




Note: Please read the entire pattern before you begin. For turned under applique techniques, trace templates and cut along the solid outer line. For raw edge appliqué techniques, trace templates and cut along the solid inner line. The templates and placement patterns are found on pages 9-16. See appliqué instruction before cutting templates.

A		52979M-2 Grey	7/8	(4) 12-7/8" squares; cut in half diagonally once to make (8) triangles.
B		52981-1 Navy	7/8	(2) 5-1/2" x WOF; subcut (12) 5-1/2" squares. Cut in half diagonally twice to make (48) triangles. (4) 2-1/2" x WOF; sew short ends together. Subcut (2) 2-1/2" x 38-3/4" borders and (2) 2-1/2" x 42-3/4" borders. (1) 2-7/8" x WOF; subcut (2) 2-7/8" squares and (5) 2" squares. Cut 2-7/8" squares in half diagonally once to make (4) triangles. (4) Large Leaf templates. (8) Medium Leaf templates.
C		52982-1 Navy	7/8	FOR BINDING: (6) 2-1/4" x WOF" strips, sew short ends together. (4) Outer Petal templates. (12) Flower templates. (8) Bud Center templates.
D		52982-2 Grey	7/8	For raw edge appliqué stems (from templates): (4) Center Stems, (8) Short Border Stems, (8) Short Border Stems reversed, (4) Long Border Stems and (4) Long Border Stems reversed. <i>Continued on page 2.</i>

D		52982-2 Grey	n/a	Continued from page 1. For turned under appliqué: (4) 1-1/4" x 13" bias strips, (8) 1-1/4" x 7-1/2" bias strips and (16) 1-1/4" x 5-1/2" bias strips. (12) Calyx templates. (11) Small Leaf and (24) Border Leaf templates.
E		52982-3 White	1/2	(2) 5-1/2" x WOF strips; subcut (11) 5-1/2" squares and (4) 3" squares. Cut 5-1/2" squares in half diagonally twice to make (44) triangles. Cut 3" squares in half once to make (8) triangles.
F		52982-4 Cornflower	1/2	(4) Inner Petal templates. (4) Bud Petal templates. (4) Bud Petal templates reversed. (8) Flower templates.
G		52983M-6 Blue	5/8	(5) 2" x WOF strips, subcut (4) 2" x 13-1/2" strips, and (12) 2" x 12" strips. (4) 2-3/4" squares. (32) Border Leaf templates. (8) Butterfly Hind Wing templates. (8) Butterfly Hind Wing templates reversed.

J		35370S-1 Optic White	1-5/8	(5) 5" x WOF strips; sew short ends together. Cut (2) 5" x 51-1/2" borders and (2) 5" x 42-1/2" borders. (4) 12-1/2" squares.

ADDITIONAL MATERIALS

Thread to match fabrics

Sewing machine

Water soluble fabric marker

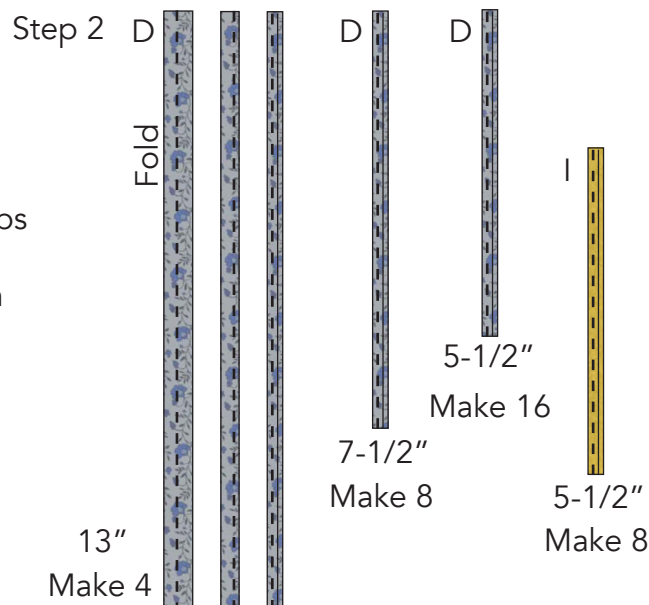
Rotary cutter, ruler and mat

Optional: For turned under edge appliqué: freezer paper or other template paper.**For raw edge appliqué:** paper backed fusible webbing.

CENTER BLOCKS

1. Using your favorite appliqué method, prepare the appliqué pieces. Prepare raw edge appliqué stems in the same way as other pieces.

2. For turned edge appliqué stems, fold (4) **D** 13" strips in half lengthwise with wrong sides together. Sew 1/4" from fold. Trim raw edge 1/8" from stitching. Press stem flat with seam centered on one side. Make 4. Repeat to make (8) **D** 7-1/2" stems, (16) **D** 5-1/2" and (8) **I** 5-1/2" stems. Make the number indicated.

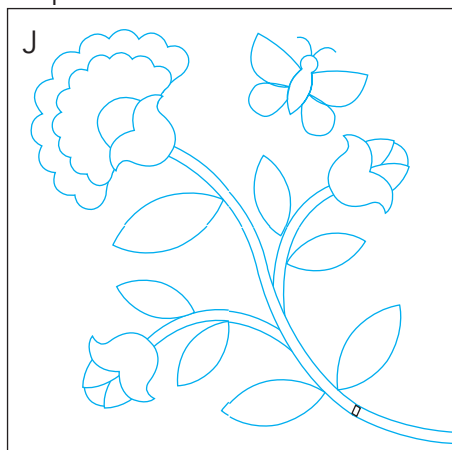


3. Trace the center placement pattern to (2) **J** 12-1/2" squares. Trace the center placement pattern to (2) **J** 12-1/2" squares flipping the butterfly as shown in the same space on the block.

