Home to Roost

Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning.

All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.

1. Cut the following:

If using FAT CUTS, you may need to cut additional width-of-fabric strips.

Fabric A - PLEASE NOTE: Panels do not always print the size intended. For this pattern, panels have a coping border added then trimmed so they will fit the quilt correctly.

Fussy cut 1/4" beyond top and bottom edges of 4 panels to approximately 11-1/2" tall. Trim to 11-1/2" wide with motif centered.

Fabric B - Referring to the quilt image, fussy cut strips, the length of fabric parallel to selvage: (4) 9-1/4" x 39-1/2" multi-stripe borders with blue stipes on bottom

Fabric C - Fussy cut (4) 6-1/4" squares, (8) 3-1/2" tall x 5" wide **C¹** pieces, and (12) 3-1/2" wide x 5" tall **C²** pieces with motifs centered

Fabric D - Cut (4) 2" strips, subcut (4) 2" x 36-1/2" borders

Fabric E - Cut (2) 3-1/2" strips, subcut (13) 3-1/2" squares

Fabric F - Cut (3) 1-1/4" strips, subcut (8) 1-1/4" x 12-1/2" strips
Cut (3) 1" strips, subcut (8) 1" x 12" strips

Fabric G - Cut (7) 2-1/2" strips (binding)

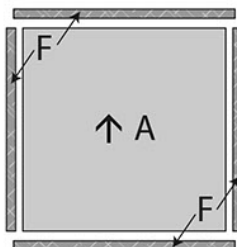
Fabric H - Cut (1) 3-1/2" strip, subcut (12) 3-1/2" squares

Fabric I - Cut (2) 2" strips, subcut (32) 2" squares

Fabric J - Cut (7) 2" strips, subcut (8) 2" x 7-3/4", (8) 2" x 6-1/4", and (40) 2" x 3-1/2" pieces

2. Piecing Order:

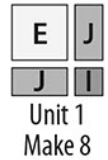
1. Stitch **Fabric F** 1" x 12" strips to sides of a **Fabric A** panel. Trim strip ends even. Add 1-1/4" x 12-1/2" **Fabric F** strips to top and bottom of panel. **Trim bordered panel to 11-1/2" square (unfinished).** Make a total of 4 **Block 1**.



Block 1 - Make 4

Arrows indicate orientation of directional prints.

2. Arrange 2 **Fabric J** 2" x 3-1/2" pieces and 1 each **Fabric E** 3-1/2" square and **Fabric I** 2" square in 2 rows as shown. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 8 Unit 1 (5" square unfinished).



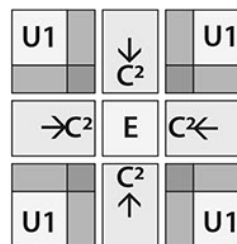
Unit 1

3. In the same manner, make 12 Unit 2 with fabrics indicated.

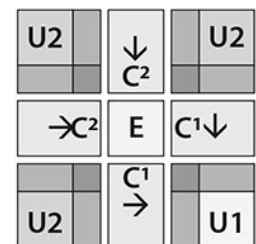


Unit 2

4. Arrange 1 **Fabric E** 3-1/2" square, 4 Unit 1, and 4 **Fabric C²** pieces in 3 rows as shown. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together to complete **Block 2** (12-1/2" square unfinished). In the same manner, make 4 **Block 3** with fabrics and units indicated.

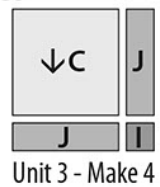


Block 2 - Make 1



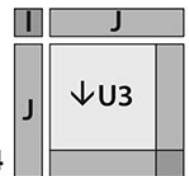
Block 3 - Make 4

5. Arrange 2 **Fabric J** 2" x 6-1/4" pieces and 1 each **Fabric C** 6-1/4" square and **Fabric I** 2" square in 2 rows as shown. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 4 Unit 3 (7-3/4" square unfinished).

6. Arrange 2 **Fabric J** 2" x 7-3/4" pieces, 1 **Fabric I** 2" square, and 1 Unit 3 in 2 rows as shown. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 4 **Block 4** (9-1/4" square unfinished).



Block 4 - Make 4

7. Refer to Quilt Layout (Page 2) for arrangement and placement of blocks, **Fabric I** squares, and borders.

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8. Arrange **Blocks 1-3** in 3 rows. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together into quilt center (36-1/2" square unfinished).

