

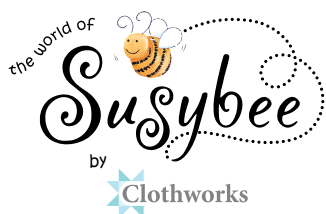

Throw Pillow cat blocks (1) 3 1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut (2) 3 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles and (4) 1 1/2" x 1 1/2" squares.</p>

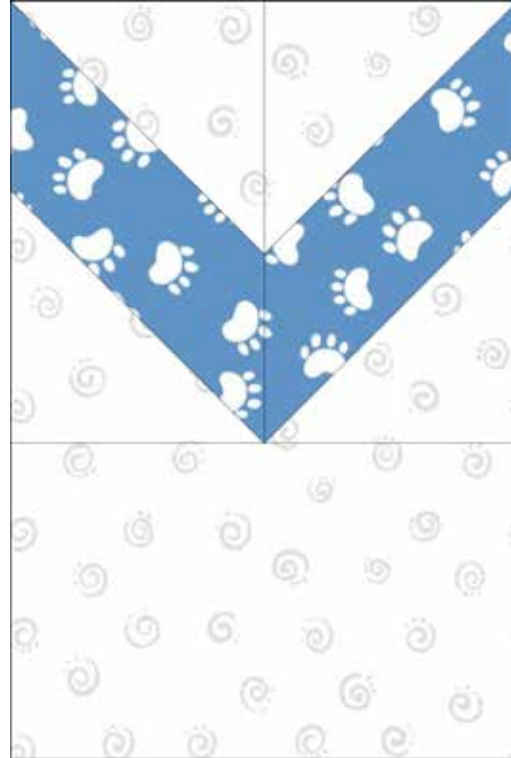
Constructing Playmat

1. M (W) block

<p>a. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" <i>Fabric A</i> square. Place square, right sides together, at the upper right corner of (1) 3 1/2" x 5 3/4" <i>Fabric F</i> rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal corner triangle. Repeat with another 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" <i>Fabric A</i> square at the lower left corner of the same <i>Fabric F</i> rectangle.</p>	<p>b. Repeat to make a mirror-image unit. Sew units together, and add (1) 4 1/4" x 6 1/2" <i>Fabric A</i> rectangle to the bottom.</p>
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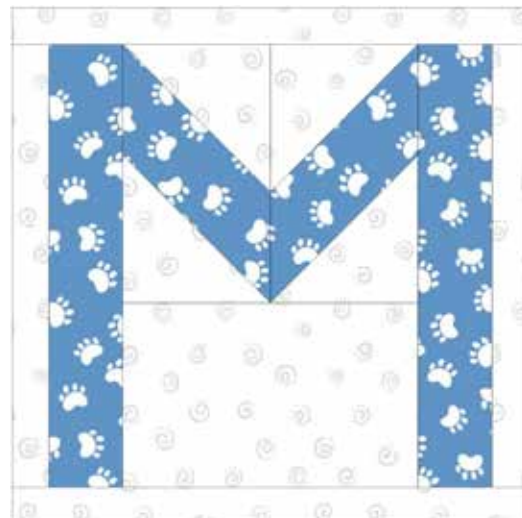
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c. Sew (1) 2" x 9 1/2" *Fabric F* rectangles to the left and right sides of step b unit. Sewn unit measures 9 1/2" x 9 1/2" unfinished.



d. Sew (1) 1 1/4" x 9 1/2" *Fabric A* rectangles to the left and right sides of step c unit, followed by (1) 1 1/4" x 11" *Fabric A* rectangles to the top and bottom of the same unit to complete (1) M block. Block measures 11" x 11" unfinished.



Repeat to make an additional block using *Fabric A* and *Fabric C*.