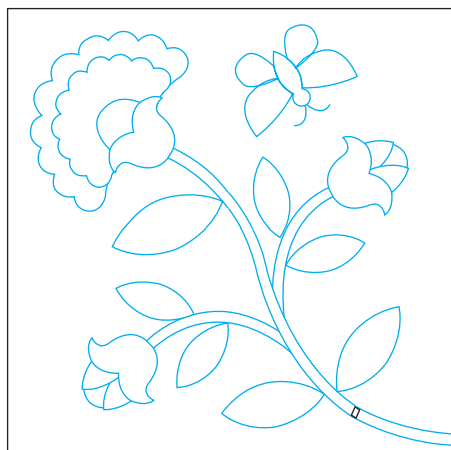
4. Fuse, baste or pin (2) **I** Curved Stems and (1) **D** Center Stem in place. Trim ends so stems overlap adjacent shapes 1/4". Tuck the ends of the **I** curved stems under the edge of the center stem. Sew along the edge of the stems.

5. Fuse, baste or pin (1) **B** Large Leaf appliqué, (2) **B** Medium Leaf appliqués and (4) **D** Small Leaf appliqués in place. Sew along the edges of the leaves. Make 4.

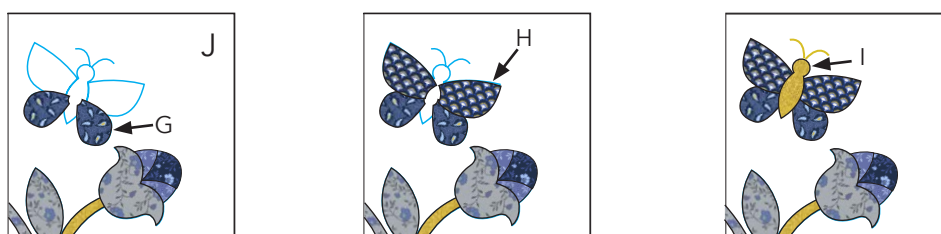
6. Fuse, baste or pin the (1) **C** Outer Petal appliqué in place. Sew along the outer edge. In the same manner, fuse, baste or pin, then sew (1) **F** Inner Petal appliqué and (1) **I** Large Center appliqué. Sew (1) **D** Calyx appliqué in place along all edges to complete the flower.



7. Fuse, baste or pin the bud appliques in place and sew as follows: Sew (1) **C** Bud Center appliqué in place along the outer curve. Sew (1) **F** Bud Petal appliqué and (1) **E** Bud Petal reversed appliqué in place along the curved edges. Sew (1) **D** Calyx appliqué in place along all edges to complete (1) bud. Appliqué the second bud in the same manner.



8. Fuse, baste or pin the butterfly appliques in place and sew as follows: Sew (1) **G** Hind Wing and (1) **G** Hind wing reversed in place. Sew (1) **H** Fore Wing and (1) **H** Fore Wing reversed in place. Sew (1) **I** Body in place. Embroider the antennae using gold thread to complete the center block. Make 4.

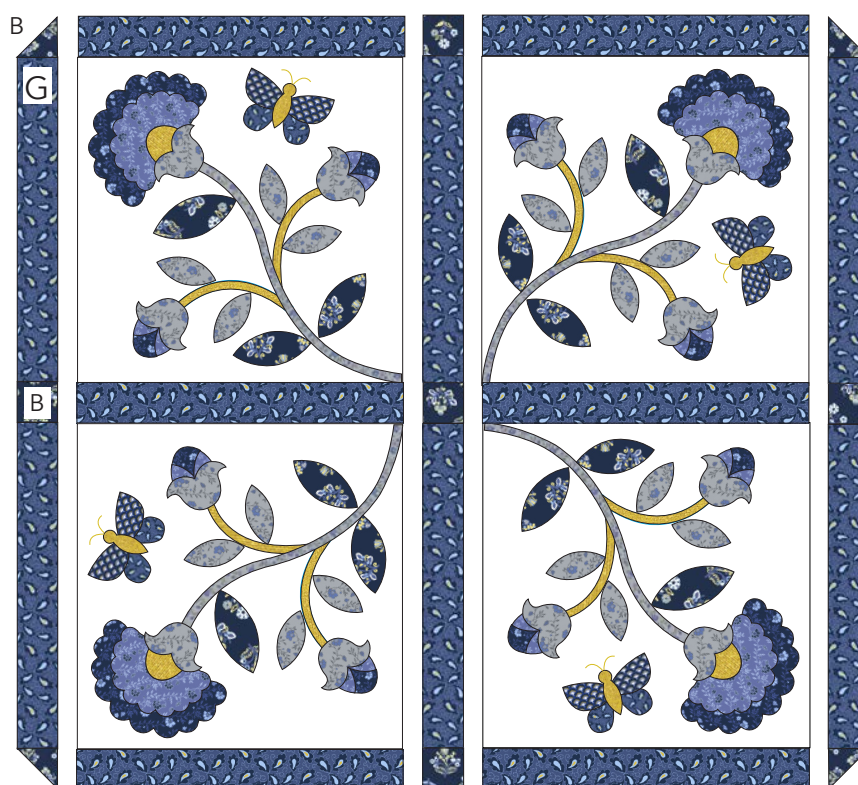

9. Arrange center blocks in (2) rows of (2) blocks each as shown. Note orientation of blocks and butterflies. Sew (3) **G** 2" x 12-1/2" strips alternating with (2) blocks to make the block rows. Make 2.

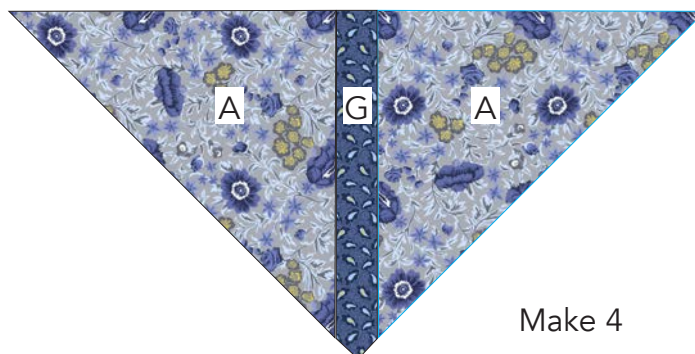
10. Sew (3) **B** 2" squares alternating with (2) **G** 2" x 12-1/2" strips to make the center sashing row. Make 1.

