
3041 Mint Crush By Lisa Audit



Twin Quilt: 64" x 81 1/2"





Mint Crush

Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning. All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.

1. Cut the following:

PLEASE NOTE:

Cut all 4-3/8" squares in half diagonally for the number of triangles indicated in [].

Fabric A - PLEASE NOTE: Panels do not always print the size intended. For this pattern, the panel has a coping border added then trimmed so the panel will fit the quilt correctly.

Fussy cut 1/4" beyond outside right and left edges of panel to approximately 23-1/2" wide. Cut panel to 41-1/2" tall.

Fabric B - Referring to the guilt image, fussy cut strips, the length of fabric parallel to selvage: (2) 5-1/2" x 82 and (2) 5-1/2" x 64 wide floral stripe borders

Fabric C - Cut (3) 4-3/8" strips, subcut (20) 4-3/8" squares [// [40] and (8) 4" squares

Fabric D - Cut (2) 7 1/2" strips, subcut (2) 7 1/2" x 11" pieces, (4) 7 1/2" squares, and (6) 4 3/8" squares [[cut 3 in 1 direction and 3 in the opposite direction for 12 triangles]

Fabric E - Cut (4) 4-3/8" strips, subcut (30) 4-3/8" squares [60]

Fabric F - Cut (2) 2-1/4" strips Cut (2) 1-1/2" strips, subcut (2) 1-1/2" x 26" strips Cut (6) 1-1/2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 1-1/2" x 64" and (2) 1-1/2" x 46-1/2" flat piping strips

Fabric G - Cut (2) 4-3/8" strips, subcut (16) 4-3/8" squares [/ [32]

Fabric H - Cut (4) 1-3/4" strips. Sew 2 strips together end to end and cut into (1) 1-3/4" x 43-1/2" and (1) 1-3/4" x 28-1/2" borders. Repeat for a total of 2 each length border.

Fabric I - Cut (13) 2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 2" x 78", (2) 2" x 64-1/2", (2) 2" x 64", and (2) 2" x 50-1/2" borders

Fabric J - Cut (6) 2-1/2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 2-1/2" x 60" and (2) 2-1/2" x 46-1/2" borders

Fabric K - Cut (8) 2-1/2" strips (binding)

2. Piecing Order:

1. Sew 1 each **Fabrics C** and **D** 4-3/8" triangles together along their long edges. Make a total of 3 each Units 1a-1d (4" square unfinished), noting orientation of triangles.

2. Sew 1 each Fabrics C and **E** 4-3/8" triangles together along their long edges. Make a total of 28 Unit 2 (4" square unfinished). In the same manner, make 32 Unit 3.

3. Draw a diagonal line across the wrong side of each of the **Fabric C** 4" squares.



Letters in italics indicate wrong side of fabric.

4. Arrange a marked **Fabric C** 4" square right sides together on the bottom right corner of a Fabric D 7-1/2" square as shown. Stitch along marked line. Trim seam allowance to 1/4". Press corner out to complete Unit 4a (7-1/2" square unfinished).

5. In the same manner, make 1 each Units 4b-4d noting placement of corner to which Fabric C square is added.

6. Using the same stitch-and-flip technique in Step 4, use 2 marked Fabric C squares to create triangles on bottom corners of a **Fabric D** 7-1/2" x 11" piece. Make a total of 2 Unit 5 (7-1/2" x 11" unfinished).

7. Refer to Quilt Layout (Page 3) for arrangement and placement of panel, strips, units, and borders.

- 8. Stitch Fabric F 2-1/4" x width of fabric strips to sides of the **Fabric A** panel. Trim strip ends even. Trim bordered panel to 26" wide. Add 1-1/2" x 26" Fabric F strips to top and bottom of panel. Bordered panel measures 26" x 43-1/2" (unfinished).
- 9. Sew **Fabric H** 1-3/4" x 43-1/2" borders to right and left sides of bordered panel. Add Fabric H 1-3/4" x 28-1/2" borders to top and bottom of bordered panel.
- 10. Arrange 1 each Units 1a-1d, 8 each Units 2 and 3, and 1 Unit 5 in 11 rows on right and left sides of quilt. Stitch into rows. Sew rows into borders (7-1/2" x 46" unfinished). Stitch to right and left sides of quilt.
- 11. Arrange 1 each Units 1a and 1b, 6 Unit 2, and 8 Unit 3 in 2 rows above quilt. Sew into rows. Stitch rows together. Add Units 4a and 4b to ends of border (7-1/2" x 42-1/2" unfinished). Sew to top of quilt.
- 12. Arrange 1 each Units 1c and 1d, 6 Unit 2, and 8 Unit 3 in 2 rows below quilt. Sew into rows. Stitch rows together. Add Units 4c and 4d to ends of border (7-1/2" x 42-1/2" unfinished). Sew to bottom of quilt.
- 13. Sew Fabric J 2-1/2" x 60" borders to right and left sides of quilt. Add Fabric J 2-1/2" x 46-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt.
- 14. Fold and press Fabric F 1-1/2" x 64" and 1-1/2" x 46-1/2" strips in half lengthwise, right side out, forming 3/4" wide flat piping strips.
- 15. Baste 3/4" x 64" Fabric F flat piping strips on top of sides of quilt, with raw edges even with raw edges of Fabric J border. Baste 3/4" x 46-1/2" Fabric F flat piping on top of top and bottom of quilt, with raw edges even with raw edges of Fabric J border.



16. Sew Fabric I 2-1/2" x 64" borders to right and left sides of quilt. Press seam allowances toward Fabric I borders leaving flat piping over Fabric J borders. Add Fabric I 2-1/2" x 50-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt.

17. Center Fabric B 5-1/2" x 82" borders on right and left sides of quilt and Fabric B 5-1/2" x 64" borders on top and bottom of quilt. Stitch 1/4" borders to sides starting and stopping 1/4" from detail corners of quilt center. Do not trim. Press $\stackrel{B}{\rightarrow}$ Quilt borders out. Center

18. Working with 1 corner at a time, fold the quilt right sides together so the outside edges of the borders line up. Using a 45-degree ruler, mark from the end of border seams to outer edges of borders. Stitch along marked line. Trim seam allowance to 1/4". Press corner seam open. Repeat on remaining corners.




- 19. Sew **Fabric I** 2-1/2" x 78" borders to right and left sides of quilt. Add Fabric I 2-1/2" x 64-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt.
- 20. The quilt measures approximately 64-1/2" x 82" (unfinished). Make backing (**Fabric L**) approximately 8" larger than the
- 21. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (Fabric K) and enjoy!!
