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# Savor the Gnoment


Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning.


All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.

## 1. Cut the following:

If using FAT CUTS, you may need to cut additional width-of-fabric strips.

### PLEASE NOTE:

Cut all 5-3/4" squares in half diagonally twice for the  number of triangles indicated in [ ].

Cut all 5-3/8" squares in half diagonally for the  number of triangles indicated in [ ].

**Fabric A** - PLEASE NOTE: Panels do not always print the size intended. For this pattern, small panels have a coping border added then trimmed so they will fit the quilt correctly.

Cut (4) 9-1/2" square large panels  
Fussy cut 1/4" beyond outside edges of 4 small panels to approximately 8-1/2" square


**Fabric B** - Referring to the quilt image, fussy cut strips, the length of fabric parallel to selvage: (2) 9-1/4" x 63-1/2" multi-stripe borders (1 with mushroom stripe on bottom, 1 with mushroom stripe on top)


**Fabric C** - Fussy cut (8) 6-7/8" squares (on point) with motifs centered


**Fabric D** - Fussy cut (8) 6-7/8" squares (on point)


**Fabric E** - Cut (4) 1-1/4" strips, subcut (8) 1-1/4" x 10" and (8) 1-1/4" x 9" strips

**Fabric F** - Cut (5) 3-3/4" strips

**Fabric G** - Cut (4) 5-3/4" strips, subcut (25) 5-3/4" squares  [100]

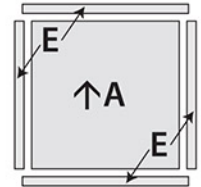
**Fabric H** - Cut (3) 5-3/8" strips, subcut (16) 5-3/8" squares  [32]  
Cut (5) 3-3/4" strips

**Fabric I** - Cut (3) 5-3/8" strips, subcut (16) 5-3/8" squares  [32] and (1) 2" x 16" strip  
Cut (10) 2" strips, sewn together end to end with the 2" x 16" strip and cut into (2) 2" x 84", (2) 2-1/2" x 66-1/2", and (2) 2" x 63-1/2" borders

**Fabric J** - Cut (4) 5-3/4" strips, subcut (25) 5-3/4" squares  [100] and (1) 2-1/2" x 12" (binding)  
Cut (8) 2-1/2" strips (binding)

## 2. Piecing Order:

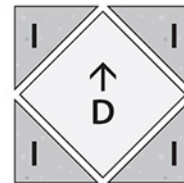
1. Stitch **Fabric E** 1-1/4" x 9" strips to sides of a small 8-1/2" **Fabric A** panel. Trim strip ends even. Add 1-1/4" x 10" **Fabric E** strips to top and bottom of panel. **Trim bordered panel to 9-1/2" square (unfinished).**  
Make a total of 4 **Block 1**.



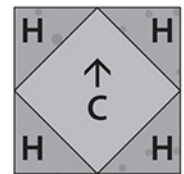
After adding **E** borders, trim bordered panel to 9-1/2" square.  
Block 1 - Make 4

Arrows indicate orientation of directional prints.

2. Sew 4 **Fabric I** 5-3/8" triangles to edges of a **Fabric D** 6-7/8" square as shown. Make a total of



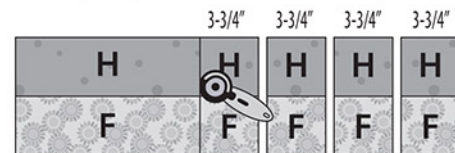
Block 2a - Make 8

8 **Block 2a** (9-1/2" square unfinished). In the same manner, make 8 **Block 2b** with fabrics indicated.

3. Stitch 1 each **Fabrics F** and **H** 3-3/4" x width of fabric strips together lengthwise. Make a total of 5 strip sets. From these, cut (50) 3-3/4" wide Unit 1 (3-3/4" x 7" unfinished).



4. Sew 2 Unit 1 together as shown, alternating fabrics. Trim to 6-7/8" square (unfinished). Make a total of 25 Unit 2.



Unit 2 - Make 25

5. Stitch 1 each **Fabrics J** and **G** 5-3/4" triangles together along short edges. Make a total of 50 each Units 3a and 3b (5-3/8" x 5-3/8" x 7-5/8" unfinished).

6. Sew 2 each Units 3a and 3b to edges of a Unit 2 as shown. Make a total of 25 **Block 3** (9-1/2" square unfinished).



7. Refer to Quilt Layout (Page 3) for arrangement and placement of blocks, **Fabric A** 9-1/2" squares, and borders.

8. Arrange blocks and **Fabric A** 9-1/2" squares in 7 rows. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together completing quilt center (63-1/2" square unfinished).

9. Sew **Fabric I** 2" x 63-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt center.

10. Sew **Fabric B** 9-1/4" x 63-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt

11. Sew **Fabric I** 2" x 84" borders to right and left sides of quilt. Add **Fabric I** 2" x 66-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt.