11. Sew (2) **B** 2-7/8" triangles and (1) **B** 2" square alternating with **G** 2" x 12-1/2" strips to make the side sashing row. Note orientation of **B** triangles. Make 2.

12. Sew (2) side sashing rows and (1) center sashing row alternating with (2) block rows to make the quilt center. Make 1.



13. Sew (2) **A** 12-7/8" triangles to the sides of (1) **G** 2" x 2" x 13-1/2" strips. Trim end of strip even with the edge of the triangles to complete an **A/G** triangle pair. Make 4.



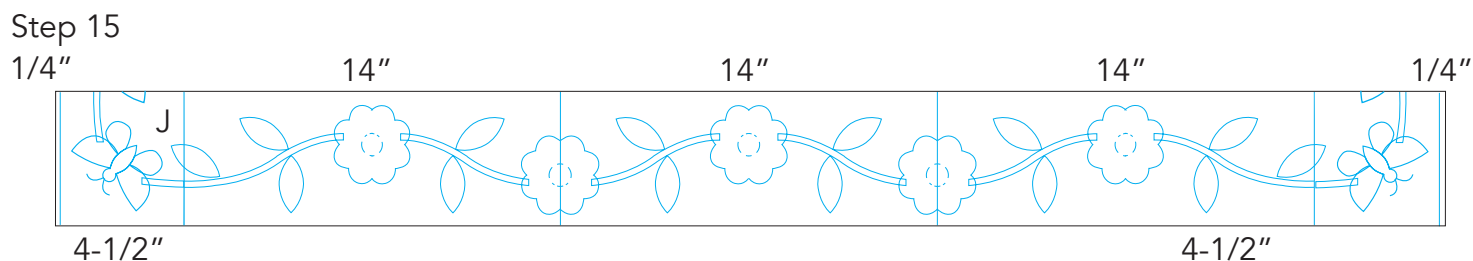
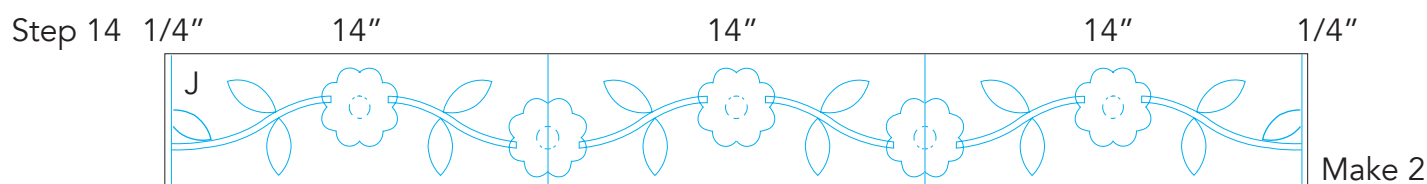


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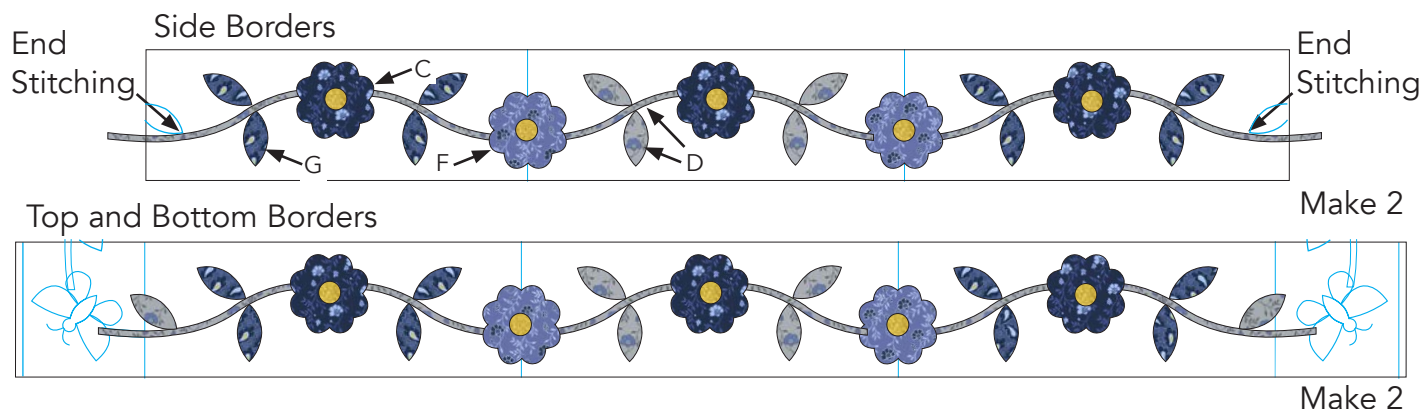
APPLIQUÉ BORDERS

14. Draw a line $\frac{1}{4}$ " from the ends of (2) **J** 5" x 42- $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips. Draw (2) lines 14" in from the two lines. Center section should also measure 14". Trace the border placement centered on the sections of the strips to make the side borders. Omit the flower from the ends of the first and last section. Extend the stem and trace the leaf placement as shown. Make 2.

15. Draw a line $\frac{1}{4}$ " from the ends of (2) **J** 5" x 51- $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips. Draw (2) lines 4- $\frac{1}{2}$ " in from the two lines. Draw (2) lines 14" in from the second lines. Center section should also measure 14". Trace the border placement centered on the 14" sections of the strips again omitting the first and last flower. Extending the stem and trace the leaf placement. Trace corner placement on the 4- $\frac{1}{2}$ " sections to make the top and bottom borders. Make 2.



16. Fuse, baste or pin the appliqué in place and sew to each border as follows: (2) **D** Short Stems and (2) **D** Short Stems reversed, (1) **D** Long Stem and (1) **D** Long Stem reversed, (3) **C** Flowers, (2) **F** Flowers, (4) **D** Border Leaves, (8) **G** Border Leaves and (5) **I** Centers. End stitching on Long stems as indicated. Sew (2) more **D** Border Leaves along Long Stems on top and bottom borders. Butterflies and remainder of stems and leaves will be appliquéd in place after the borders are assembled. Make 2 each.

