#### PIECED BLOCK ASSEMBLY

1. Sew (1) **H** 1-1/2" x 5-1/2" rectangle to the left, and (1) **H** 1-1/2" x 2-1/2" rectangle to the right sides of (1) **O** 1-1/2" square to make a row unit. Then add (1) **H** 1-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangle to the bottom of row unit, as shown.






2. Sew (1) H 1-1/2" square to the left, and (1) H 1-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangle to the right sides of (1) O 1-1/2" square to make a row unit.




3. Sew (1) H 1-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangle to the left, and (1) 1-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangle to the right sides of (1) O 1-1/2" square to make another row unit.



**4.** Sew both row units (Step 2-3) to the opposite long sides of (1) **H** 1-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangle, as shown.



5. Alternating with (3) L 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles, sew together Step 1 and 4 row units to create a lighthouse unit, measuring 8-1/2" x 11-1/2" unfinished.





6. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) O 2-1/2" square. Place square, right sides together, at a corner of (1) A 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal O corner triangle. Repeat with another O 2-1/2" square at the opposite corner of the same A rectangle to complete sewn unit.










7. Add unit from Step 6 to the top of the lighthouse unit, followed by (2) O 2-1/2" x 13-1/2" rectangles to the left and right sides.






8. Repeat Step 6 using (2) O 1-1/2" squares and (1) A 1-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangle.



9. Add (1) L 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangle to the bottom of Step 8, followed by (2) O 3-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangles to the left and right sides to make the lighthouse beacon unit, measuring 3-1/2" x 12-1/2" unfinished.









**10.** Sew (1) **H** 1-1/2" x 2-1/4" rectangle on top of (1) **O** 1-1/2" x 2-1/4" rectangle. Then add (1) **N** 1" x 2-1/2" rectangle to the left of sewn unit, measuring 2-3/4" x 2-1/2" unfinished.






11. Sew (1) O 2-1/2" x 6-1/4" rectangle to the left, and (1) O 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangle to the right sides of previous unit to make a flag row unit. Unit measures 2-1/2" x 12-1/2" unfinished.




12. Repeat Step 6 using (2) O 1-1/2" square and (1) H 1-1/2" x 10-1/2" rectangle.



13. Add (2) O 1-1/2" squares to the opposite short ends of Step 12. Then sew (1) N 1-1/2"  $\times$  12-1/2" rectangle to the bottom to make the base unit, measuring 2-1/2"  $\times$  12-1/2" unfinished.



14. Sew the flag row unit on top of the lighthouse beacon unit to make a lighthouse top unit.





**15.** Add the lighthouse top unit on top of the lighthouse unit. Then add the base unit to the bottom to complete (1) **Pieced Block**, measuring 12-1/2" x 20-1/2" unfinished.


#### **CORNERSTONE**

17. Half-Square Triangle (HST): Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) O 2-1/2" square and place right sides together, on (1) E 2-1/2" square. Sew 1/4" seam on both sides of drawn line. Cut along drawn line. Open and press to yield (2) E/O HST Units. Square to 2" unfinished. Make (4) HST Units.



18. Noting rotation of HSTs, sew (4) into a Pinwheel Unit, as shown. Square to 3-1/2" unfinished.



19. Sew (2) O 1" x 3-1/2" rectangles to the left and right sides of the Pinwheel Unit, followed by (2) O 1" x 4-1/2" rectangles to the top and bottom sides to complete (1) Cornerstone, measuring 4-1/2" square unfinished. Make (20).









#### QUILT ASSEMBLY - REFER TO QUILT IMAGE FOR BLOCK PLACEMENT GUIDE.

**20.** Pieced Rows: Arrange and sew together (4) Pieced Blocks and (5) **O** 4-1/2" x 20-1/2" rectangles to make a Pieced Row. Make (3) rows. Row 1 is shown below.



21. Sashing Rows: Sew together (5) Cornerstones and (4) O 4-1/2" x 12-1/2" rectangles, as shown. Make (4) rows.



22. Sew together (3) Pieced Block Rows and (4) Pieced Sashing Rows to complete quilt center.

#### **BORDERS**

- 23. Inner Border: Sew (2) O 1-1/2" x 76-1/2" strips to the left and right sides of quilt center, followed by (2) O 1-1/2" x 70-1/2" strips to the top and bottom of quilt center.
- **24.** Outer Border: Sew (2) **G** 4-1/2" x 78-1/2" strips to the left and right sides of quilt center, followed by (2) **G** 4-1/2" x 78-1/2" strips to the top and bottom of quilt center to complete quilt top.



#### **QUILT ASSEMBLY**

O 1-1/2" x 70-1/2" Row 1 Row 2 Row 3

**FINISHING:** Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich. Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using **C** 2-1/4" pieced strip.
