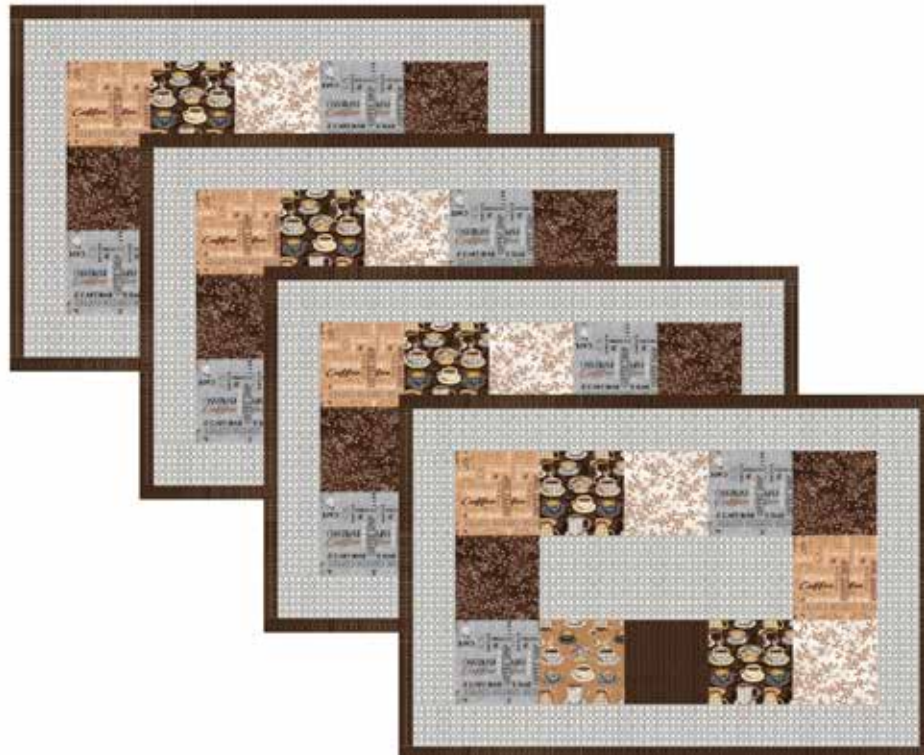

A		53063-2 Dark Roast	FQ	(1) 3-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut (12) 3-1/2" squares.
B		53063-3 Caramel	FQ	(1) 3-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut (6) 3-1/2" squares.
C		53064-5 Latte	FQ	(1) 3-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut (10) 3-1/2" squares.
D		53064-6 Grey	FQ	(1) 3-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut (12) 3-1/2" squares.
E		53065-1 Cream	FQ	(1) 3-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut (12) 3-1/2" squares.
F		53065-2 Dark Roast	FQ	(1) 3-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut (12) 3-1/2" squares.
G		53066-2 Dark Roast	1-1/8	(1) 3-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut (8) 3-1/2" squares. (10) 2-1/2" x WOF strips for binding. (1) each of "but," "first," and "coffee" templates (1) scroll template
H		53067-1 Cream	7/8	(1) 13" x WOF strip. Subcut (1) 13" square, (2) 6-1/2" x 12-1/2" rectangles and (4) 3-1/2" x 9-1/2" rectangles. (6) 2" x WOF strips. Subcut (8) 2" x 18-1/2" strips and (8) 2" x 9-1/2" strips.
		Backing	2-1/2	48" x 18" piece of batting for table runner; (4) 22" x 16" pieces of batting for placemats

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MAKE THE TABLE RUNNER

1. Trace each appliqué template onto the paper side of fusible web. Cut out 1/4" past the drawn lines. Fuse shapes onto **G** fabric and cut out on the drawn lines.
2. Center and fuse the words and scroll to (1) **H** 13" square. Secure appliqué with a zig zag or other decorative stitch. Trim appliqué square to measure 12-1/2" square.



3. Lay out (2) each **A**, **D**, **E**, **F** and **G** 3-1/2" squares and (1) each **B** and **C** 3-1/2" squares into (4) rows of (3). Sew squares into rows and join the rows to make a pieced unit. Make (2).



4. Sew pieced units to opposite sides of the appliqué square. Sew **H** 6-1/2" x 12-1/2" rectangles to both ends to complete the runner top.



Runner Assembly Diagram



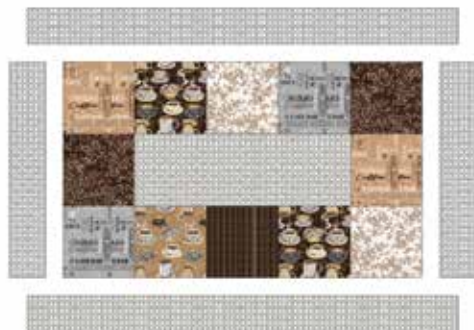
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MAKE THE PLACEMATS

5. Sew (1) **F** 3-1/2" square and (1) **C** 3-1/2" square to opposite ends of (1) **H** 3-1/2" x 9-1/2" rectangle to make (1) center row. Sew together (1) each **C, A, E, D** and **F** 3-1/2" square for the top row. Sew together (1) each **D, B, G, A** and **E** square for the bottom row. Sew the top and bottom rows to the center row.



6. Sew **H** 2" x 9-1/2" strips to opposite sides of the pieced center. Sew **H** 2" x 18-1/2" strips to the top and bottom to complete the placemat top.



7. Repeat steps 5 and 6 to make (4) placemat tops.

FINISHING

With the backing fabric laying taut, place batting and then runner top to form quilt sandwich. Baste the sandwich and quilt as desired. Bind using **G** strips to finish the runner. Finish each placemat in the same way.