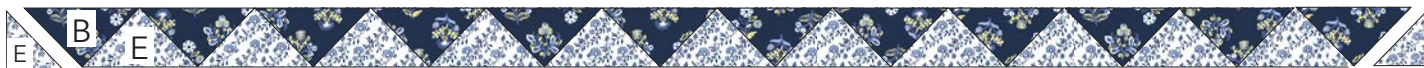

TRIANGLE BORDERS

17. Sew (12) **B** 5-1/2" triangles and (11) **E** 5-1/2" triangles together along the short edges. Sew (1) **E** 3" triangle to each end to make (1) triangle border strip. Make 4.



QUILT ASSEMBLY

18. Following the quilt layout diagram on page 8, sew (1) **A/G** triangle pair to each side of the center blocks to complete the quilt center. Quilt center should measure approximately 38-3/4" including seam allowance.

19. Sew (1) **B** 2-1/2" x 38-3/4" border to each side of quilt center. Sew (1) **B** 2-1/2" x 42-3/4" border to top and bottom of quilt. Trim borders evenly so quilt center measures 42-1/2" square including seam allowance.

20. Sew (1) 5" x 42-1/2" appliqué border to each side of quilt noting orientation of flowers and stems. Sew (1) 5" x 51-1/2" appliqué border to top and bottom of quilt. Keep long stems free when sewing seams.

21. Sew long **D** stems extending from side borders in place on top and bottom borders.

22. Following step 8, sew butterfly to corners of border as shown on lower left corner of Quilt Layout. Sew (4) **D** Border Leaf appliqués overlapping seam of side and top and bottom borders.

23. Sew (1) **B/F** triangle border to each side of quilt noting orientation of triangles. Sew (1) **G** 2-3/4" square to each end of (2) **B/F** triangle borders. Sew to top and bottom of quilt.

Quilt Layout

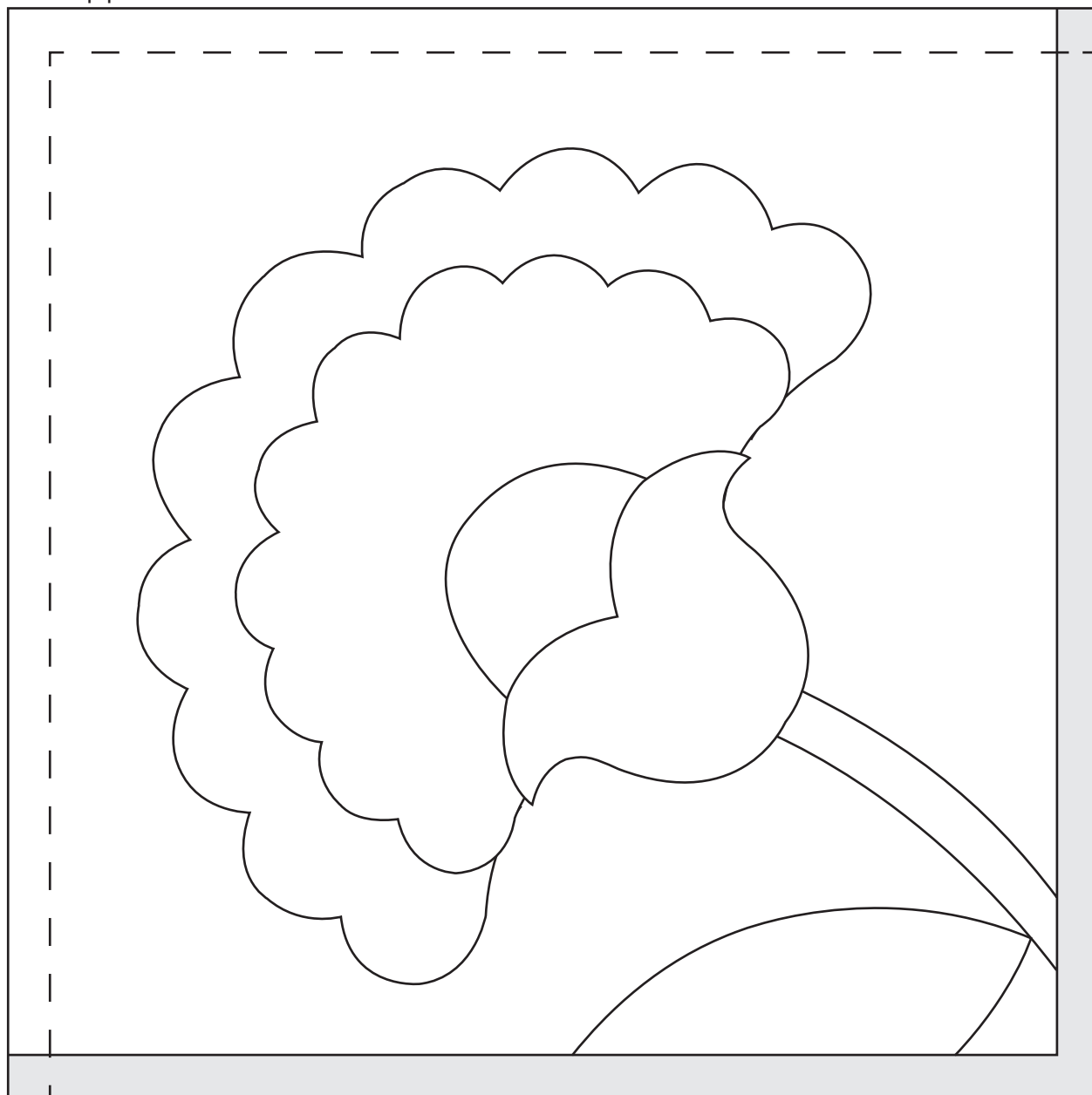


FINISHING: Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich. Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using **C** 2-1/4" strips.

