

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BH4 Block 2 - Cooee

Color/shading options.

Piecing & Cutting Notes:

• To trim the HTSs to size, add 1/8" to 1/4" to the A and B squares. Trim to the size specified below.

Cutting Instructions:

9" Finished Block:

A - (2) squares - 3%" x 3%"

B - (2) squares - 3%" x 3%"

C - (4) squares - 2" x 2"

D - (8) squares - 2" x 2"

E - (4) rectangles - 2" x 31/2"

4½" Finished Block:

A - (2) squares - 2%" x 2%"

B - (2) squares - 2%" x 2%"

C - (4) squares - 1¼" x 1¼"

D - (8) squares - 1¼" x 1¼"

E - (4) rectangles - 11/4" x 2"

All seams are a scant $\frac{1}{4}$ " unless specified otherwise.

Assembly


- 1. On the wrong side of the A squares, draw a line from one corner to the opposing corner.
 - Or use Diagonal Seam Tape to guide the square for stitching.




2. With right sides together, align the A with the B squares as shown. Stitch a scant ¼" on both sides of the line. Cut the square apart on the drawn line. Trim seam to ¼" and press the seam to the triangle.

The HTSs will measure 3½" x 3½" or 2" x 2".

3. Lay out the pieces as shown.








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moda FABRICS + SUPPLIES° 4. Join the pieces for one corner as shown. Press the seams in the direction of the arrows - or press them open.


The corner will measure 5" x 5" or 2\%" x 2\%".

Repeat to make (4) matching units.





- 6. Join the halves to complete the block. Press the seams in the direction of the arrows or press them open.
 - 9" block block will measure 9½" x 9½".
 - 4½" block block will measure 5" x 5".



Stitching with Jenelle...

- The name of the block is Cooee pronounced Kooo-EEEE, as in "seek"! You should "Cooee" when you're in the Australian bush because the sound travels and echoes. It's very helpful if you're lost, because if you're "within cooee", then you're within earshot!
- The quilting tip I wish I'd learned when I first started is... to use Fork Pins to match your nested seams.
- My best advice to new quilters is to... choose fabric you love!
- When it comes to quilting/sewing tools, don't get between me and my... Perfect Circles for appliqué.
- Don't tell anyone, but when I'm sewing, I don't worry about... I don't worry about what's for dinner! If you want a sewing related answer, I would say, trimming my threads, I leave them dangling and trim when I'm finished.
- My "rock-star stitch group" includes... includes dessert, but if you want people I would say my Friday night stitching friends that we have nicknamed the 'winers club'!
