panel

Fussy Cut (1) 22" x 16" Large Motif

Fussy Cut (4) 11" x 8" Small Motifs

Garden Vine Med Basil (6124-46) 1/8 yd

Cut (1) 1" strip into:

(20) 1" x 1-1/2"

Damask Diamond Lt Tangerine (1673-37) 1/8 yd

Cut (1) 3" strip into:

(20) 3" x 1-1/2"

Garden Vine Med Tangerine (6124-38) 1/4 yd

Cut (1) 3" strip into:

(40) 3" x 1"

Cut (2) 1" strips into:

(80) 1" squares

### Construction:

This project uses precise 1/4" seams. To test your seam allowance, accurately cut (2) 1-1/2" x 3" rectangles. Stitch them together along the 3" length. Measure across the unit. It should be exactly 2-1/2" wide. If not, adjust your seam and repeat.

These instructions 'assume' you are making the runner and 4 placemats, and that you will be making all 20 of the small pumpkins.

1. Make 20 tiny Pumpkins, Begin by diagonally stitching four 1" squares of Garden Vine Med Tangerine to the 1-1/2" x 3" Damask Diamond Lt Tangerine. After stitching the first square, you'll need to trim it and fold it in place before adding the second one at each end. Make 20.



2. Diagonally stitch 1" squares of Wave Texture Tangerine to each end of the 1" x 3" Garden Vine Med Tangerine, as shown. Make 40.



3. Diagonally stitch 1" squares of Tonal Plaid Bisque to each end of the 1" x 3" Wave Texture Tangerine, as shown. Make 40



4. Stitch Steps 1-3 together, creating 20 pumpkin bodies measuring 3-1/2" x 3" from raw edge to raw edge.



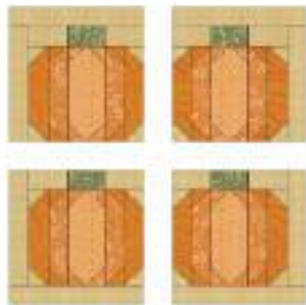
5. Make Stem tops for these tiny Pumpkins by joining 1" x 1-1/2" Garden Vine Med Basil between a pair of 1" x 1-1/2" Tonal Plaid Bisque. Add to the top of the tiny Pumpkins.



6. Attach a 3-1/2" x 1" Tonal Plaid Bisque to the right side edge of (10) of the pumpkins, and to the left edge of (10) pumpkins.



7. Sew a 4" x 1" Tonal Plaid Bisque to the upper edge of (5) of the Step 6 right edge, and (5) of the Step 6 left edge. Stitch the remaining 4" x 1" Tonal Plaid Bisque pieces to the lower edge of the remaining (5) and (5). This will prepare them for all the corners.



8. To complete the Runner top, stitch a 4" x 16" Tonal Bisque Plaid to both side of the 22" x 16" center motif. These seams go toward the Bisque.



9. Lay out one of each of the corner small pumpkins so the narrow strips from Step 7 are on the outer corners. Sew a 4" x 22" Tonal Plaid Bisque between the two upper corner pumpkins, and another between the lower corner pumpkins. Direct the seams toward the large Bisque pieces.



10. Stitch the Step 9 units above and below the Step 8 Center section. Press.



11. To complete the Placemats, stitch an 8" x 5" Tonal Bisque Plaid to both side edges of the 11" x 8" panel pieces. Make 4. Direct the seams toward the Bisque.



12. Lay out one of each of the corner small pumpkins so the narrow strips from Step 7 are on the outer corners. Sew a 4" x 13-1/2" Tonal Plaid Bisque between the two upper corner pumpkins, and another between the lower corner pumpkins. Direct the seams toward the large Bisque pieces. Make (4) of each.



13. Stitch the Step 12 units above and below the Step 11 Center sections. Make (4). Press.



14. Place the runner face up on a surface. Put its backing face down on top, and add the Pellon fleece on the very top. Leaving an opening to turn it right side out, stitch around all four sides. Trim the corners, and turn right side out.

15. Close the opening area by hand. Top stitch around the entire edge.

Repeat Steps 14 & 15 to complete the (4) Placemats.