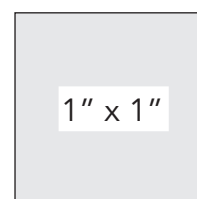
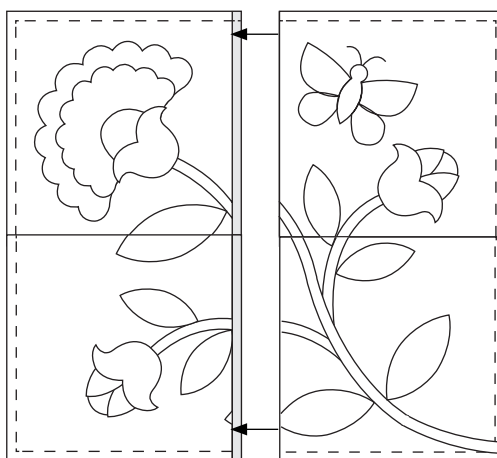

Block Placement Pattern Upper Left



Cut out (4) Block Placement patterns. Place the lower patterns over the gray area of the upper patterns. Tape or glue together. Place the right half over the gray area of the left half. Glue or tape together.

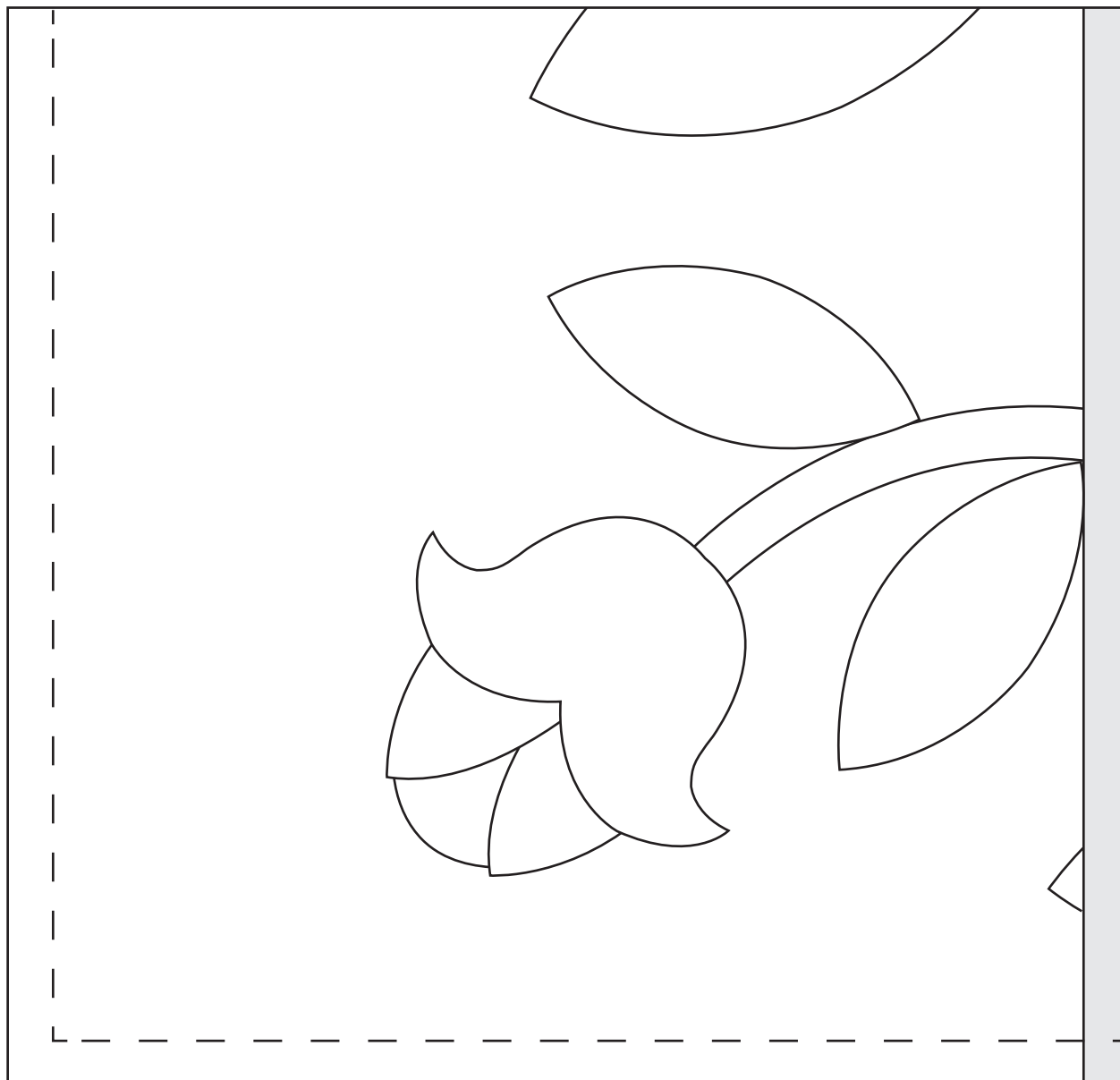


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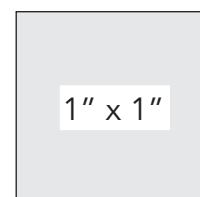
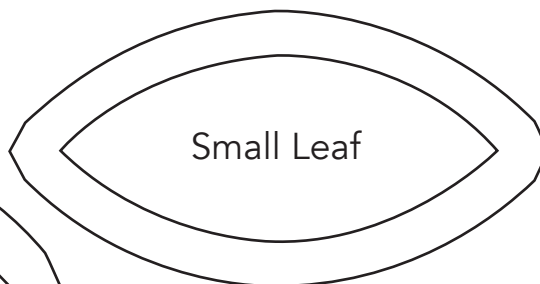
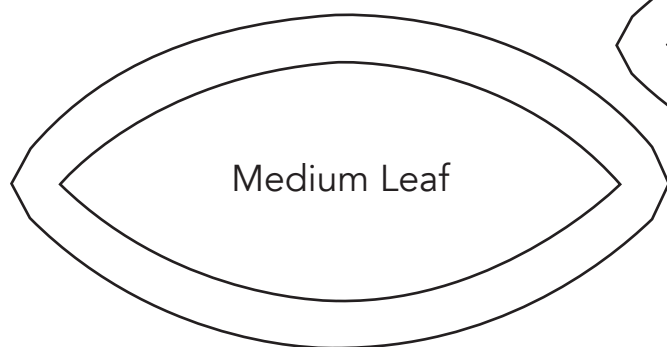

Trace inner lines for raw edge appliqué or paper templates.

