# ALL SQUARED UP

## FINISHED QUILT SIZE 67" x 78"

Measurements include ¼" seam allowance.

Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated.

This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting technique and terminology. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric.

## FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

1 10-11370-42 For the Love of Nature 10" Stacker

1¼ Yards Green Main (C11370 Green)

1½ yards Pearl Moths (C11373 Pearl)

¾ Yard Burgundy Check (C11374 Burgundy)\*

\*includes Binding

## CUTTING REQUIREMENTS

Please read instructions before cutting fabrics. Refer to the quilt photo for the placement of each of the fabrics. Use a straight edge ruler and rotary cutter to cut your fabrics.

### Green Main

Cut seven 5½" x WOF strips for outer border.

### Pearl Moths

Cut eighteen 2" x WOF strips:

Sub-cut into (71) 2" x 10" rectangles for sashing.

### Burgundy Check

Cut eight 2½" x WOF strips for binding.

Cut two 2" x WOF strips:

Sub-cut into (42) 2" x 2" squares.

## QUILT ASSEMBLY

Refer to the quilt photo for placement of the prints. Press seam allowances towards the squares, away from the sashing strips.

Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces. Sew side borders first.

### Quilt Center

Sew the 10" stacker squares together, alternating with the 2" x 10" pearl moth sashing strips, into 6 rows of 5 squares and 6 strips (A).



Sew the 2" burgundy check square together, alternating with the 2" x 10" pearl moth sashing strips, into 7 rows of 6 squares and 5 strips (B).



Sew rows together alternating between the A and B rows to complete the Quilt Center. Quilt Center should measure 57" x 68".

### Outer Border

Side borders should be 68". Top and bottom borders should be 67".



Finish quilt by layering the quilt top, batting and back. Quilt as desired. Bind with the burgundy check strips you have already cut. Have fun with your colors and enjoy the journey of making your quilt.
