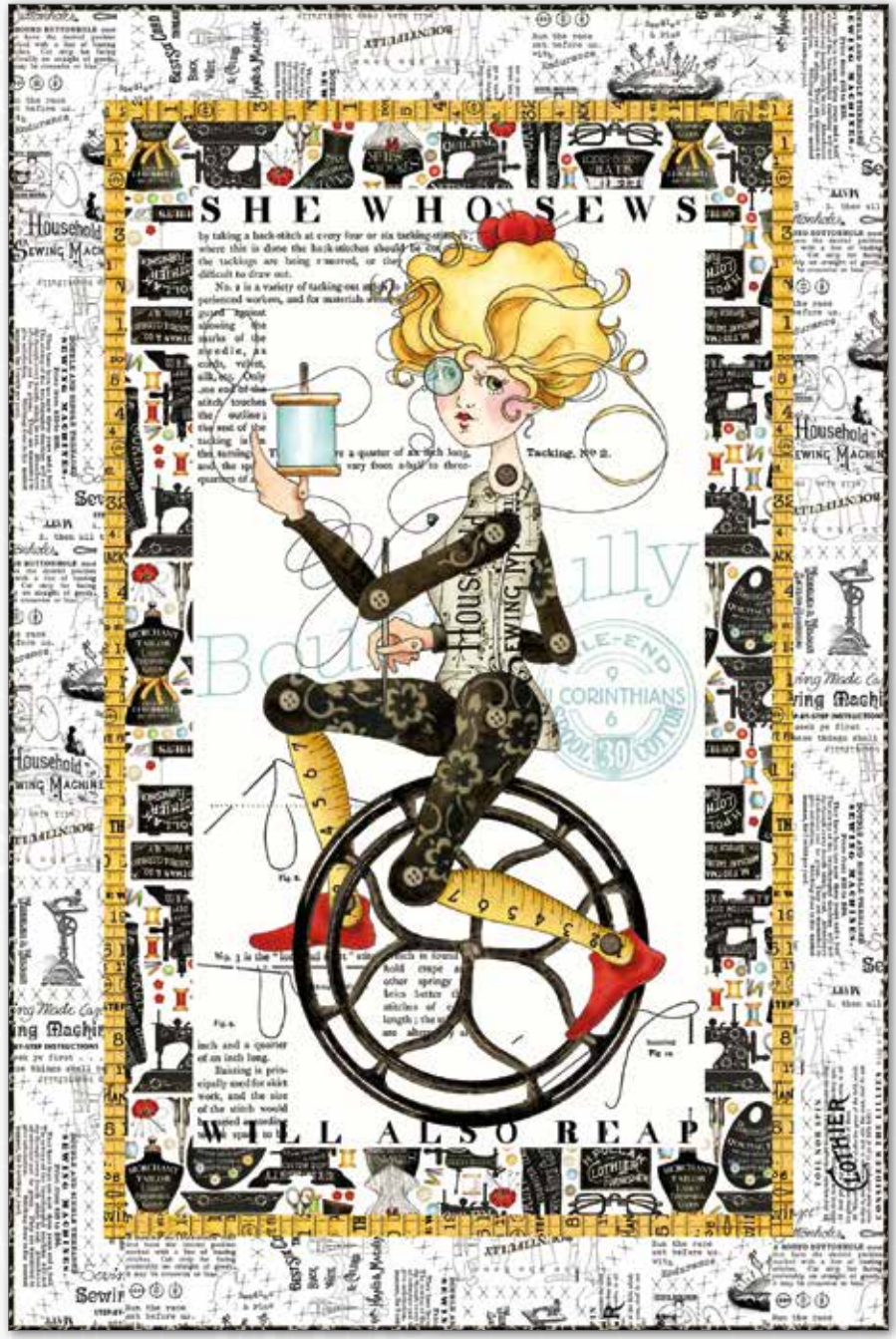

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

1 PD11330 She Who Sews Main Panel

¼ Yard C11331 Yellow Vintage Tapes

½ Yard CD11337 White Shop Sign Tins

½ Yard C11341 Black Flower Stencils

⅞ Yard C11343 White Vintage Text

CUTTING REQUIREMENTS

Please read instructions first before cutting. Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces.

She Who Sews Panel

Cut 1 rectangle 24" x 43½".

White Shop Sign Tins

Cut 4 strips 3½" x WOF for Border 1.

Yellow Vintage Tapes

Cut 5 strips 1½" x WOF for Border 2.

White Vintage Text

Cut 5 strips 4½" x WOF for Border 3.

Black Flower Stencils

Cut 6 strips 2½" x WOF for Binding.

QUILT ASSEMBLY

Refer to the quilt photo for placement of fabrics.

Borders

Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces. Sew border strips together end to end if necessary to get the length needed. Sew side borders first.

Border 1

Side borders should be 43½". Top and bottom borders should be 30".

Border 2

Side borders should be 49½". Top and bottom borders should be 32".

Border 3

Side borders should be 51½". Top and bottom borders should be 40".

Finish quilt by layering the quilt top, batting, and back. Bind with Black Flower Stencils. Have fun with your colors and enjoy the journey of making your quilt.
