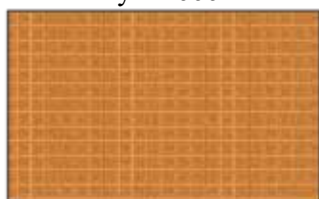

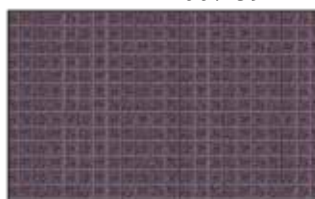

Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Large Floral with Bird - Cocoa (A), cut:

- (1) 3" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (14) 3" squares.
- (5) 2 1/2" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Teepees - Ivory (B), cut:

- (8) 1 1/8" x WOF strips.

From the Circle Clover - Cocoa (C), cut:

- (8) 1 1/8" x WOF strips.

From the Tear Drop Floral - Red (D), cut:

- (1) 3" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (1) 3" square and (8) 1 3/4" squares.
- (3) 1 1/4" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 1/4" x 59 1/2" strips.
- (2) 1 1/4" x 28" WOF strips.
- (3) 1 1/4" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 1/4" x 47" strips.
- (1) 1 1/4" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 1 1/4" x 15 1/2" strips.

From the Wavy Floral Stripe - Red (E), cut:

- (1) 3" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (1) 3" square and (8) 1 3/4" squares.

From the Circle Clover - Ivory (F), cut:

- (3) 1 3/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (52) 1 3/4" squares.

From the Floral Stamp - Ivory (G), cut:

- (4) 1 3/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (52) 1 3/4" x 3" strips.

From the Teepees - Green (H), cut:

- (1) 3" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (1) 3" square and (8) 1 3/4" squares.

From the Diamond Stripe - Green (I), cut:

- (1) 3" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (1) 3" square and (8) 1 3/4" squares.

From the Circle Clover - Teal (J), cut:

- (1) 3" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (1) 3" square and (8) 1 3/4" squares.

From the Floral - Teal (K), cut:

- (1) 3" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (1) 3" square and (8) 1 3/4" squares.

From the Floral - Red (L), cut:

- (1) 3" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (1) 3" square and (8) 1 3/4" squares.

From the Check - Gold (M), cut:

- (1) 3" square.

From the Floral Stamp - Orange (N), cut:

- (1) 3" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (1) 3" square and (16) 1 3/4" squares.

From the Check - Purple (O), cut:

- (1) 3" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (1) 3" square and (8) 1 3/4" squares.

From the Floral Stamp - Purple (P), cut:

- (1) 3" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (1) 3" square and (8) 1 3/4" squares.

From the Diamond Stripe - Gold (Q), cut:

- (1) 3" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (1) 3" square and (8) 1 3/4" squares.

From the Tear Drop Floral - Green (R), cut:

- (1) 3" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (1) 3" square and (8) 1 3/4" squares.

From the Floral Stripe - Ivory (S) (Version #1 Only), cut:

- (2) 6" x 62" LOF strips.
- (2) 6" x 32" LOF strips.

From the Floral Strips - Cocoa (S) (Version #2 Only), cut:

- (2) 6" x 62" LOF strips.
- (2) 6" x 32" LOF strips.

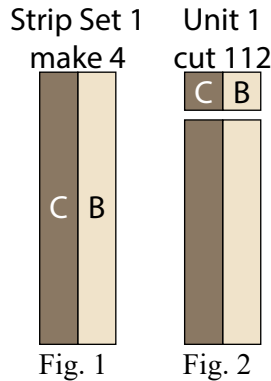
From the Large Floral with Bird - Ivory (Backing), cut:

- (1) 67" x 37" WOF strip for the backing.

Block Assembly

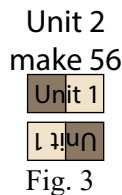
Note: The arrows figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a 1/4" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Sew (1) 1 1/8" x WOF Fabric C strip lengthwise to the left side of (1) 1 1/8" x WOF Fabric B strip to make (1) Strip Set 1 (Fig. 1). Repeat to make (4) Strip Set 1's total.

