3 Wishes Fabric® Welcome to the Funny Farm Collection

- 1 Panel – Farm Squad Panel (18727-PNL-CTN-D)
- ½ yard – Tossed Animals (18728-TRQ-CTN-D)
- ¼ yard – Hens (18733-WHT-CTN-D)
- ¼ yard – Animal Patch (18731-MLT-CTN-D)

Additional Supplies Needed:

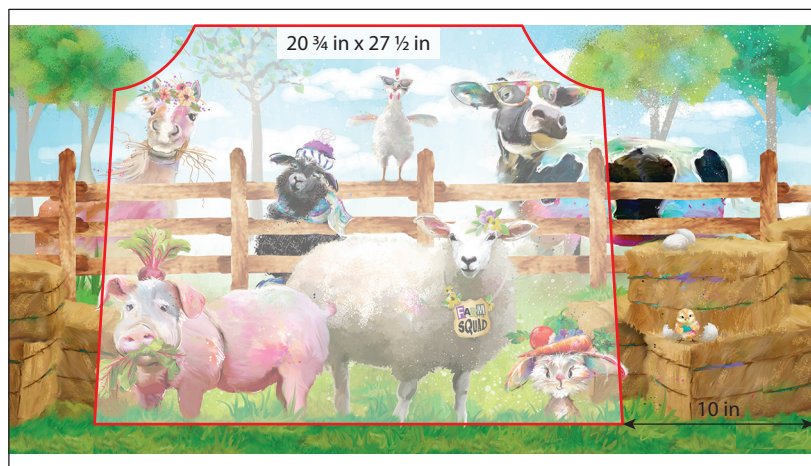
- Coordinating thread
- Basic Sewing Supplies
- Sewing machine
- Iron and pressing surface

Before You Begin

Read all instructions before beginning project. Do not pre-wash fabrics. Press fabrics with a dry iron on cotton setting before cutting. Sew fabrics with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted. Backstitch at the beginning and end of stitching. Seam allowances can be finished using zigzag or serge stitching. Press seams in the direction of arrows.

Note: A printed panel may become slightly skewed during the finishing process. Check if panel is square before cutting by folding the panel so selvages meet. If all edges do not meet, pull firmly from corner to corner until the edges meet. Continue until all corners are square.

Fussy Cut 1 - 20 3/4 in x 27 1/2 in (52.71 cm x 69.85 cm) Apron Body



Tossed Animals (18728-TRQ-CTN-D) 1/2 yard

Cut 2 - 3 1/2 in x 31 1/2 in (8.89 cm x 80.01 cm) Waist Ties

Cut 2 - 3 1/2 in x 26 in (8.89 cm x 66.04 cm) Neck Ties

Cut 1 - 2 1/4 in x 15 in (5.72 cm x 38.1 cm) Apron Top Band



Hens (18733-WHT-CTN-D) 1/4 yard

Fussy Cut 1 - 6 1/2 in x 17 3/4 in (16.51 cm x 45.1 cm) Apron Bodice



Animal Patch (18731-MLT-CTN-D) 1/4 yard

Fussy Cut 1 - 4 3/4 in x 28 in (12.07 cm x 71.12 cm) Bottom Band

Sewing

1. To make the Apron body, measure $1\frac{1}{4}$ in (3.18 cm) from the top left and top right corners of the $20\frac{3}{4}$ in x $27\frac{1}{2}$ in (52.71 cm x 69.85 cm) panel and make a mark. Measure a straight line from the top left mark to the bottom left corner and cut along that line. Repeat for the right side. Align the Apron Body Corner Template with each top corner, trace and cut (Dia. A).

2. To make the Apron bodice, align the Apron Bodice Corner Template with each top corner of the Hens $6\frac{1}{2}$ in x $17\frac{3}{4}$ in (16.51 cm x 45.09 cm), trace and cut (Dia. B).

