# Blue Breeze

Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning.

All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.

## 1. Cut the following:


PLEASE NOTE:


Cut all 4-7/8" squares in half diagonally for the  number of triangles indicated in [ ].


**Fabric A** - PLEASE NOTE: Panels do not always print the size intended. For this pattern, the panel has a coping border added then trimmed so the panel will fit the quilt correctly.


Fussy cut 1/4" beyond outside edges of panel to approximately 23-1/2" x 42"

**Fabric B** - Referring to the quilt image, fussy cut strips, the length of fabric parallel to selvage: (2) 8-3/4" x 95" and (2) 8-3/4" x 83" multi-stripe borders

**Fabric C** - Cut (4) 4-7/8" strips, subcut (26) 4-7/8" squares  [52]

**Fabric D** - Cut (4) 4-7/8" strips, subcut (28) 4-7/8" squares  [56]  
Cut (1) 2-1/2" strip, subcut (10) 2-1/2" squares

**Fabric E** - Cut (4) 4-7/8" strips, subcut (26) 4-7/8" squares  [52] and (10) 2-1/2" squares

**Fabric F** - Cut (4) 4-7/8" strips, subcut (28) 4-7/8" squares  [56]

**Fabric G** - Cut (9) 4-1/2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 4-1/2" x 91" and (2) 4-1/2" x 87" borders

**Fabric H** - Cut (10) 2-1/2" strips (binding)

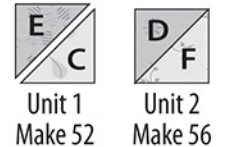
**Fabric I** - Cut (4) 3" strips. Sew 2 strips together end to end and cut into (1) 3" x 45-1/2" and (1) 3" x 30-1/2" borders. Repeat for 2 of each length border.

**Fabric J** - Cut (2) 2-3/4" strips, subcut (2) 2-3/4" x 27" strips  
Cut (7) 2-1/2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 2-1/2" x 70-1/2" and (2) 2-1/2" x 62-1/2" borders  
Cut (3) 4-1/2" strips, subcut (48) 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" pieces  
Cut (2) 2" strips

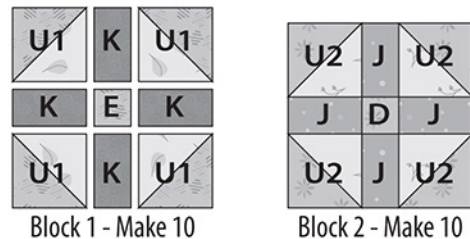
**Fabric K** - Cut (3) 4-1/2" strips, subcut (46) 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" pieces

## 2. Piecing Order:

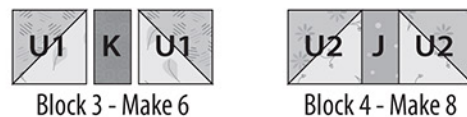
1. Sew 1 each **Fabrics C** and **E** 4-7/8" triangles together along their long edges. Make a total of 52 Unit 1 (4-1/2" square unfinished). In the same manner, make 56 Unit 2 with fabrics indicated.



2. Arrange 4 Unit 1, 1 **Fabric E** 2-1/2" square, and 4 **Fabric K** 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" pieces in 3 rows. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 10 **Block 1** (10-1/2" square unfinished). In the same manner, make 10 **Block 2** with fabrics and units indicated.



3. Arrange 2 Unit 1 and 1 **Fabric K** 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" piece in a row. Stitch together. Make a total of 6 **Block 3** (4-1/2" x 10-1/2" unfinished). In the same manner, make 8 **Block 4** with fabric and units indicated.



