3 Wishes Fabric® Welcome to the Funny Farm Collection

- 1 Panel Barn Scene Panel (18729-PNL-CTN-D)
- 7/8 yard Gingham (18730-RED-CTN-D) for Piecing and Binding
- ³/₄ yard Carrots (18734-MLT-CTN-D)
- ¹/₂ yard Tossed Animals (18728-TRQ-CTN-D)
- 1/2 yard Veggies (18732-MLT-CTN-D)
- ½ yard Hens (18733-WHT-CTN-D)
- ¹/₂ yard Tractors (18735-RED-CTN-D)
- 2 % yards Hens (18733-WHT-CTN-D) for Backing

Additional Supplies Needed:

- 61 in x 67 in (154.94 cm x 170.18 cm) Cotton batting
- · Piecing and sewing thread
- Quilting and sewing supplies
- Even-feed foot (optional for quilting)

Before You Begin

Read all instructions before beginning project. Do not pre-wash fabrics. Press fabrics with a dry iron on cotton setting before cutting. Use a ¼ in (6.35 mm) seam allowance and sew fabrics with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted. Press seams in the direction of the arrows. wof = width of fabric


Note: A printed panel may become slightly skewed during the finishing process. Check if panel is square before cutting by folding the panel so selvages meet. If all edges do not meet, pull firmly from corner to corner until the edges meet. Continue until all corners are square.

Cutting


Use a rotary cutter and ruler to cut the size and number of squares and rectangles from each fabric listed below.



Sewing


 Place a Gingham strip 2 ½ in x 38 ½ in (6.35 cm x 97.79 cm) on each side of the Fussy Cut Barn Scene Panel rectangle 32 ½ in x 38 ½ in (82.55 cm x 97.79 cm). Pin RST matching ends and centers, sew and press. Place a Gingham strip 2 ½ in x 36 ½ in (6.35 cm x 92.71 cm) on the top and bottom. Pin RST matching ends and centers, sew and press. The Center Unit should measure 36 ½ in x 42 ½ in (92.71 cm x 107.95 cm).




Alternate seven Hens rectangles 3 ½ in x 16 in (8.89 cm x 40.64 cm) with seven Tossed Animal rectangles 3 ½ in x 16 in (8.89 cm x 40.64 cm) as shown in Diagram B. Pin RST, sew and press. The strip set should measure 16 in x 42 ½ in (40.64 cm x 107.95 cm).




3. Refer to Diagram C to straighten (trim) one side of the Strip Set and cut into four Hens/Tossed Animal Borders 3 ½ in x 42 ½ in (8.89 cm x 107.95 cm).




3. Follow Step 2 and Diagram D to alternate eight Veggies rectangles 3 ½ in x 16 in (8.89 cm x 40.64 cm) with eight Tractors rectangles 3 ½ in x 16 in (8.89 cm x 40.64 cm) to make four Veggies/Tractors Borders 3 ½ in x 48 ½ in (8.89 cm x 123.19 cm). *Note: Check orientation of designs.*



4. Place two Carrots rectangles 2 ½ in x 24 ½ in (6.35 cm x 62.23 cm) as shown in Diagram E. *Note: Check orientation of designs*. Pin RST, sew and press open or to one side to make the Carrots Top Border 2 ½ in x 48 ½ in (6.35 cm x 123.19 cm). Repeat to make the Carrots Bottom Border.



5. Place two Carrots rectangles 2 ½ in x 29 ½ in (6.35 cm x 74.93 cm) as shown in Diagram F. Pin RST, sew and press open or to one side to make the Carrots Side Border 2 ½ in x 58 ½ in (6.35 cm x 148.59 cm). Make 2.



6. Refer to Diagram G to place the Borders around the Center Unit 36 ½ in x 42 ½ in (92.71 cm x 107.95 cm). Sew each Border RST in the order listed. Pin matching center, seams and ends. *Note:* Check orientation of designs. Press seams as shown. Measure at each step to ensure the next border will fit. *Tip:* If one border is a little larger than the border it is being sewn to, pin well to ease the fullness and place the fullness on the bottom while sewing. Finished Quilt Top should measure 52 ½ in x 58 ½ in (133.35 cm x 148.59 cm).

(2) Sides: Made in Step 3 - 3 ½ in x 42 ½ in (8.89 cm x 107.95 cm) (2) Top and Bottom: Made in Step 3 - 3 ½ in x 42 ½ in (8.89 cm x 107.95 cm)

Quilt Top: 42 1/2 in x 48 1/2 in (107.95 cm x 123.19 cm)

Veggies/Tractor Border

(2) Sides: Made in Step 3 - 3 ½ in x 48 ½ in (8.89 cm x 123.19 cm)
(2) Top and Bottom: Made in Step 3 3 ½ in x 48 ½ in (8.89 cm x 123.19 cm)

Quilt Top: 48 ½ in x 54 ½ in (123.19 cm x 138.43 cm)

Carrots Border

(2) Top and Bottom: Made in Step 4 - 2 ½ in x 48 ½ in (6.35 cm x 123.19 cm) (2) Sides: Made in Step 5 - 2 ½ in x 58 ½ in (6.35 cm x 148.59 cm)




Finishing

18. Remove the selvages from the Hens Backing fabric. Cut one piece 40 ¼ in x 67 in (102.24 cm x 170.18 cm) and two pieces 21 ¼ in x 33 ¾ in (53.98 cm x 85.73 cm). Pin RST and sew the two smaller pieces on the short edges; press. Pin the two sections RST along the long edges as shown in Diagram H. The Backing should measure 61 in x 67 in (154.94 cm x 170.18 cm).

- 19. Press finished Quilt Top and Backing. Tape the Backing, **wrong** side up, to a firm surface. Layer Batting and Quilt Top (right side up). Baste the layers together with safety pins. Quilt as desired.
- 20. Once quilting is complete, square up corners and edges, trimming excess Backing and Batting even with the Quilt Top.
- 21. Follow Diagram I to make the Gingham Binding. Remove selvages and sew the short ends of the six 2 ½ in (6.35 cm) x wof strips RST end to end at a 45° angle to make one continuous strip; press seams open. Press one short end ¼ in (6.35 mm) to the **wrong** side. Fold in half lengthwise with **wrong** sides together; press. Leaving a 2 in (5.08 cm) tail on the folded end, place cut edges of folded Binding even with the edge of the Quilt Top and sew, mitering the corners. Overlap ends, trim any excess and finish sewing the Binding. Fold Binding over to back and hand stitch.



Finished Care Instructions

Machine wash in cold water; gentle cycle. Do not bleach. **Tip:** Before drying, check for fabric dyes that may have run. If fabric dyes run, rewash and rinse using a color catcher to absorb loose dye. Lay flat to dry or tumble dry low.
