



Fabric 1	10070-Z	2-1/4 yards*
Fabric 2	10077-P *includes binding	1 yard
Fabric 3	110076-P	3/4 yard
Fabric 4	10076-G	3/4 yard
Fabric 5	P126-UW	2 yards
Fabric 6	10072-P	1-1/4 yards
Backing	10077-Q *used for pieced backing on p.8	4-1/2 yards

*Fabric 1: you will need 3 repeats, which will give you extra blue & orange blocks.

Pieced Backing: see the diagram on p.8 for details.



Block 1: Make 6



Block 2: Make 6

WOF - Width of Fabric LOF - Length of Fabric RST - Right Sides Together HST - Half Square Triangle

Cutting

Finished size: 59" x 74" Blocks finish at 15"

Fabric 1:

Cut (6) 10-1/2" x 10-1/2" green bouquet squares Cut (3) 10-1/2" x 10-1/2" pink bouquet squaress Cut (3) 10-1/2" x 10-1/2" lavender bouquet squares *save the orange & blue blocks for the quilt back!

Fabric 2 - Dark Pink Geo

A Cut (4) 3" x WOF strips. Subcut into: (48) 3" squares

Cut (7) 2-1/4" x WOF strips for binding

Fabric 3 - Pink Gingham

B: Cut (4) 3-1/2" x WOF strips. (HSTs) Subcut into (36) 3-1/2" squares

C: Cut (5) 3" x WOF strips. (flying geese) Subcut into (48) 3" x 3" squares

Fabric 4 - Green Gingham

B: Cut (4) 3-1/2" x WOF strips.

Subcut into (36) 3-1/2" squares

E: Cut (2) 5-1/2" x WOF strips. (flying geese) Subcut into (24) 3" x 5-1/2"rectangles

Fabric 5 - White Dot

D: Cut (7) 3-1/2" x WOF strips.

Subcut into (72) 3-1/2" squares

C: Cut (4) 3" x WOF strips.

Subcut into (48) 3" x 3" squares

E: Cut (2) 5-1/2" x WOF strips. (flying geese) Subcut into (24) 3" x 5-1/2"rectangles

Sashing

Cut (6) 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end to end. Subcut into:

(2) 60-1/2" side sashing strips

(2) 49-1/2" top and bottom sashing strips

Fabric 6 - Pink Floral

Cut: (7) 5-1/2" x WOF strips for borders. Sew together, end to end. Subcut into:

(2) 59-1/2" top and bottom borders

(2) 64-1/2" side borders

Optional Pieced Backing *Fabric is NOT included in kit.

Finished dimensions: 67" x 81"

Remaining Fabric 1 orange & blue blocks:

Cut (3) blue and (2) orange 10-1/2" x 10-1/2" squares Backing:

Cut into (2) 81" pieces

Left Side: Cut (1) 18-1/2" x 81"

Right Side: Cut (1) 38-1/2" x 81"

From the remainder cut:

F: Cut (2) 10-1/2"x 11 3/4"rectangles G: Cut (4) 2-1/2" x 10-1/2" rectangles

Bloom on! Quilt Instructions

Please read all instructions before you begin. Seam allowance is 1/4" unless otherwise stated. Fabric is abbreviated as 'F'. For example, F1 refers to Fabric 1. Press in the direction of arrows.

Use a light sizing or starch on triangles to help prevent stretching along the diagonal edges.

Use the

check boxes to mark each step as you complete it.

Block Centers

Gather (12) F1- squares and (48) F2-A squares.

- ☐ 1. Mark a diagonal line from corner to corner on the F2-A squares.
- □ 2. Place a F2-A square, RST on a corner of a F1 bouquet square as illustrated. Sew on the marked line. Cut the corner 1/4" away from the sewn line. Press open.
- □ 3. Repeat step 2 to sew the F2-A squares on the remaining 3 corners of the bouquet block.
- □ 4. Sew and cut-away the corners on the remaining 11 bouquet blocks.






Flying Geese units

Gather (48) F3-C squares, (24) F4-E rectangles, (48) F5-C squares, and (24) F5-E rectangles.

