





#### **Cutting Instructions**

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

#### From the Book Panel 36-In - Gray (A):

• Fussy cut (12) 7 3/4" squares, each centered on a panel.

#### From the Camping Words - Red (B), cut:

- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 2" x 7 \( \frac{3}{4} \)" strips.
- (4) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 2" x 10 \(^3\)4" strips.

#### From the Water Lily - Light Teal (C), cut:

- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 2" x 7 3/4" strips.
- (4) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 2" x 10 3/4" strips.

#### From the Starry Basics - Orange (D), cut:

• (1) 2 3/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 2 3/8" squares. Cut the squares across (1) diagonal to make (16) 2 3/8" triangles

#### From the Starry Basics - Gold (E), cut:

• (1) 2 <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 2 <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (16) 2 <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" triangles.

#### From the Houndstooth Basics - Gold (F), cut:

• (1) 2 3/4" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 2 3/4" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (16) 2 3/4" triangles.

#### From the Starry Basics - Teal (G), cut:

- (2) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 2" squares.
- (1) 1 5/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 1 5/8" x 2" strips.

#### From the Houndstooth Basics - Green (H), cut:

• (1) 2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 2" x 3 ½" strips.

#### From the Starry Basics - Lime Green (I), cut:

• (1) 2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 2" x 3 ½" strips.

#### From the Houndstooth Basics - Lime Green (J), cut:

• (1) 2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 2" x 3 ½" strips.

#### From the Starry Basics - Brown (K), cut:

• (1) 1 1/4" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 1 1/4" x 2" strips.

#### From the Folio Basic - White on White (L), cut:

• (1) 2 3/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 2 3/8" squares. Cut the squares across (1) diagonal to make (16) 2 3/8" triangles

#### From the Houndstooth Basics - Steel (M), cut:

• (1) 2 <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 2 <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (16) 2 <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" triangles.

#### From the Pawprint - Gray (N), cut:

• (1) 2 <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 2 <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (16) 2 <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" triangles.

#### From the Starry Basics - Indigo (O), cut:

- (2) 2" x 41" WOF strips.
- (2) 2" x 36 ½" WOF strips.

#### From the Camping Site - Gray (P), cut:

- (3) 3" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 3" x 44" strips.
- (2) 3" x 41 ½" WOF strips.

#### From the Small Stripe - Light Teal (Q), cut:

• (3) 2" x 33 ½" WOF strips.

#### From the Firefly - Navy (R), cut:

- (2) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 2" squares.
- (1) 1 5/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 1 5/8" x 2" strips.

#### From the Small Floral - Red (S), cut:

• (5) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

#### From the Critters Tossed Allover - Gray (Backing), cut:


• (2) 49" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 49" x 57" back.


#### **Block Assembly**

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a ¼" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.


- 1. Sew (1) 2" x 7  $\frac{3}{4}$ " Fabric B strip to each side of (1) 7  $\frac{3}{4}$ " Fabric A square. Sew (1) 2" x 10  $\frac{3}{4}$ " Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A square. Trim the block to measure 9  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 9  $\frac{1}{2}$ " to make (1) Block One square (Fig. 1). Repeat to make (6) Block One squares total.
- 2. Sew (1) 2" x 7 ¾" Fabric C strip to each side of (1) 7 ¾" Fabric A square. Sew (1) 2" x 10 ¾" Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A square. Trim the block to measure 9 ½" x 9 ½" to make (1) Block Two square (Fig. 2). Repeat to make (6) Block Two squares total.




- 3. Sew (1) 2 ¾" Fabric E triangle and (1) 2 ¾" Fabric F triangle together along short sides. Sew (1) 2 ¾" Fabric D triangle to the long side of the newly sewn triangle to make (1) 2" Unit 1 square (Fig. 3). Repeat to make (16) Unit 1 squares total.
- 4. Repeat Step 3 and refer to Figure 4 for fabric identification, placement and orientation to make (16) Unit 2 squares.
- 5. Sew together (4) Unit 1 squares into a 2 x 2 matrix to make (1) 3 ½" Unit 3 square (Fig. 5). Repeat to make (4) Unit 3 squares total.
- 6. Sew together (4) Unit 2 squares into a 2 x 2 matrix to make (1) 3 ½" Unit 4 square (Fig. 6). Repeat to make (4) Unit 4 squares total.



7. Sew (1) 1 5/8" x 2" Fabric G strip to each side of (1) 1 1/4" x 2" Fabric K strip lengthwise to make (1) Unit 5 strip (Fig. 7). Repeat to make (4) Unit 5 strips total.




8. Sew (1) 1 %" x 2" Fabric R strip to each side of (1) 1 1/4" x 2" Fabric K strip lengthwise to make (1) Unit 6 strip (Fig. 8). Repeat to make (4) Unit 6 strips total.



9. Place (1) 2" Fabric G square on the left side of (1) 2" x 3 ½" Fabric H strip, right sides together (Fig. 9). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 9). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a ¼" seam allowance (Fig. 10).




- 10. Place another 2" Fabric G square on the right side of the 2" x 3 ½" Fabric H strip, right sides together (Fig. 11). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 11). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a ¼" seam allowance to make (1) Unit 7 strip (Fig. 12).
- 11. Repeat Steps 9-10 to make (4) Unit 7 strips total.




12. Repeat Steps 9-10 and refer to Figures 13-17 for fabric identification, placement and seam direction to make (4) of each unit strip for Unit 8 through Unit 12.



- 13. Sew together (1) Unit 3 square, (1) Unit 7 strip, (1) Unit 8 strip, (1) Unit 9 strip and (1) Unit 5 strip, lengthwise and in that order from top to bottom, to make (1) Block Three strip (Fig. 18). Repeat to make (4) Block Three strips total.
- 14. Repeat Step 13 and refer to Figure 19 for component identification, placement and orientation to make (4) Block Four strips.




15. Follow Figure 20 and sew together (6) Block One squares, (4) Block Three strips, (6) Block Twos squares, (4) Block Four strips and (3) 2" x 33 ½" Fabric Q strips to make the 33 ½" x 41" Center Block.



#### **Quilt Top Assembly**

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)
16. Sew (1) 2" x 41" Fabric O strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2" x 36 ½" Fabric O strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

- 17. Sew (1) 3" x 44" Fabric P strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 3" x 41 ½" Fabric P strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.
- 18. Layer and quilt as desired.
- 19. Sew the (5) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric S strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
- 20. Bind as desired.
