FINISHED QUILT SIZE 58" x 66"

Measurements include ¼" seam allowance.

Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated.

The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric.

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

1 Bison Panel (PD11865)

11/2 yards Parchment Main (CD11860)

% yard Forest Trees (C11862)

1 yard Brown Pinewood Grain (C7755)

* Includes Binding

CUTTING REQUIREMENTS

Please read instructions first before cutting. Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces.

Bison Panel

Cut 1 rectangle 36" x 43".

Parchment Main

Cut 6 strips 5½" x WOF for Border 3.

Brown Pinewood Grain

Cut 4 strips 3½" x WOF for Border 1.

Cut 6 strips 2½" x WOF for binding.

Forest Trees

Cut 5 strips 3½" x WOF for Border 2.

QUILT ASSEMBLY

Refer to the quilt photo for placement of fabrics.

Borders

Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces. Sew border strips together end to end if necessary to get the length needed. Sew side borders first.

Border 1

Side borders should be 43". Top and bottom borders should be 42".

Border 2

Side borders should be 49". Top and bottom borders should be 48".

Border 3

Side borders should be 55". Top and bottom borders should be 58".

Finish quilt by layering the quilt top, batting, and back. Bind with the 2½" Brown Pinewood Grainl strips. Have fun with your colors and enjoy the journey of making your quilt.