- □ 1. Mark a line from corner to corner on the F5-C squares. Place a C square, RST over a F4-E rectangle. Sew on the marked line. Trim 1/4" away from the sewn line. Press in the direction of the arrows.
- \square 2. Repeat on the opposite corner. Square up to 3" x 5-1/2". Make 24.
- □ 3. Mark a line from corner to corner on the F3-C squares. Place a C square, RST over a F5-E rectangle. Sew on the marked line. Trim 1/4" away from the sewn line. Press away from E.
- \square 4. Repeat on the opposite corner. Square up to 3" x 5-1/2". Make 24.


HST (Half Square Triangle) units


Gather (72) F5-D squares, (36) F3-B squares, and (36) F4-B squares.

- ☐ 1. Mark a diagonal line from corner to corner on the F5-D squares. Place a D square, RST over a F4-B square. Sew 1/4" away from the marked line on either side.
- □ 2. Trim on the original marked line creating 2 pieces. Press away from D. Square up to 3". Make 36 for a total of 72 pieces.
- □ 3. Place a D square, RST over a F3-B square. Sew 1/4" away from the marked line on either side.
- 4. Trim on the original marked line creating 2 pieces. Press toward D. Square up to 3". Make 36 for a total of 72 pieces.




- ☐ 1. Lay the units out as illustrated below for the block sides and the block top and bottom.
- □ 2. Sew into rows. Press in the direction of the





arrows.



Blocks

Gather the block centers, the side rows and the top and bottom

Refer to the illustration on p.7- Match the green rows to the pink and lavender center blocks. Match the pink rows to the green center blocks.

- 1. Sew the side rows to the Block 1 center units. Press.
- 2. Sew the top and bottom rows to the step 1 units. Press. Make 6. Blocks finish 15-1/2" x 15-1/2".
- □ 3. Repeat steps 1-2 with the Block 2 center units. Press. Make 6. Blocks finish 15-1/2" x 15-1/2".
- 4. Lay the blocks out in rows as illustrated on p.7.

Row 1: Block 1 - Block 2 - Block 1

Row 2: Block 2 - Block 1 - Block 2

Row 3: Block 1 - Block 2 - Block 1

Row 4: Block 2 - Block 1 - Block 2

Sew the blocks together. Press rows in opposite directions to nest seams.

□ 5. Sew row to row. Press open.



Follow the illustration on p.7

Sashing

- ☐ 1. Side Sashing: Center and pin the F5-side sashing strips, RST, to the sides of the quilt. Sew together. Press toward top. Repeat on the opposite side.
- ☐ 2. Top and Bottom Sashing. Center and pin the F5 top sashing, RST, to the top of the quilt. Sew together. Press toward top. Repeat on the bottom of the quilt top.

Outer Borders

- □ 3. Center and pin a F6 side border strip, RST, to one side of the quilt top. Sew together. Press toward the outer border. Repeat on the opposite side.
- 4. Center and pin the F6 top border strip, RST, to the top of the guilt top. Sew together. Press toward the outer border. Repeat on the bottom of the quilt.

Block 1 - Make 6 Pink and Lavendar centers will vary




Block 2 - Make 6 Green centers will vary.



- □ 5. Layer the backing (wrong side up), batting and quilt top (right side up). Baste layers to secure. Quilt as desired. Trim the excess backing and batting.
- \Box 6 . Sew the binding strips together into one continuous strip. Press in half length-wise. Sew the binding to the quilt top with a 1/4" seam allowance. Turn the binding to the back side of the quilt and stitch down by hand with matching thread.

Bloom on! Quilt Pieced Backing



This pieced backing accounts for an additional 3-4" around on all sides. Use 1/2" seam allowance when sewing the right and left side sections to the center section.

- ☐ 1. Piece the center section as illustrated above: Sew the G-rectangles to the bottom of the F1 bouquet blocks. Press toward G. Then sew an F-rectangle to the top and bottom of the center section. Press toward F.
- □ 2. Sew the right and left side sections to the pieced center section. Press away from the center section.

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