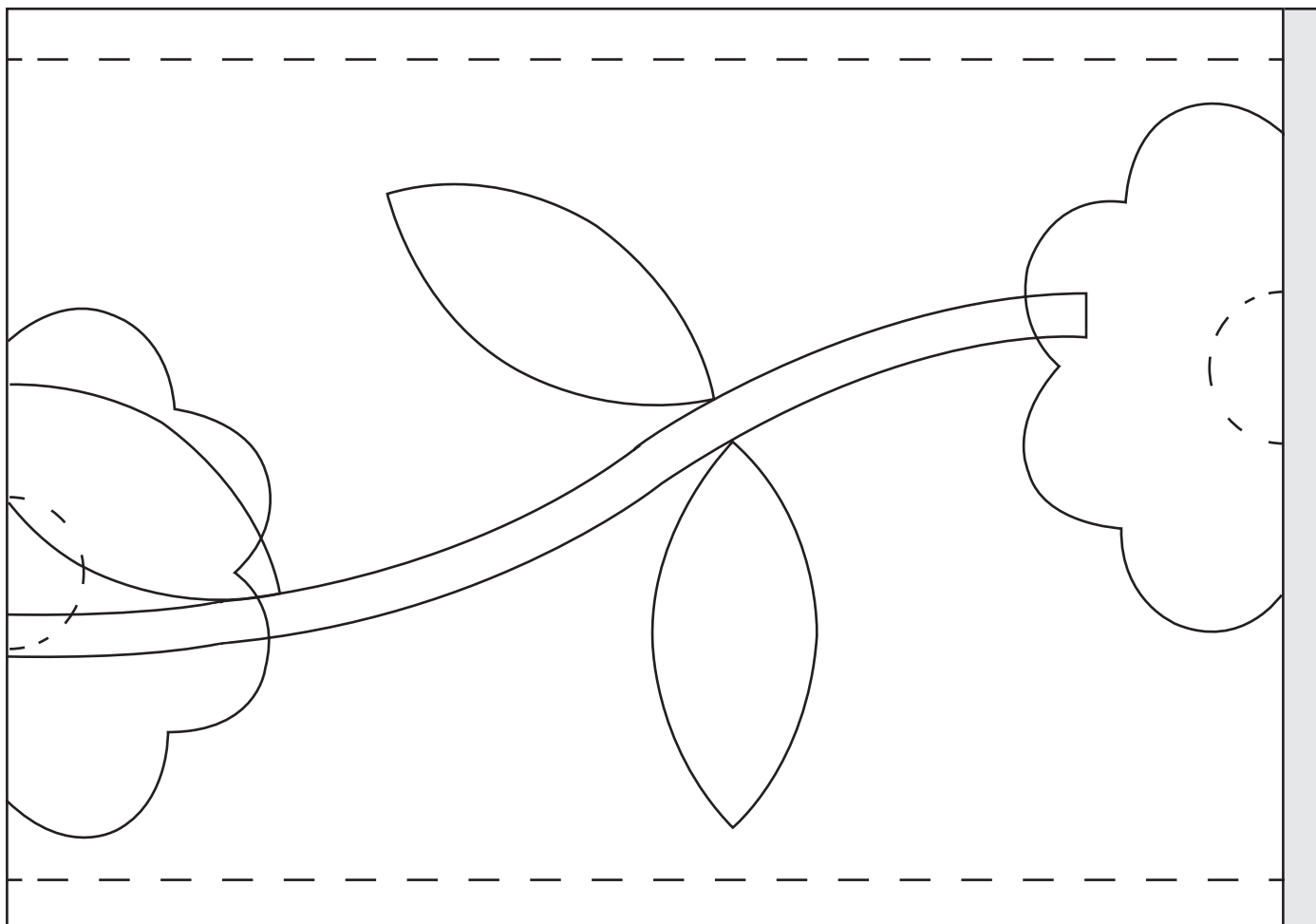
Do not trim or turn under edges along dashed line which will be overlapped.



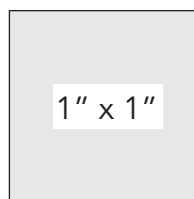
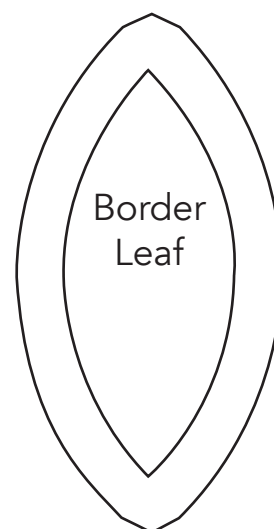
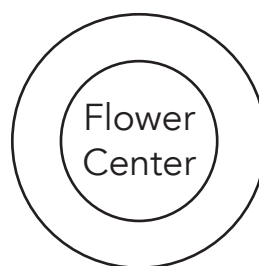
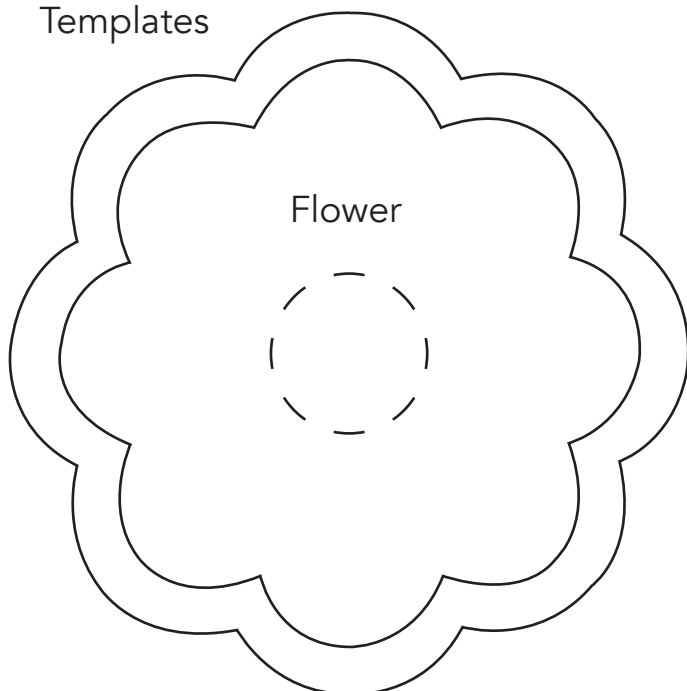