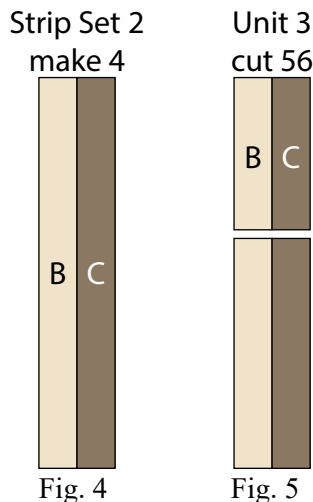


2. Cut the (4) Strip Set 1's into (112) 1 3/4" x 1 1/8" Unit 1 strips (Fig. 2).

3. Sew (2) Unit 1 strips together to make (1) 1 3/4" Unit 2 square (Fig. 3). Repeat to make (56) Unit 2 squares total.



4. Sew (1) 1 1/8" x WOF Fabric B strip lengthwise to the left side of (1) 1 1/8" x WOF Fabric C strip to make (1) Strip Set 2 (Fig. 4). Repeat to make (4) Strip Set 2's total.



6. Sew (1) Unit 2 square to each end of (1) Unit 3 strip to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) Unit 3 strip to each side of (1) 3" Fabric A square to make the middle row. Sew the (3) rows together lengthwise to make (1) 5 1/2" Block One square (Fig. 6). Repeat to make (14) Block One squares total.

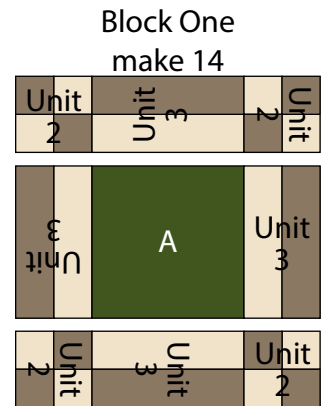

7. Place (1) 1 3/4" Fabric E square on the left side of (1) 1 3/4" x 3" Fabric G strip, right sides together (Fig. 7). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 7). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance (Fig. 8).

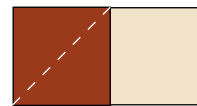

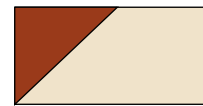

8. Place another 1 3/4" Fabric E square on the right side of the 1 3/4" x 3" Fabric E strip, right sides together (Fig. 9). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 9). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance to make (1) Unit 4 strip (Fig. 10).

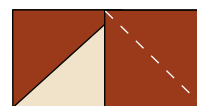

9. Repeat Steps 7-8 to make (4) Unit 4 strips total.

10. Repeat Steps 7-8 and refer to Figures 11-21 for fabric identification, placement, seam direction and orientation to make (4) of each unit strip for Unit 5-15, except make (8) Unit 8 strips.

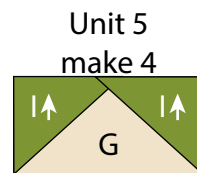

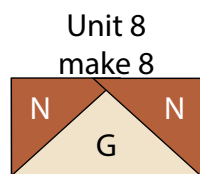

11. Sew (1) 1 3/4" Fabric F square to each end of (1) Unit 4 strip to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) Unit 4 strip to each side of (1) 3" Fabric D square to make the middle row. Sew the (3) rows together lengthwise to make (1) 5 1/2" Block Two square (Fig. 22).

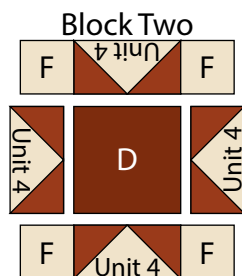

12. Repeat Step 11 and refer to Figures 23-34 for component identification, placement and orientation to make (1) each block square for Block Three through Block Fourteen.

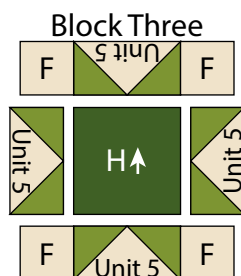

13. Sew the (27) Blocks together into a 3 x 9 matrix to make the Center Block (Fig. 35 below).

Runner Assembly

(Follow the appropriate Runner Layout while assembling the quilt top. Only the Fabric S strips are difference between the two different quilt versions.)

