

BH4 Block 7 - Game Board

Color/shading options.

Piecing & Cutting Notes:

• The center checkerboard is strip-pieced. To use a different construction method, the squares measure 1%" x 1%" and 5/16" x 5/16" finished size.

Cutting Instructions:

9" Finished Block:

A -(2) rectangles - 23/4" x 5"

B - (2) squares - 2¾" x 2¾"

C - (2) rectangles - 23/4" x 5"

D - (2) squares - 23/4" x 23/4"

E - (2) strips - 15/8" x 71/2"

F - (2) strips - 1%" x 7½"

41/2" Finished Block:

A -(2) rectangles - 1%" x 234"

B - (2) squares - 1%" x 1%"

C - (2) rectangles - 1%" x 234"

D - (2) squares - 1%" x 1%"

E - (2) strips - 1-1/16" x 5"

F - (2) strips - 1-1/16" x 5"


All seams are a scant $\frac{1}{4}$ " unless specified otherwise.

Assembly

1. Join the E and F strips as shown. Press the seams to the F strips - the darker strips.

Sub-cut the strip set into (4) segments:


- 9" block segments are 1%" wide.
- 4½" block segments are 1-1/16" wide.




2. Lay out the four segments as shown. Press the seams in one direction - or press them open.

The units will measure 5" x 5" or 2¾" x 2¾".

3. Lay out the pieces as shown.







3. Join the pieces to make rows. Press the seams in the direction of the arrows - or press them open.



- 4. Join the rows to complete the block. Press the seams in the direction of the arrows or press them open.
 - 9" block block will measure 9½" x 9½".
 - 4½" block block will measure 5" x 5".
