56½" x 56½"

#### **GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS**

- Read through all instructions before beginning the project.
- Featured fabrics are Best of She Who Sews from Riley Blake Designs.
- Refer to cover art and quilt layout diagram for fabric choices/placement.
- Fabric quantities are for 43"/44" wide, 100% cotton fabrics.
- Measurements include a 1/4" seam allowance unless otherwise stated.

## **CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS**

- WOF width of fabric.
- Label pieces as they are cut.

## **FABRIC REQUIREMENTS**

5/8 Yard Black Sew Vintage Text (C11343)

1/4 Yard Gray Baby Button Toss (C11342)

5/8 Yard Gray Low Volume Spool Tops (C11338)

1/2 Yard Gray Sew Vintage Text (C11343)

1/2 Yard Gray Vintage Tapes (C11331)

1/8 Yard White Tiny Toy Sewing Machines (C11334)

1 3/4 Yards Riley White Confetti Cotton Solid (C120)

## **Black Sew Vintage Text**

Cut 1 strip 3½" x WOF. Sub-cut:

A - 6 squares 3½" x 3½"

Cut for Binding:

6 strips 21/2" x WOF

## **Gray Baby Button Toss**

Cut 2 strips 3½" x WOF. Sub-cut:

B - 14 squares 31/2" x 31/2"

## **Gray Low Volume Spool Tops**

Cut 3 strips 61/2" x WOF. Sub-cut:

C - 16 squares 61/2" x 61/2"

## **Gray Sew Vintage Text**

Cut 2 strips 6 7/8" x WOF. Sub-cut:

D - 8 squares 6 7/8" x 6 7/8" and then cut once on the diagonal for a total of 16 triangles.

Cut 1 strip 3½" x WOF. Sub-cut:

E - 12 squares 31/2" x 31/2"

## **Gray Vintage Tapes**

Cut 2 strips 6 7/8" x WOF. Sub-cut:

F - 8 squares 6 7/8" x 6 7/8" and then cut once on the diagonal for a total of 16 triangles.

## White Tiny Toy Sewing Machines

Cut 1 strip 3 7/8" x WOF. Sub-cut:

G - 8 squares 3 7/8" x 3 7/8" and then cut once on the diagonal for a total of 16 triangles.

## **Riley White Confetti Cotton**

Cut 3 strips 61/2" x WOF. Sub-cut:

H - 16 squares 61/2" x 61/2"

Cut 3 strips 3 7/8" x WOF. Sub-cut:

I - 24 squares 3 7/8" x 3 7/8" and then cut once on the diagonal for a total of 48 triangles.

Cut 6 strips 41/2" x WOF for borders.



#### PIECING INSTRUCTIONS


- All pieces are sewn with right sides together.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise stated.

#### Unit A

Sew an I triangle to the top of an E square and press.



Sew a G triangle to the adjacent side of the E square and press.



With right sides together, sew a D triangle to the pieced triangle and press. Repeat to make a total of 12 Unit A.  $(6\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $6\frac{1}{2}$ ")



## Unit B

Following the instructions for Unit A, sew a G triangle and an I triangle to the sides of an A square. Then sew a D triangle to the pieced triangle. Repeat to make a total of 4 Unit B.  $(6\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $6\frac{1}{2}$ ")



#### Unit C

Following the instructions for Unit A, sew two I triangles to the sides of a B square. Then sew an F triangle to the pieced triangle. Repeat to make a total of 14 Unit C.  $(6\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $6\frac{1}{2}$ ")



## Unit D

Following the instructions for Unit A, sew two I triangles to the sides of an A square. Then sew an F triangle to the pieced triangle. Repeat to make a total of 2 Unit D.  $(6\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $6\frac{1}{2}$ ")



## **QUILT ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS**

- Refer to quilt layout diagram on the next page for block placement.
- Piece and sew the borders to match the measurements of your assembled quilt center. Measurements provided are a guide.
- Attach side borders first.

## Rows

Lay out blocks in 8 rows of 8 blocks. Sew together in rows  $(6\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $48\frac{1}{2}$ ").

## **Quilt Center**

Sew the rows together to complete the quilt center  $(48\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $48\frac{1}{2}$ ").

## **Borders**

Cut 2 side borders  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $48\frac{1}{2}$ ". Cut 2 top and bottom borders  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $56\frac{1}{2}$ ".

## **FINISHING**

Layer the quit top, batting and quilt back as desired. Trim excess batting and backing even with the quilt top and bind with the black sew vintage text strip.