14. Sew (1) 1 1/4" x 15 1/2" Fabric D strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 1/4" x 47" Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

15. Center (1) 6" x 32" Fabric S strip on (1) side of the Center Block and pin in place. Start sewing the strip a 1/4" from the top edge of the block and stop a 1/4" from the bottom edge. **DO NOT TRIM THE EXCESS.** Repeat with the opposite side.

16. Repeat Step 15 to sew (1) 6" x 62" Fabric S strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block, making sure to stop and start 1/4" away from each end of the block. To miter each corner, fold the Center Block on a diagonal, wrong side together. This should line up the strips from adjacent sides (Fig. 36).

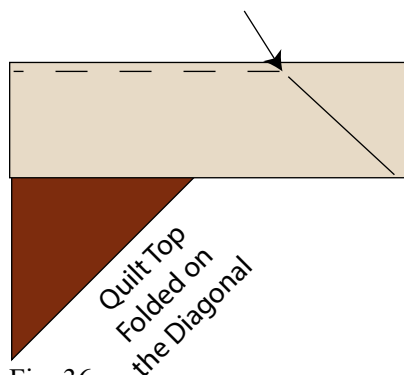

17. Starting at the sewn seam (represented by the arrow in Figure 36), draw a 45-degree line to the edge of the fabric. Sew on the drawn line. Trim the excess fabric leaving a 1/4" seam. Repeat this step with the remaining corners.

18. Sew (1) 1 1/4" x 28" Fabric D strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 1/4" x 59 1/2" Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the runner top.