4. Refer to Quilt Layout (Page 3) for arrangement and placement of panel, strips, blocks, and borders.

5. Stitch **Fabric J** 2" x width of fabric strips to sides of the **Fabric A** panel. Trim strip ends even. Add 2-3/4" x 27" **Fabric J** strips to top and bottom of panel. **Trim bordered panel to 25-1/2" x 45-1/2" (unfinished).**

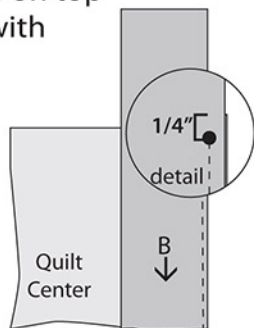
6. Sew **Fabric I** 3" x 45-1/2" borders to right and left sides of bordered panel. Add **Fabric I** 3" x 30-1/2" borders to top and bottom of bordered panel. Bordered panel now measures 30-1/2" x 50-1/2" (unfinished).

7. Arrange 2 **Block 1**, 3 **Block 2**, 3 **Block 3**, and 2 **Block 4** in 5 rows on each side of bordered panel. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together (14-1/2" x 50-1/2" unfinished). Stitch to sides of bordered panel.

8. Arrange 3 **Block 1**, 2 **Block 2**, and 2 **Block 4** in rows above and below bordered panel. Stitch into top and bottom borders (10-1/2" x 58-1/2" unfinished). Stitch to top and bottom of bordered panel. Quilt center measures 58-1/2" x 70-1/2" (unfinished).

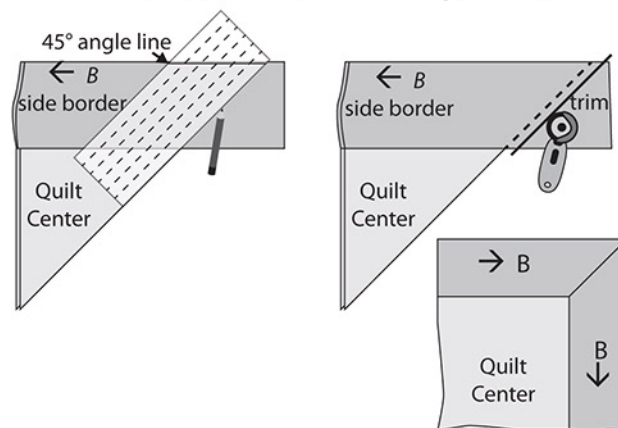
9. Sew **Fabric J** 2-1/2" x 70-1/2" borders to right and left sides of quilt center. Add **Fabric J** 2-1/2" x 62-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt center. Quilt center now measures 62-1/2" x 74-1/2" (unfinished).

10. Center **Fabric B** 8-3/4" x 95" borders on right and left sides of quilt center and **Fabric B** 8-3/4" x 83" borders on top and bottom of quilt center with the light stripe next to quilt center. Stitch borders to sides starting and stopping 1/4" from corners of quilt center. Do not trim. Press borders out.



*Letters in italics indicate wrong side of fabric.  
Arrows indicate orientation of directional prints.*

11. Working with 1 corner at a time, fold the quilt right sides together so the outside edges of the borders line up. Using a 45-degree ruler, mark from the end of border seams to outer edges of borders. Stitch along marked line. Trim seam allowance to 1/4". Press corner seam open. Repeat on remaining corners.



12. Sew **Fabric G** 4-1/2" x 91" borders to right and left sides of quilt. Add **Fabric G** 4-1/2" x 87" borders to top and bottom of quilt.