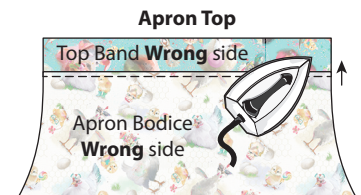


3. Pin the Apron Top Band to the top edge of the Apron Top RST with edges even; sew using a $\frac{1}{4}$ in (6.35 mm) seam allowance (Dia. C).

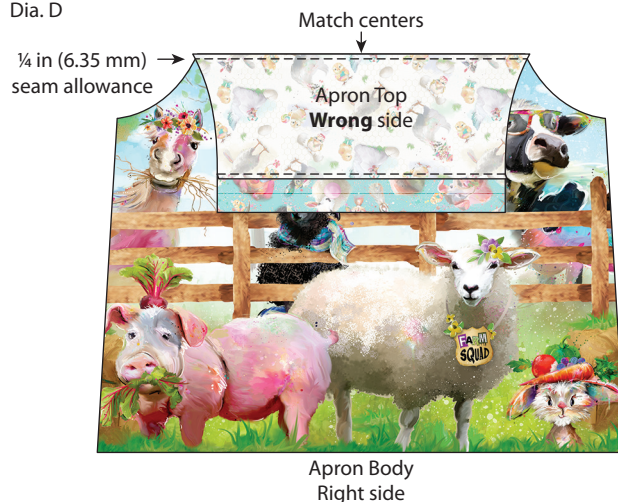

4. Mark the center of the top edge of the Apron Body and the bottom edge of the Apron Top. Pin the Apron Top to the top edge of the Apron Body RST with centers matching and edges even; sew using a $\frac{1}{4}$ in (6.35 mm) seam allowance (Dia. D).

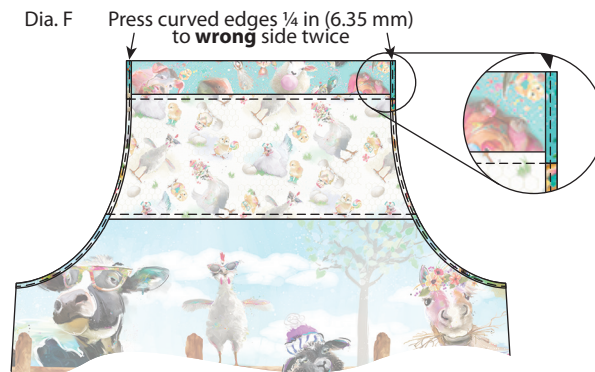

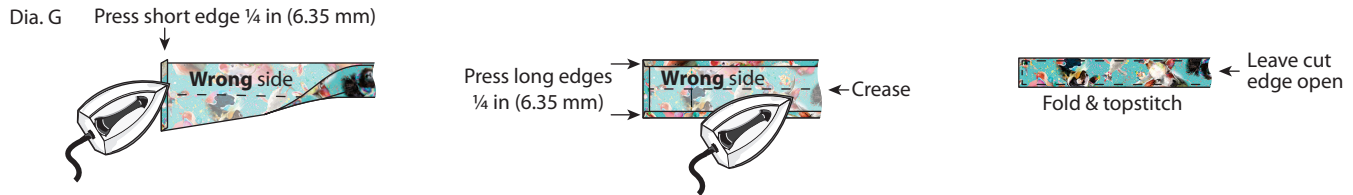
5. Pin the Bottom Band to the bottom edge of the Apron Body RST with edges even; sew using a $\frac{1}{4}$ in (6.35 mm) seam allowance; press and trim side edges (Dia. E).