19. Layer and quilt as desired.

20. Sew the (5) 2 1/2" x WOF Fabric A strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

21. Bind as desired.

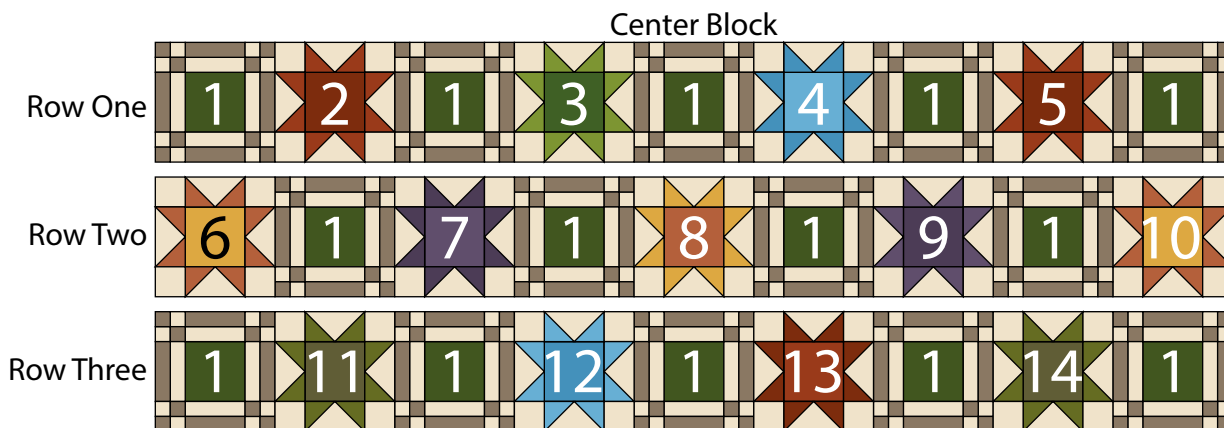
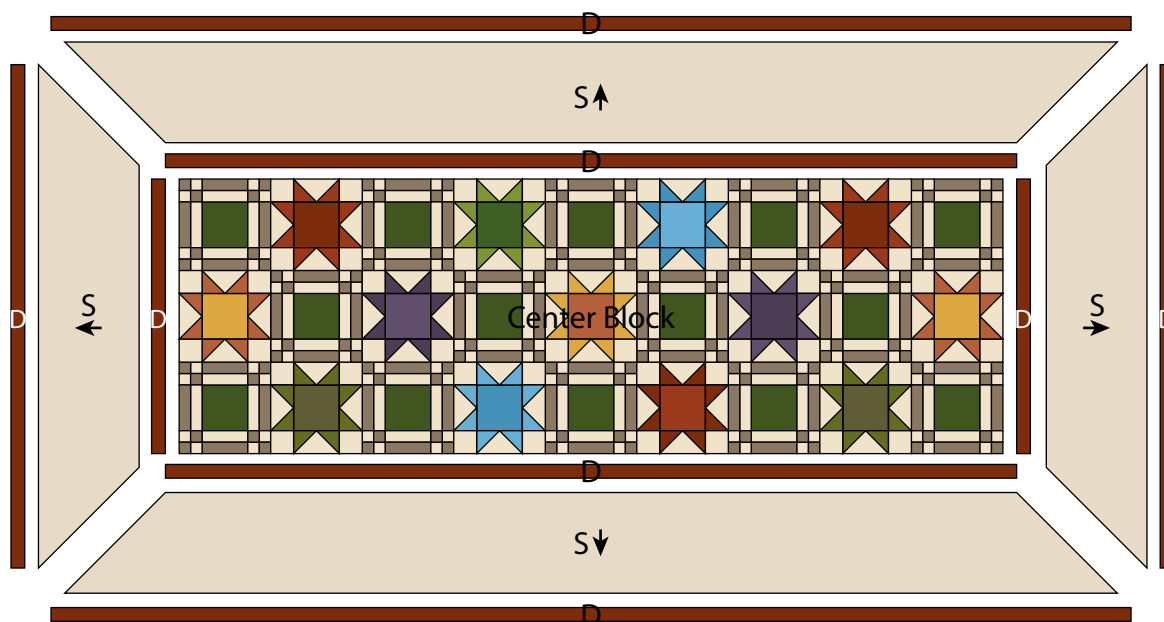
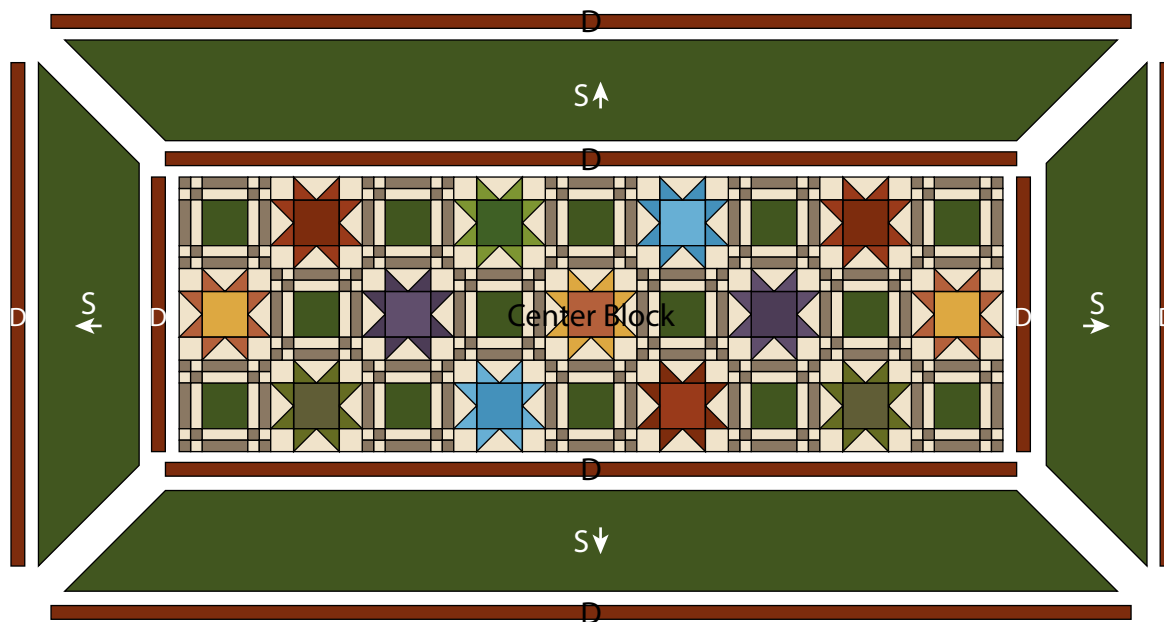