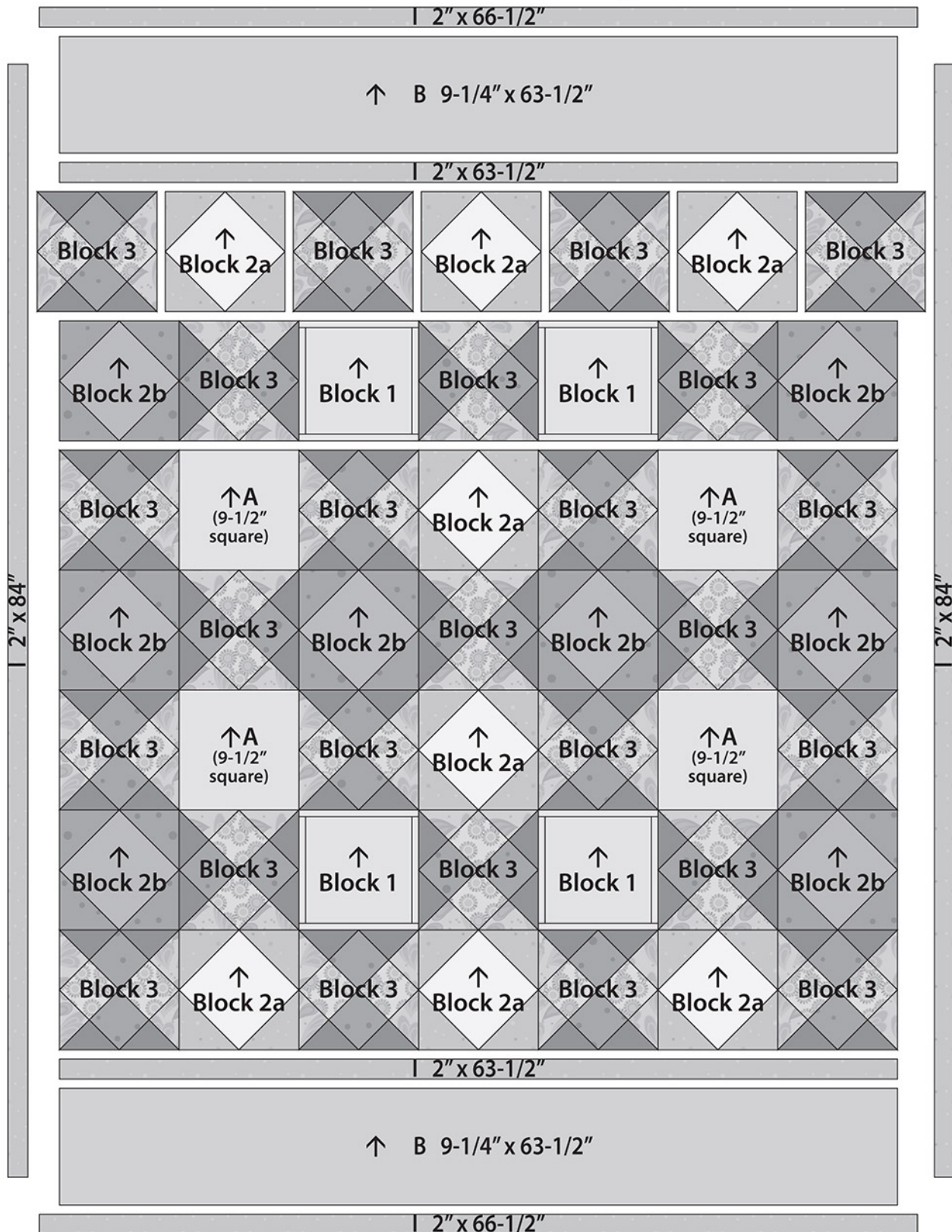
12. The quilt measures approximately 66-1/2" x 87" (unfinished). Make backing (**Fabric K**) approximately 8" larger than the top.

13. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric J**) and enjoy!!

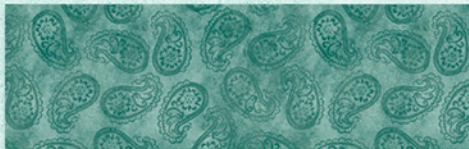

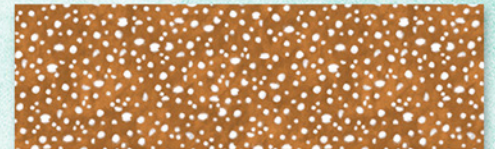

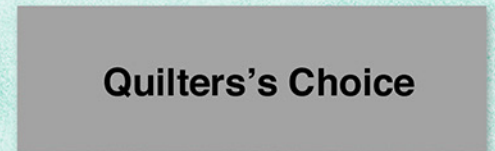