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2. E block

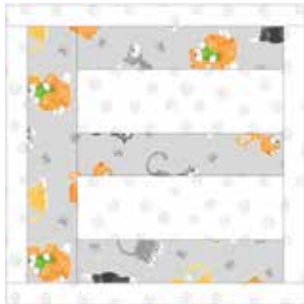
a. Sew (3) 2" x 7 ³/₄" *Fabric D* rectangles together, alternating with (2) 2 ³/₄" x 7 ³/₄" *Fabric A* rectangles. Sewn unit measures 7 ³/₄" x 9 ¹/₂" unfinished.



b. Add (1) 2 ¹/₄" x 9 ¹/₂" *Fabric D* rectangle to the left of step a unit. Sew unit measures 9 ¹/₂" x 9 ¹/₂" unfinished.



c. Sew (1) 1 ¹/₄" x 9 ¹/₂" *Fabric A* rectangles to the left and right sides of step b unit, followed by (1) 1 ¹/₄" x 11" *Fabric A* rectangles to the top and bottom of the same unit to complete (1) E block. Block measures 11" x 11" unfinished.



3. O block






a. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) 1 ¹/₂" x 1 ¹/₂" *Fabric B* square. Place square, right sides together, at a corner of (1) 1 ¹/₂" x 4" *Fabric A* rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim ¹/₄" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal corner triangle. Repeat with another 1 ¹/₂" x 1 ¹/₂" *Fabric B* at the opposite corner of the same *Fabric A* rectangle.



b. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) 1 ¹/₂" x 1 ¹/₂" *Fabric A* square. Place square, right sides together, at the bottom left corner of (1) 3 ¹/₂" x 4" *Fabric B* rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim ¹/₄" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal corner triangle. Repeat with another 1 ¹/₂" x 1 ¹/₂" *Fabric A* square at the bottom right corner of the same *Fabric B* rectangle.

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<p>c. Sew step a unit above step b unit to make cat unit. Unit measures 4" x 4 1/2" unfinished.</p> 	<p>d. Sew (2) 2" x 4 1/2" <i>Fabric A</i> rectangles to the left and right sides of step c unit, followed by (1) 1 1/2" x 7" <i>Fabric A</i> rectangle to the top, and (1) 2" x 7" <i>Fabric A</i> rectangle to the bottom of the same unit. Unit measures 7" x 7" unfinished.</p> 
<p>e. Sew (1) 1 3/4" x 7" <i>Fabric G</i> rectangles to the left and right sides of step d unit.</p> 	<p>f. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) 1 3/4" x 1 3/4" <i>Fabric A</i> square. Place square, right sides together, at a corner of (1) 1 3/4" x 9 1/2" <i>Fabric G</i> rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal corner triangle. Repeat with another 1 3/4" x 1 3/4" <i>Fabric A</i> square at the opposite corner of the same <i>Fabric G</i> rectangle. Make a total of (2) units and sew to the top and bottom of step 2 unit. Sewn unit measures 9 1/2" x 9 1/2" unfinished.</p> 

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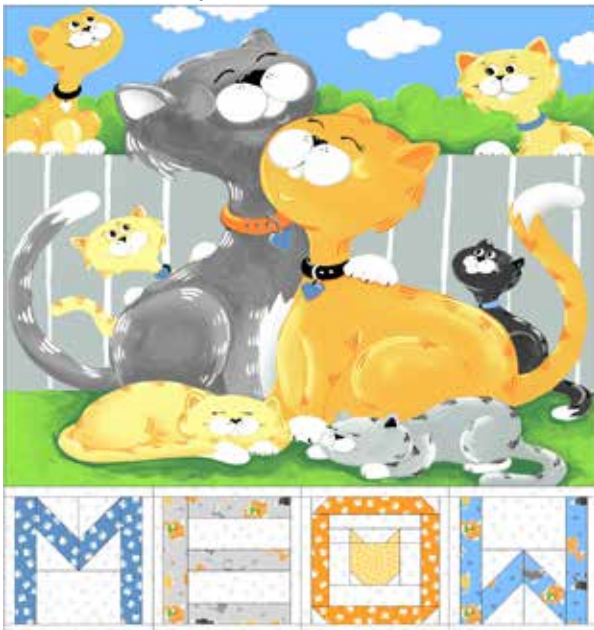
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g. Sew (1) $1\frac{1}{4}$ " x $9\frac{1}{2}$ " *Fabric A* rectangles to the left and right sides of step f unit, followed by (1) $1\frac{1}{4}$ " x 11" *Fabric A* rectangles to the top and bottom of the same unit to complete (1) O block. Block measures 11" x 11" unfinished.