9. Sew **Fabric D** 2" x 36-1/2" borders to right and left sides of quilt center. Stitch 2 **Fabric I** 2" squares to ends of remaining **Fabric D** 2" x 36-1/2" borders. Sew these borders to top and bottom of quilt center.

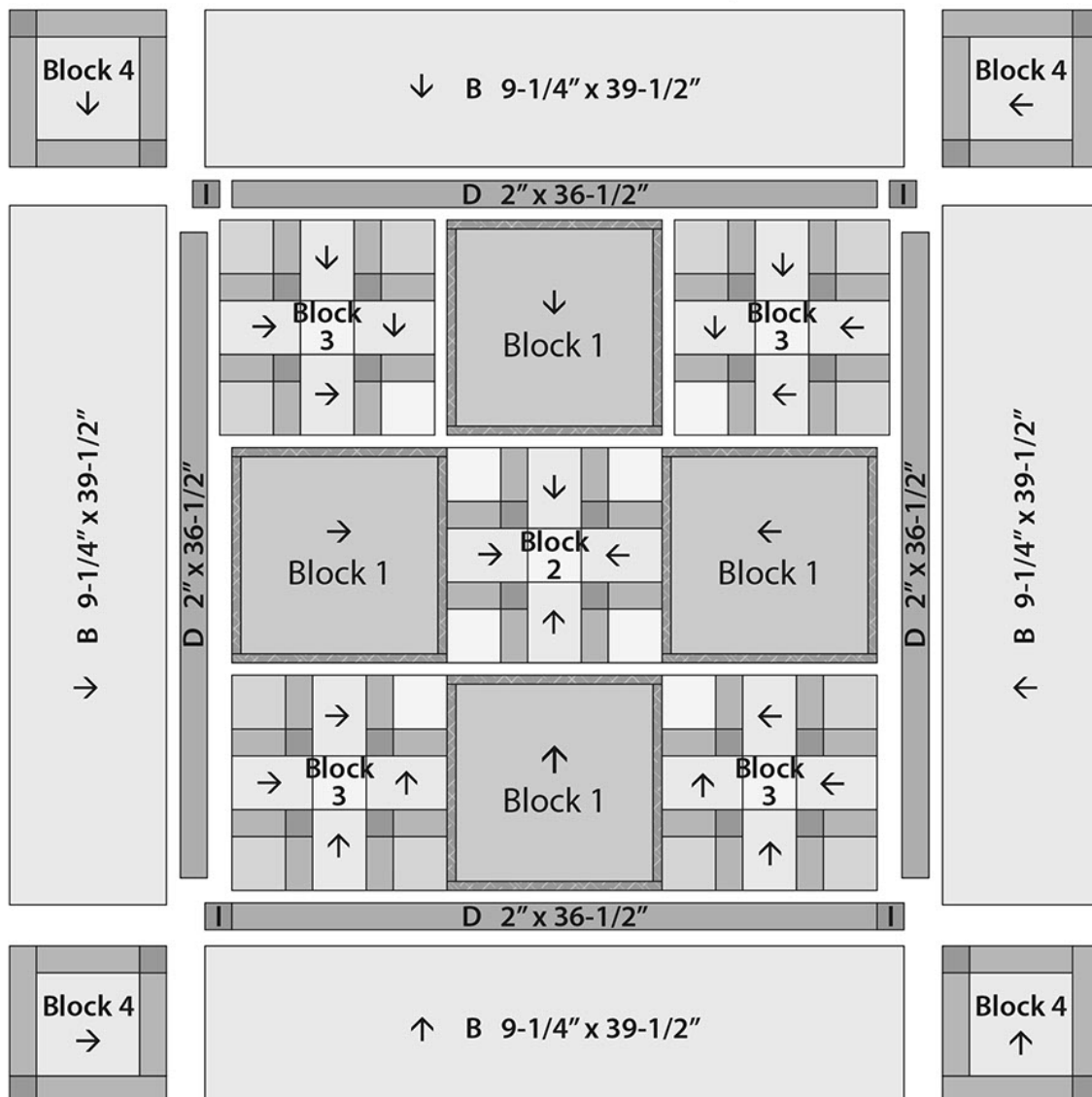
10. Stitch a **Fabric B** border to opposite sides of quilt. Sew **Block 4** to ends of remaining **Fabric B** borders then sew to remaining sides of the quilt.

11. The quilt measures approximately 57" square (unfinished). Make backing (**Fabric K**) approximately 8" larger than the top.

12. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric G**) and enjoy!!