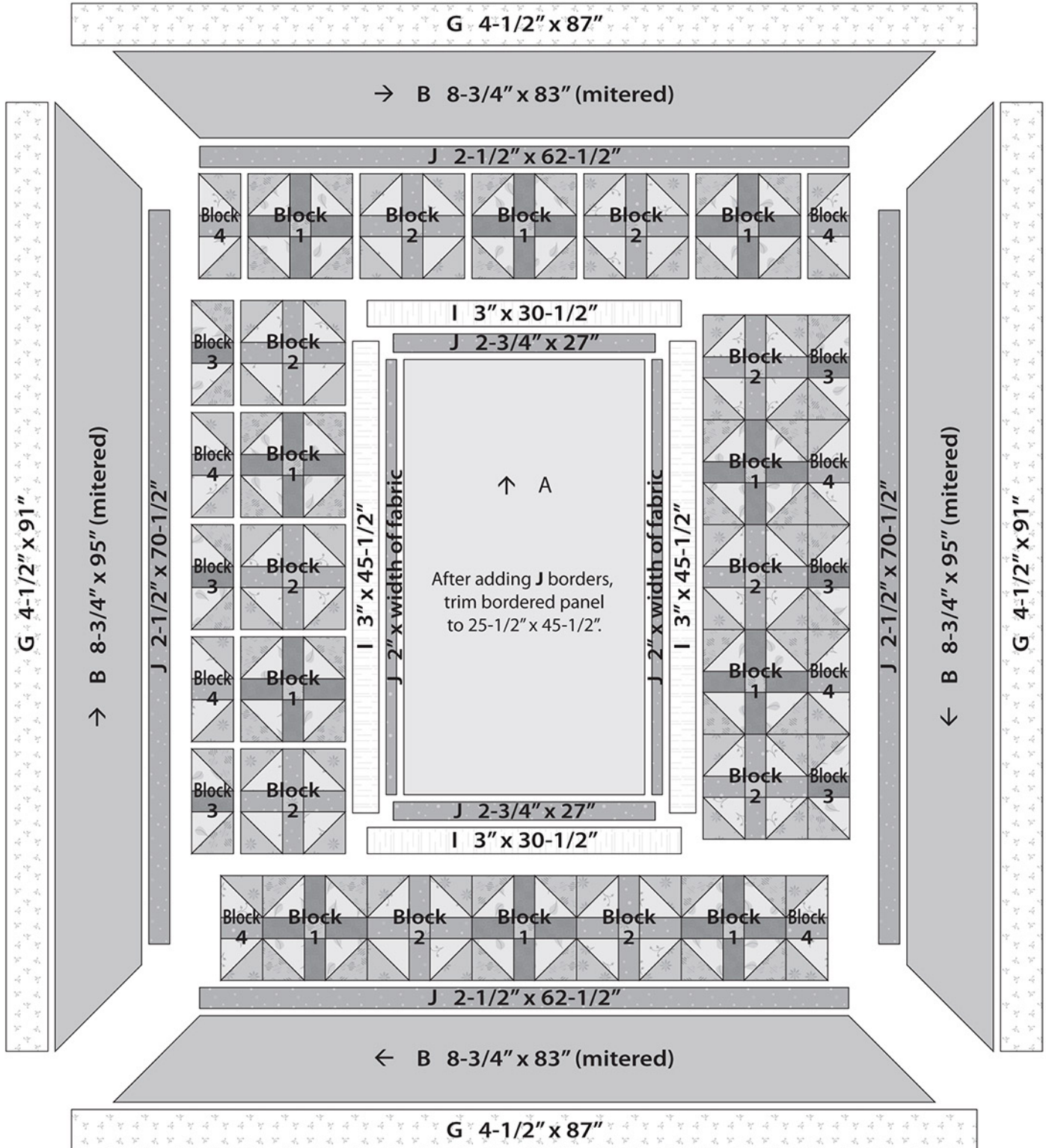
13. The quilt measures approximately 87" x 99" (unfinished). Make backing (**Fabric L**) approximately 8" larger than the top.

14. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric H**) and enjoy!!

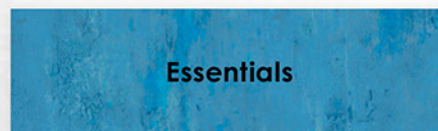

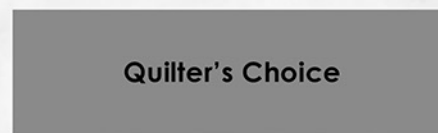
