 <p>Background T7764 Amethyst Silver</p>	<p>4 3/8y, includes binding</p>	<p>a. Pieced blocks (10) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (240) 1 1/2" x 1 1/2" squares. (8) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (120) 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" squares.</p> <p>b. Sashing rectangles (5) 10 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (49) 3 1/2" x 10 1/2" Rectangles.</p> <p>c. Cornerstone units (2) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Reserve for strip piecing. (2) 3 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (40) 1 1/2" x 3 1/2" rectangles.</p> <p>d. Inner border (8) 4" x WOF strips. Piece strips and sub-cut (2) 4" x 69 1/2" and (2) 4" x 75 1/2" strips.</p> <p>e. Binding (9) 2 1/4" x WOF strips. Piece strips to make a continuous binding strip.</p>

 <p>Fabric F S4705 Mint</p>	3/8y	<p>a. Pieced blocks (2) 6" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (10) 6" x 6" squares.</p>
 <p>Fabric G S4811 Ice</p>	1 1/8y	<p>a. Pieced blocks (1) 6" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) 6" x 6" squares.</p> <p>b. Cornerstone units (1) 1 1/2" x WOF strip. Reserve for strip piecing.</p> <p>c. Outer border (8) 3 1/2" x WOF strips. Piece strips and sub-cut (2) 3 1/2" x 75 1/2" and (2) 3 1/2" x 82 1/2" strips.</p>

 <p>Fabric J T7762 Sweet Pea Silver</p>	3/8y	<p>a. Pieced blocks (2) 6" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (10) 6" x 6" squares.</p>
 <p>Fabric K T7763 Lilac Silver</p>	3/8y	<p>a. Pieced blocks (2) 6" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (10) 6" x 6" squares.</p>


## Constructing Pieced Blocks

**Note: A light lavender solid is used in place of the actual background fabric in order to better show block and quilt outlines.**

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) **Fabric 1** 6" x 6" square. Place square, right sides together, on (1) **Fabric 2** 6" x 6" square. Sew  $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from both sides of drawn line. Cut along drawn line to yield (2) HST units. Align diagonal seam of HST units against 45 degree angle line on quilting ruler, trim units to measure  $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $5\frac{1}{2}$ " raw edge to raw edge.




2. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " **background** square. Place square, right sides together, at the top right corner of HST unit made in Step 1. Sew on drawn line. Trim  $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal corner triangle. Repeat with (2)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " **background** squares at the top left and bottom right corner of the same HST unit. Unit measures  $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $5\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished.




Repeat to make a total of (4) units.

3. Sew together (4) units to complete (1) pieced block. Block measures  $10\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $10\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished.



4. Make a total number of blocks for the following **Fabric 1 / Fabric 2** combinations.




### Constructing Cornerstone Units

1. Sew (2) 1 1/2" x WOF **background** strips to the long sides of (1) 1 1/2" x WOF **Fabric G** strip. Subcut strip set at 1 1/2" intervals for (20) units, as shown.



Sew to the opposite long sides (2) 1 1/2" x 3 1/2" **background** rectangles to complete (1) cornerstone unit. Unit measures 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" unfinished.



Make a total of (20) cornerstone units.

### Quilt Center Assembly


1. Pieced rows. Refer to quilt image for block placement guide, arrange and sew together (5) pieced blocks and (4) 3 1/2" x 10 1/2" **background** sashing rectangles to make a pieced row. Make a total of (6) pieced rows. Row 1 is shown below.



2. Pieced sashing rows. Sew together (5) 3 1/2" x 10 1/2" **background** sashing rectangles and (4) cornerstone units to make a pieced sashing row. Make a total of (5) pieced sashing rows.




3. Sew together pieced rows and pieced sashing rows to complete quilt center.



## Quilt Top Assembly

1. Inner border. Sew (2) 4" x 75 1/2" **background** strips to the left and right sides of quilt center, followed by (2) 4" x 69 1/2" **background** strips to the top and bottom of quilt center.
2. Outer border. Sew (2) 3 1/2" x 82 1/2" **Fabric G** strips to the left and right sides of quilt center, followed by (2) 3 1/2" x 75 1/2" **Fabric G** strips to the top and bottom of quilt center to complete quilt top.



## Finishing

1. Layer backing, batting and quilt top.
2. Baste the layers together. Quilt as desired.
3. Bind to complete the quilt.