4. Playmat assembly.

a. Sew together alphabet blocks to make a pieced row. Add to the bottom of *Fabric E* panel to complete playmat.



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Constructing Throw Pillow

1. Cat blocks

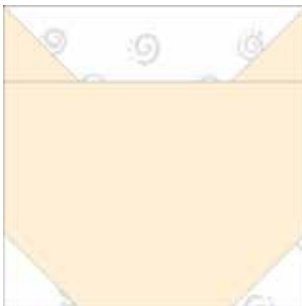
a. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $1\frac{1}{2}$ " *print* square. Place square, right sides together, at a corner of (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " *Fabric A* rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal corner triangle. Repeat with another $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $1\frac{1}{2}$ " *print* square at the opposite corner of the same *Fabric A* rectangle.



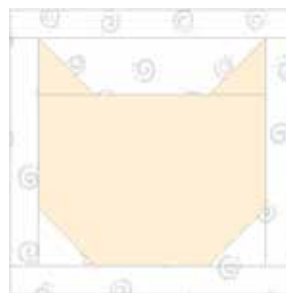
b. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $1\frac{1}{2}$ " *Fabric A* square. Place square, right sides together, at the bottom left corner of (1) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " *print* rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal corner triangle. Repeat with another $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $1\frac{1}{2}$ " *Fabric A* square at the bottom right corner of the same *print* rectangle.



c. Sew step a unit on top of step b unit to make (1) cat unit. Unit measures $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished.



d. Sew (1) 1 " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " *Fabric A* rectangles to the left and right sides of step c unit, followed by (1) 1 " x $5\frac{1}{2}$ " *Fabric A* rectangles to the top and bottom of the same unit to complete (1) cat block. Block measures $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $5\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished.



Make a total of (2) blocks each for the following Fabrics: B, D, F, G

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2. Throw pillow assembly.

a. Arrange and sew (4) cat blocks to make a row unit. Add (1) 2 ½" x 20 ½" *Fabric C* strip to the top, and (1) 1 ½" x 20 ½" *Fabric C* strip to the bottom of row unit.



b. Add (1) 12 ½" x 20 ½" *Fabric H* rectangle to the bottom of section made in step a to complete pillow top.



c. Completing throw pillow case.

[Optional - Quilters may choose to quilt pillowcase top before completing pillow case. If that's the case, an additional backing fabric piece measuring 20 ½" x 20 ½" is needed (not accounted for in the yardage chart above), along with a 20 ½" x 20 ½" batting piece.]

Turn under ¼" on one edge of a 20 ½" x 20 ½" *Fabric D* pillow back piece. Turn the same edge under again approximately 4" to make a flap. Edge stitch along the out edge of the flap to hold it in place.

Repeat with another 20 ½" x 20 ½" *Fabric D* pillow back piece.

Place pillowcase front piece right side up on a flat surface. Lay the pillow back pieces, right sides down, on the pillowcase front piece. Flaps will overlap. Adjust the pillow back pieces as needed, and trim any excess fabric from the 20 ½" area that is not covering the pillowcase front piece.

Pin and stitch the pieces together around the outside raw edges. Zig zag to finish edges if desired.

Turn the pillowcase right side out. Press and insert pillow form to complete throw pillow case.

d. Repeat to make another throw pillow case.