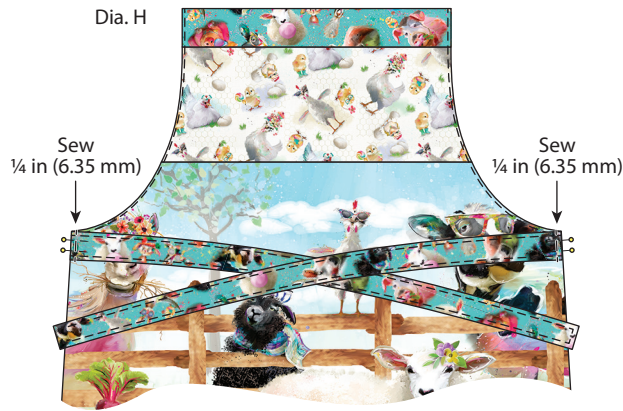
6. Along the side edges of the Apron, press only the curved edges $\frac{1}{4}$ in (6.35 mm) to the **wrong** side, then press again $\frac{1}{4}$ in (6.35 mm) to the **wrong** side. Sew close to the inner fold to hem the edge (Dia. F).



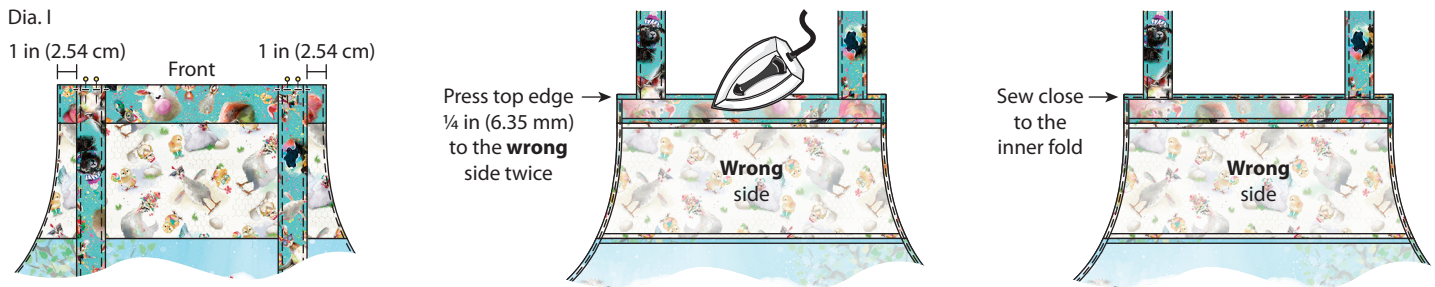
7. Press one short end of a Neck Tie $\frac{1}{4}$ in (6.35 mm) to the **wrong** side. Fold long edges **wrong** sides together so they meet; press to create a crease. Open and fold each long edge $\frac{1}{4}$ in (6.35 mm) to the **wrong** side; press. Fold again so edges meet and press. Topstitch close to each folded edge (Dia. G). Repeat to make all Apron Neck and Waist Ties.



8. On the right side of the Apron, pin the cut end of a Waist Tie to each side edge directly next to the hemmed edge. Sew $\frac{1}{4}$ in (6.35 mm) from the edge to attach (Dia. H).



9. Press the side edges $\frac{1}{4}$ in (6.35 mm) to the **wrong** side, then again $\frac{1}{4}$ in (6.35 mm) to the **wrong** side; pin. Sew close to the folded edge to hem the sides.
10. On the right side of the Apron, at the top edge measure 1 in from each side and pin the cut end of a Neck Tie. Sew $\frac{1}{4}$ in (6.35 mm) from the edge to attach. Press the top edge $\frac{1}{4}$ in (6.35 mm) to the **wrong** side, then again $\frac{1}{4}$ in (6.35 mm) to the **wrong** side; pin. Sew close to the folded edge to hem (Dia. I).



Finishing

11. Press the bottom edge $\frac{1}{4}$ in (6.35 mm) to the **wrong** side, then again $\frac{1}{4}$ in (6.35 mm) to the **wrong** side; pin. Sew close to the inner folded edge to hem the bottom.

Finished Care Instructions

Machine wash in cold water; gentle cycle. Do not bleach. Hang to dry.

Cut out each template. Place on fabric, trace and cut according to the instructions.
