HIGH HORSE PANEL QUILT

FINISHED QUILT SIZE 57" x 75"

Measurements include ¼" seam allowance.

Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated.

Please check our website www.rileyblakedesigns.com/pattern-updates for any revisions before starting this project. This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting technique and terminology. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric.

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

1 PD11120 Foothills Panel
1 PPD11125 Horses Pillow Panel
1 Yard C200 Phantom Shades
5/8 Yard C7017 Brown Fence (Binding)
6" x 21" of Each:
C130 Evergreen Trento
C5573 Yellow Forest
C5573 Green Forest
C5573 Dk Green Forest
C7015 Tan Bark
C7016 Yellow Grass
C7017 Tan Fence
C7017 Brown Fence
C7755 Tan Pinewood Grain
C7755 Lt Brown Pinewood Grain
C7755 Brown Pinewood Grain

CUTTING REQUIREMENTS

Please read instructions first before cutting.
WOF - width of fabric.

Label pieces as they are cut.

Foothills Panel

Fussy cut 1 Center Panel 43½" x 35½", centered over the panel.

Horses Pillow Panel

Fussy cut 4 Small Panels 19½" x 16½", centered over the 4 pillow designs.

Evergreen Trento, Yellow Forest, Green Forest, Yellow Grass, Tan Fence, Tan Pinewood Grain, Lt Brown Pinewood Grain, and Brown Pinewood Grain

Cut 2 squares 5½" x 5½" of each print. (A)

Dk Green Forest, Tan Bark

Cut 3 squares 5½" x 5½" of each print. (A)

Phantom Shades

Cut 3 strips 2½" x WOF for Top and Bottom Border 2.

Cut 6 strips 2½" x WOF.

Sub-cut from strips:

4 - 2½" x 19½" rectangles (B)

8 - 2½" x 18½" rectangles (C)

Cut 8 strips 1½" x WOF.

Sub-cut from strips:

4 - 1½" x 35½" rectangles (D)

2 - 1½" x 18½" rectangles (E)

22 - 1½" x 5½" rectangles (F)

Brown Fence

Cut 1 strip 5½" x WOF.

Sub-cut from strip:

2 - 5½" squares (A)

Cut 7 strip 2¼" x WOF for Binding.

QUILT ASSEMBLY

Refer to the quilt photo and layout diagram for the placement of prints.

Borders

Press seam allowances as indicated in the diagrams unless otherwise stated.

Border 1

Sew together 6 A squares, alternating with 5 F rectangles. Sew a D rectangle to each side. Repeat to make 2 Side Borders (7½" x 35½").

Sew Side Borders to each side of the Center Panel. Press seam allowances towards the Center Panel (57½" x 35½").

Sew a B rectangle to the bottom of 1 Small Panel. Sew a C rectangle to each side. Repeat to make 2 Top Corner Panels (23½" x 18½").

Sew a B rectangle to the top of 1 Small Panel. Sew a C rectangle to each side. Repeat to make 2 Bottom Corner Panels (23½" x 18½").

Sew together 3 A squares alternating with 3 F rectangles. Repeat to make 4 Unit 1 (5½" x 18½").

HIGH HORSE PANEL QUILT

Sew an E rectangle between 2 Unit 1. Repeat to make 2 Centers (11½" x 18½").

Sew 1 Center between the 2 Top Corner Panels to make the Top Border (57½" x 18½"). Sew to the top of the Center Panel. Press seam allowances toward the Center Panel.

Sew 1 Center between the 2 Bottom Corner Panels to make the Bottom Border (57½" x 18½"). Sew to the bottom of the Center Panel. Press seam allowances toward the Center Panel.

Border 2

Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces.

Top and bottom borders only. Should measure 57½".

Finish quilt by layering the quilt top, batting, and back. Bind with the Brown Fence. Have fun with your colors and enjoy the journey of making your quilt.