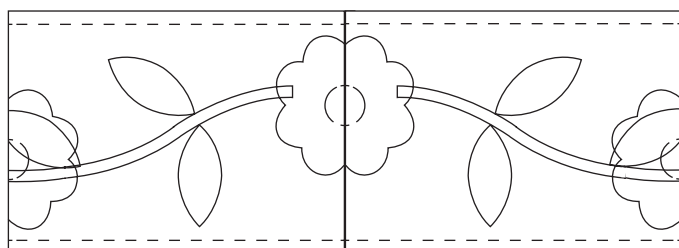
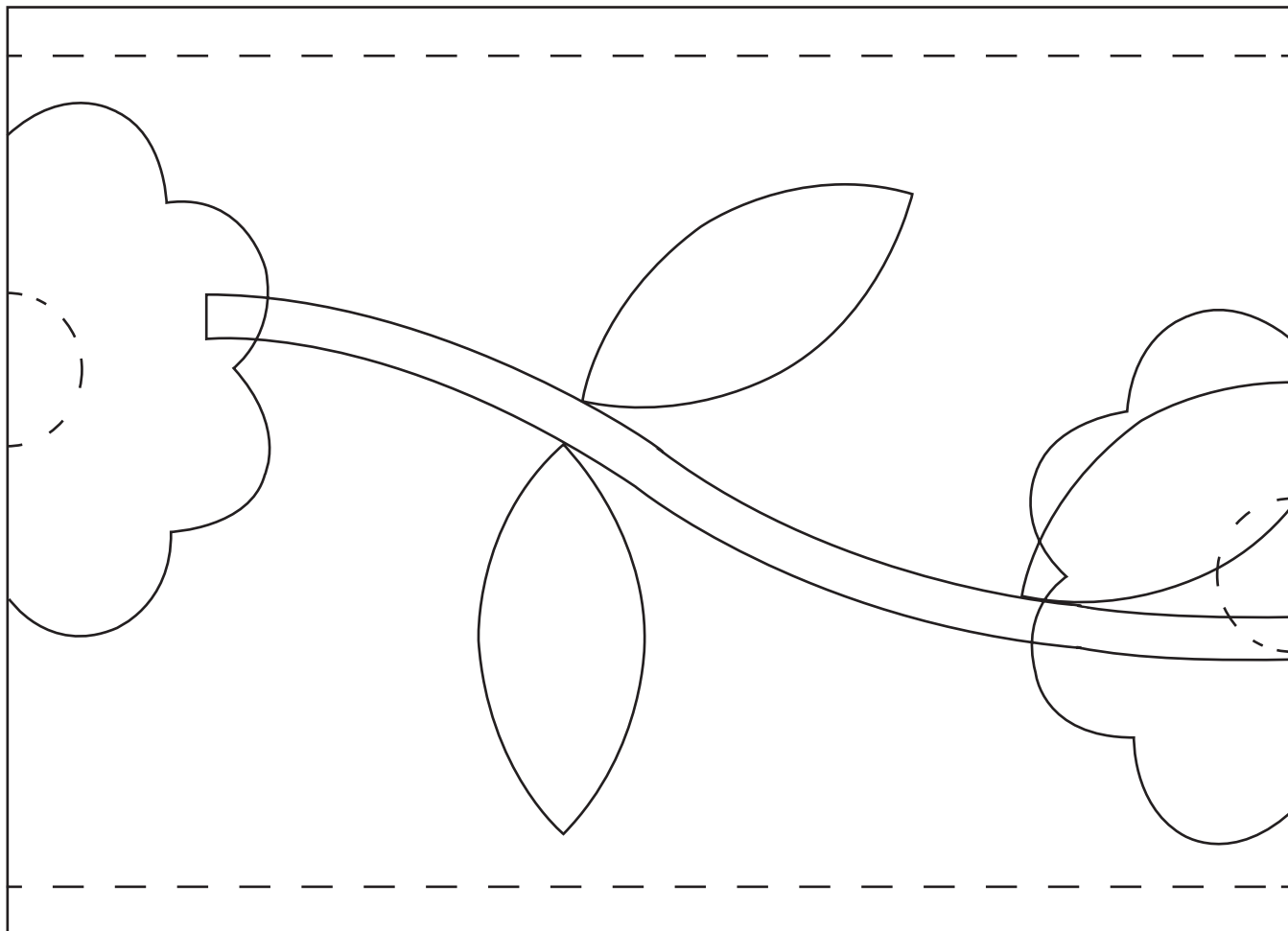


