Requirements

Fabrics from the Castle Spooky collection

- 1. A572.1 Castle Spooky on orange fat 1/4
- 2. A573.2 Spooky ghosts on blue fat 1/4
- 3. A574.1 Spooky pumpkins on light grey fat 1/4
- 4. A575.2 Bats on grey fat 1/4
- 5. A576.1 Cobwebs & cats on light grey fat 1/4
- 6. A572.2 Castle Spooky on night blue fat 1/4
- 7. A573.3 Spooky ghosts on black fat 1/4
- 8. A574.2 Spooky pumpkins on blue fat 1/4
- 9. A575.1 Bats on blue fat 1/4
- 10. A576.2 Cobwebs & cats on purple blue fat 1/4
- 11. BB110 Bumbleberries Rock 1½ yds 1.40
- 12. BB20 Bumbleberries Black 1 yd 1mtr
- 13. BB277 Bumbleberries Rainbow blue -1 yd -

Wadding and backing 64" 76"

All measurements include ½" seam allowances; press each seam as you go. you will need to join your strips to get the length on the border.

Cutting

From each of the fabrics 1 to 10 cut

5 x 5" x 5" cut a diagonal from bottom left to top right 5 x 5" x 5" cut a diagonal from top left to bottom right

From fabric 11 cut

2 x 2½" x 68½" side borders

 $2 \times 2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 60" top and bottom

5 x 2" x 68½" sashing strips


From fabric 12 cut

48 x 5" x 5" cut in half diagonally once 4 x 4½" x 4½"

From fabric 13 cut

 48×5 " x 5" cut in half diagonally once $4 \times 4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ "

Making up the blocks



Lay out your triangle fabric pieces as in the main diagram. Take two triangle pieces and sew them together to make a square, press and then trim to a

4½" x 4½" square.





On two sets you will not use the background fabric to make up the square.

When you have made all the blocks lay out in rows as in the main diagram. Stitch down the rows, press the seams in the opposite way on each row. This will help when sewing your rows together. Two rows of block with sashing in between.

Sew all the rows and sashing together.

Next add the border strips to the sides, then the top and bottom strips.

Quilting

Sandwich quilt top, wadding and backing together. Quilt by hand or machine as desired. Trim backing and wadding to size of quilt.

Binding

Use your favorite method from fabric 11 to bind the quilt.

- 10. A576.3 Cobwebs & cats on grey fat1/4
- 11. BB283 Bumbleberries Dark skies 11/2 yds

Wadding and backing 64" 76"

All measurements include ¼" seam allowances; press each seam as you go. you will need to join your strips to get the length on the border.

Cutting

From each of the fabrics 1 to 10 cut

5 x 5" x 5" cut a diagonal from bottom left to top right 5 x 5" x 5" cut a diagonal from top left to bottom right

From fabric 11 cut

2 x 2½" x 68½" side borders 2 x 2½" x 60" top and bottom 5 x 2" x 68½" sashing strips


From fabric 12 cut

 48×5 " x 5" cut in half diagonally once $4 \times 4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ "

From fabric 13 cut

 48×5 " x 5" cut in half diagonally once $4 \times 4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ "

Making up the blocks



Lay out your triangle fabric pieces as in the main diagram. Take two triangle pieces and sew them together to make a square, press and then trim to a $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " square.









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Quilting

Sandwich quilt top, wadding and backing together. Quilt by hand or machine as desired. Trim backing and wadding to size of quilt.
