

BH4 Block 1 – Square Wheel

Color/shading options.

Piecing & Cutting Notes:

 This block uses connector/flip-and-sew corners for the D triangles.

Cutting Instructions:

9" Finished Block:

- A (4) squares 31/2" x 31/2"
- B (8) rectangles 2" x 3½" (4 each.)
- C (9) squares $\frac{1}{2}$ " $\times \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times (4 + 4 + 1)$
- D (16) squares 2" x 2"

41/2" Finished Block:

- A (4) squares 2" x 2"
- B (8) rectangles 11/4" x 2" (4 each.)
- C (9) squares $1'' \times 1'' (4 + 4 + 1)$
- D (16) squares 11/4" x 11/4"

All seams are a scant $\frac{1}{4}$ " unless specified otherwise.

Assembly

- 1. On the wrong side of the D squares, draw a line from one corner to the opposing corner.
 - Or use Diagonal Seam Tape as a guide.



2. With right sides together, align the D squares in the corners of the A squares as shown. Stitch on the line. Trim seam to ¼" and press the seam to the triangle.

Repeat for remaining corners.



3. Join two B rectangles. Press the seam in one direction - or press it open.


Repeat to make 4 units.



4. Join the (9) C squares to make a nine-patch.

Press the seams in the direction of the arrows.

- 9" block all units will measure 3½" x 3½".
- $4\frac{1}{2}$ " block all units will measure 2" x 2".






5. Lay out the units as shown.




6. Join the units to make three rows. Press. the seams in the direction of the arrows or press them open.



- 6. Join the rows to complete the block. Press the seams in the direction of the arrows or press them open.
 - 9" block block will measure 91/2" x 91/2".
 - 4½" block block will measure 5" x 5".