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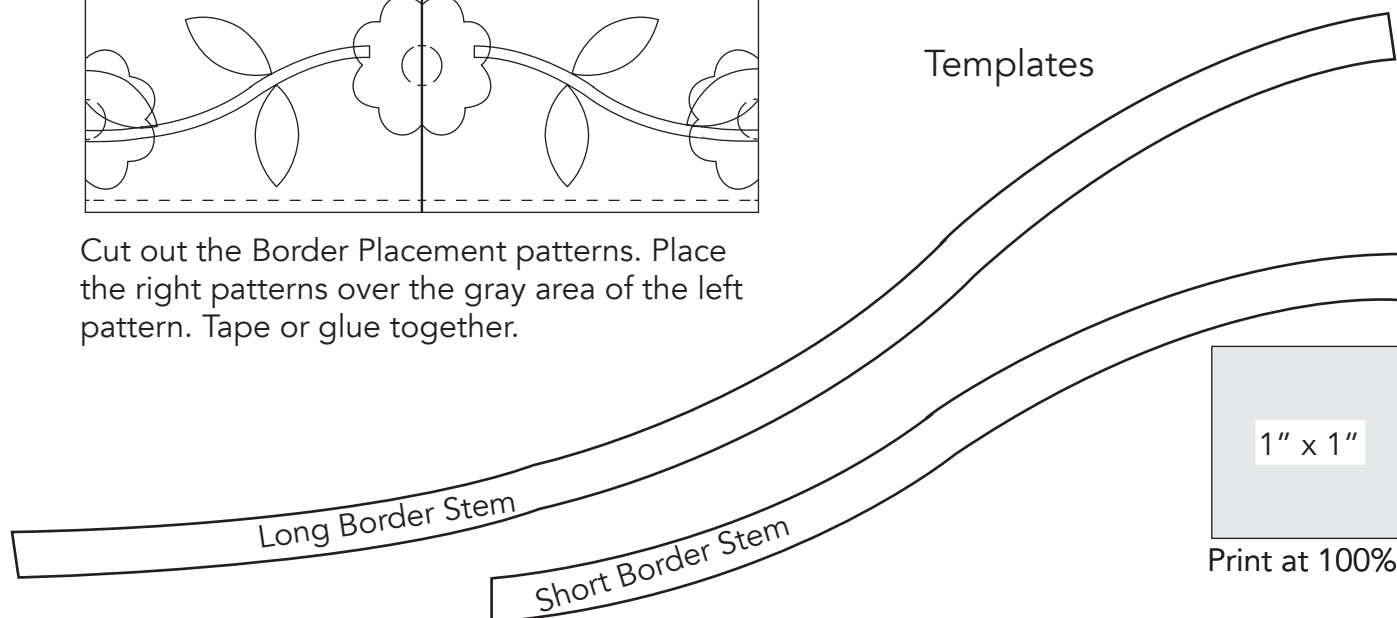
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Border Placement Pattern

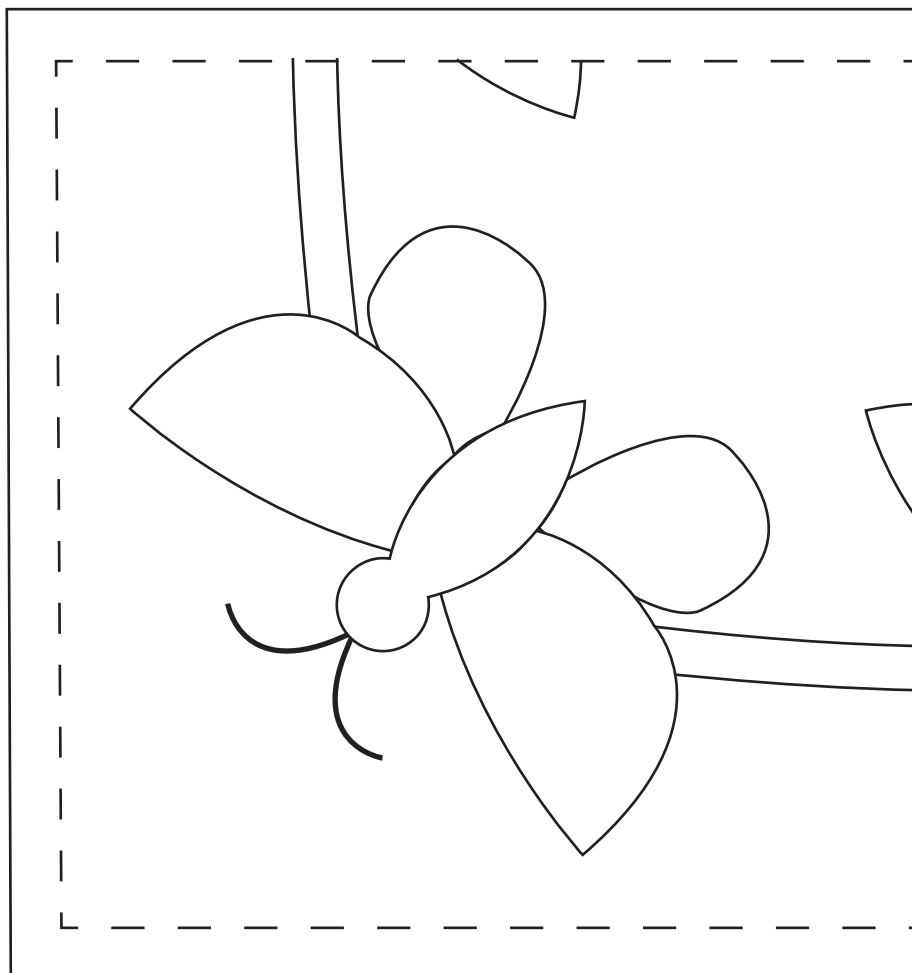


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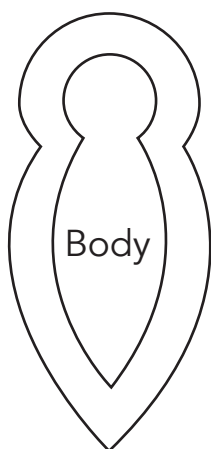

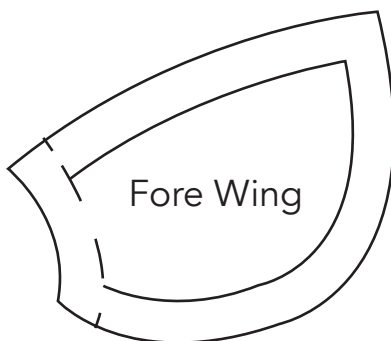
Corner Placement Pattern



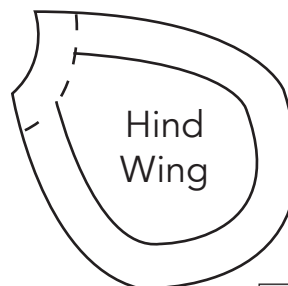

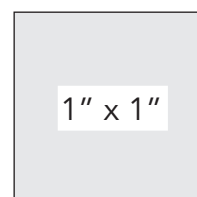
