

Cutting Instructions:

Please read all instructions carefully before beginning. Strips are cut across the width of fabric (perpendicular to selvedges) unless otherwise stated. All seams are sewn with a 1/4" seam unless otherwise stated. Label all pieces. LOF = length of fabric.

From Fabric A:

 Cut one 16" x 21" rectangles, centering large panel. Panel blocks are used in the larger Chickadee Songs quilt.

From Fabric B:

1. Cut two 2 1/2" strips. Subcut twenty-two 2 1/2" squares. (Blocks)

From Fabric C:

1. Cut one 2 1/2" strip. Subcut eight 2 1/2" squares and sixteen 2" x 2 1/2" rectangles. (Blocks)

From Fabric D:

1. Cut one 2 1/2" strip. Subcut four 2 1/2" squares and eight 2" x 2 1/2" rectangles. (Blocks)

From Fabric E:

- 1. Cut three 1 1/4" strips. Subcut two 1 1/4" x 20 1/2" and two 1 1/4" x 24 1/2" strips. (Third Border)
- 2. Cut six 2 1/2" strips. Subcut forty-four 2 1/2" squares and eighty-eight 1 1/2" x 2 1/2" rectangles. (Blocks)
- 3. Cut four 2" strips. Subcut two 2" x 33 1/2" and two 2" x 35 1/2" strips. (Fifth Border)

From Fabric F:

1. Cut one 2 1/2" strip. Subcut eight 2 1/2" squares and sixteen 1 1/2" x 2 1/2" rectangles. (Blocks)

From Fabric G:

1. Cut one 2 1/2" strip. Subcut eight 2 1/2" squares and sixteen 1 1/2" x 2 1/2" rectangles. (Blocks)

From Fabric H:

1. Cut two 2 1/2" strips. Subcut eight 2 1/2" squares and sixteen 1 1/2" x 2 1/2" rectangles. (Blocks)

From Fabric I:

- 1. Cut one 2 1/2" strip. Subcut eight 2 1/2" squares and sixteen 1" x 2 1/2" rectangles. (Blocks)
- 2. Cut three 1" strips. Subcut two 1" x 19" and two 1" x 23" strips. (Second Border)
- 3. Cut five 2 1/4" strips for binding. (Binding)

From Fabric J:

1. Cut four 1 1/2" strips. Subcut two 1 1/2" x 18" and two 1 1/2" x 21" strips. (First Border)

Piecing Instructions:

Inner Border Blocks

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of one 2 1/2" E square. Place square, right sides together, with one 2 1/2" print square. Sew 1/4" away from both sides of drawn line. Cut along drawn line to yield two half-square-triangle (HST) units. Align diagonal seams of HST units against 45 degree line on quilting ruler, trim HST units to measure 2" x 2" raw edge to raw edge (Figure 1). Make a total of four HST units.

2. Sew together one 1" x 2 1/2" print rectangle and one 1 1/2" x 2 1/2" E rectangle to make one middle unit (Figure 2). Make a total of four middle units.

3. Sew two HST units to the opposite short sides of one middle unit to make a row unit. Make a total of two row units (Figure 3).

4. Sew two middle units to the left and right sides of one 2 1/2" B square to make a row unit (Figure 4).

5. Sew together row units to complete one block. Block measures 5 1/2" square unfinished (Figure 5).



6. Make a total number of blocks for the following prints (Figure 6).

Quilt Assembly:

- 1. Inner border #1. Sew two 1 1/2" x 21" J strips to the left and right sides of one 16" x 21" A panel, followed by two 1 1/2" x 18" J strips to the top and bottom of quilt center.
- 2. Inner border #2. Sew two 1" x 23" I strips to the left and right sides of quilt center, followed by two 1" x 19" I strips to the top and bottom of quilt center.

- 3. Inner border #3. Sew two 1 1/4" x 24" E strips to the left and right sides of quilt center, followed by two 1 1/4" x 20 1/2" E strips to the top and bottom of quilt center.
- 4. Inner border #4. Refer to quilt diagram for block placement guide, arrange and sew together five pieced blocks to make a column unit. Make two column units, and sew to left and right sides of quilt center. Then, arrange and sew together six pieced blocks to make a row unit. Make two row units, and sew to the top and bottom of quilt center.
- 5. Outer border. Sew two 2" x 35 1/2" E strips to the left and right sides of quilt center, followed by two 2" x 33 1/2" E strips to the top and bottom of quilt center to complete quilt top.

Finishing

- 1. Prepare backing to measure 41" x 46".
- 2. Layer quilt top, batting, and backing. Baste layers together.
- 3. Quilt as desired.
- 4. Trim layers even with quilt top squaring corners.
- Join five 2 1/4" I binding strips with diagonal seams. Press seams open. Press strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together to make double-fold binding. Attach binding to quilt using your favorite method.
- 6. Make a label and sew to the back of the quilt.
