
Watercolor Floral Bed Runner

Fabric A 80640-37	3/4 yd	Cut 3 – 6 ½" x WOF strips • Sub-cut 14 – 6 ½" squares Cut 6 – 2 ½" x WOF strips (outer border)
Fabric B 80642-12	3/4 yd	Cut 3 – 6 ½" x WOF strips • Sub-cut 14 – 6 ½" squares
Fabric C 81000-1002	1 1/4 yds	Cut 11 – 1 ½" x WOF strips • Sub-cut 26 – 1 ½" x 6 ½" strips & 26 – 1 ½" x 8 ½" strips Cut 5 – 1 ½" x WOF strips (inner border) Cut 6 – 2 ¼" x WOF strips (binding)
Fabric D 80644-57	1/3 yd	Cut 6 – 1 ½" x WOF strips • Sub-cut 14 – 1 ½" x 6 ½" strips & 14 – 1 ½" x 7 ½" strips
Fabric E 80644-56	1/3 yd	Cut 6 – 1 ½" x WOF strips • Sub-cut 14 – 1 ½" x 7 ½" strips & 14 – 1 ½" x 8 ½" strips
Backing	2 1/3 yds	No cutting required.

Requirements for Mint Aqua Colorway:

SKU #'s	Yardage	Cutting Instructions
Fabric A 80642-85	3/4 yd	Cut 3 – 6 ½" x WOF strips • Sub-cut 14 – 6 ½" squares
Fabric B 80640-60	1 1/4 yds	Cut 3 – 6 ½" x WOF strips • Sub-cut 14 – 6 ½" squares Cut 6 – 2 ½" x WOF strips (outer border)
Fabric C 80645-25	1 1/4 yds	Cut 11 – 1 ½" x WOF strips • Sub-cut 26 – 1 ½" x 6 ½" strips & 26 – 1 ½" x 8 ½" strips Cut 5 – 1 ½" x WOF strips (inner border) Cut 6 – 2 ¼" x WOF strips (binding)
Fabric D 81300-63	1/3 yd	Cut 6 – 1 ½" x WOF strips • Sub-cut 14 – 1 ½" x 6 ½" strips & 14 – 1 ½" x 7 ½" strips
Fabric E 80641-60	1/3 yd	Cut 6 – 1 ½" x WOF strips • Sub-cut 14 – 1 ½" x 7 ½" strips & 14 – 1 ½" x 8 ½" strips
*80291-61	2 1/3 yds	No cutting required.

NOTE: Use a 1/4" seam allowance for all piecing. Diagrams are shown for the Sangria version of the quilt. The Mint Aqua version is made in the same way.

Block 1 Assembly:

With right sides together, sew a Fabric D 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strip to one side of a Fabric A 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " square. Add a Fabric D 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 7 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strip to one perpendicular side.

With right sides together, add a Fabric E $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x 7 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strip, then a Fabric E $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strip to the same two sides as in Step 1. This completes Block 1. Repeat to make 14 Block 1's.

Block 2 Assembly:

With right sides together, sew a Fabric C 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strip to opposites sides of a Fabric B 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " square. Then add Fabric C 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips to the remaining two sides. This completes Block 2. Repeat to make 13 Block 2's.

Quilt Top Assembly:

 Sew blocks together to make 9 vertical rows of 3 blocks each, alternating Block 1 & block 2 as shown below. Press seams in one direction for Row 1, and in the opposite direction for Row 2. This will make seams nest when sewing the rows together.



Continue alternating Row 1 & Row 2, ending with a Row 1.

- 2. Sew rows together to complete the center of the quilt top.
- 3. Sew the Fabric C 1 ½" x WOF strips together. Cut two inner border strips for the long sides (approximately 72 ½" at this point). With right sides together, sew these strips to the long edges of the quilt top. Cut two inner border strips for the short sides (approximately 26 ½" at this point). Add to quilt top in the same manner.
- 4. Sew the Fabric A (Sangria) or Fabric B (Mint Aqua) 2 ½" x WOF strips together. Cut two outer border strips for the long sides (approximately 74 ½" at this point). With right sides together, sew these strips to the long edges of the quilt top. Cut two outer border strips for the short sides (approximately 30 ½" at this point). Add to quilt top in the same manner.
- 5. Prepare binding from the Fabric C 2 ¼" x WOF strips. Layer quilt top with batting & backing. Quilt and bind as desired.
