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Botanical Magic

Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning.

All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.

1. Cut the following:

If using FAT CUTS, you may need to cut additional width-of-fabric strips.

Fabric A - Referring to the quilt image, fussy cut (6) 6-3/4" strips along the length of fabric parallel to selvage. Carefully separating the 2 different designs, sew together 3 of the same strips end to end. Repeat. Cut each strip set into (1) 6-3/4" x 86" and (1) 6-3/4" x 68" border (to total 2 of each length)

Fabric B - Cut (1) 5" strip, subcut (5) 5" squares

Fabric C - Cut (2) 9-3/4" strips, subcut (8) 9-3/4" squares

Cut (1) 2-3/4" strip, subcut (8) 2-3/4" x 5" pieces


Fabric D - Cut (2) 5-3/8" strips, subcut (10) 5-3/8" squares, (2) 3-1/4" squares and (4) 2-3/4" squares

Cut (3) 2-3/4" strips, subcut (22) 2-3/4" x 5" pieces

Fabric E - Cut (1) 5" strip, subcut (4) 5" squares

Fabric F - Cut (3) 2-3/4" strips, subcut (20) 2-3/4" x 5" pieces

Fabric G - Cut (3) 2-3/4" strips, subcut (18) 2-3/4" x 5" pieces

Fabric H - Cut (1) 4-1/8" strip, subcut (10) 4-1/8" squares then cut in half diagonally for (20) triangles 

Cut (1) 2-3/4" strip, subcut (2) 2-3/4" x 5" pieces

Cut (6) 1-3/4" strips sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 1-3/4" x 68" and (2) 1-3/4" x 52-1/2" borders


Fabric I - Cut (3) 2-3/4" strips, subcut (20) 2-3/4" x 5" pieces


Fabric J - Cut (3) 2-3/4" strips, subcut (18) 2-3/4" x 5" pieces

Cut (8) 2-1/2" strips (binding)

Fabric K - Cut (1) 3-1/4" strip, subcut (2) 3-1/4" squares and (2) 2-3/4" squares

Cut (6) 2-3/4" strips, subcut (90) 2-3/4" squares

Fabric L - Cut (3) 3-1/8" strips, subcut (32) 3-1/8" squares then cut in half diagonally for 64 triangles 

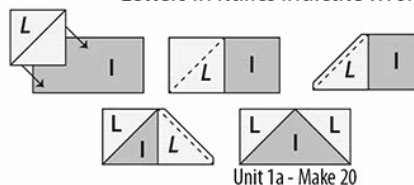
Cut (25) 2-3/4" strips, subcut (40) 2-3/4" x 9-1/2" pieces and (228) 2-3/4" squares 

2. Piecing Order:

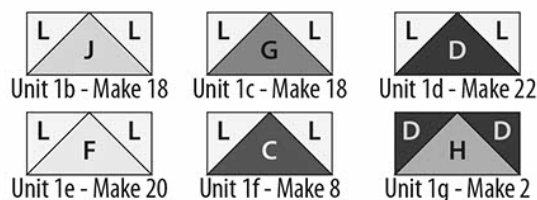
1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of 4 **Fabric D**, 20 **Fabric K**, and 212 **Fabric L** 2-3/4" squares; and 2 **Fabric K** 3-1/4" squares.

2. Arrange a marked **Fabric L** 2-3/4" square on 1 end of a **Fabric I** 2-3/4" x 5" piece as shown. Stitch along the marked line. Trim seam allowance to 1/4". Press triangle out. Repeat on opposite side of the **Fabric I** piece. Make a total of 20 Unit 1a (2-3/4" x 5" unfinished).

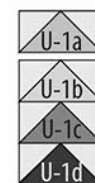
Letters in italics indicate wrong side of fabric.



3. Repeat step 2 to make Units 1b - 1g using fabrics shown.

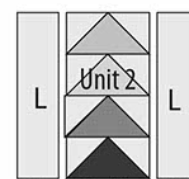


4. Stitch 1 each Units 1a - 1d into a column as shown to make Unit 2. Make 18 Unit 2 (5" x 9-1/2" unfinished).



Unit 2 - Make 18

5. Stitch a **Fabric L** 2-3/4" x 9-1/2" piece to each side of Unit 2 to complete **Block 1** (9-1/2" square unfinished). Make 18 **Block 1**.

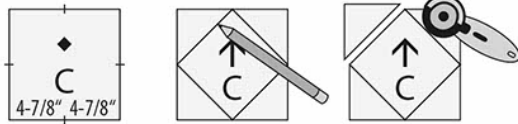


Block 1 - Make 18

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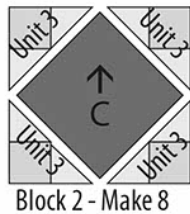
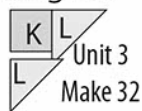
Arrows indicate orientation of directional prints.

6. Mark the 4-7/8" center



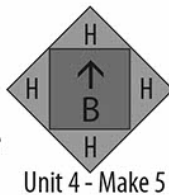
point on all sides of a 9-3/4" **Fabric C** square as shown. Draw diagonal lines from mark to mark. Trim corners from square. Repeat for a total of 8 trimmed **C** squares (6-7/8" square unfinished).

7. Stitch a **Fabric L** 3-1/8" triangle to the right side of a **Fabric K** 2-3/4" square, aligning the top edge as shown. Then sew a second **Fabric L** 3-1/8" triangle to the bottom of the **Fabric K** square, aligning the left sides to make Unit 3. Make 32 Unit 3 (5-3/8" x 5-3/8" x 7-5/8" unfinished).

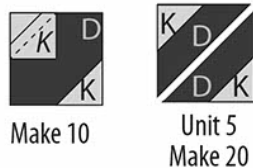


8. Stitch a Unit 3 to each side of a trimmed **Fabric C** square to complete **Block 2**. Make 8 **Block 2** (9-1/2" square unfinished).

9. Stitch a **Fabric H** 4-1/8" triangle to each side of a **Fabric B** 5" square to make Unit 4. Make 5 Unit 4 (6-7/8" square unfinished).



10. Arrange 2 marked **Fabric K** 2-3/4" squares right sides together on opposite corners of a **Fabric D** 5-3/8" square as shown. Stitch along marked lines. Trim seam allowances to 1/4". Press triangles out. Cut the **Fabric D** square in half diagonally as shown, creating 2 Unit 5. Make 20 Unit 5 (5-3/8" x 5-3/8" x 7-5/8" unfinished).

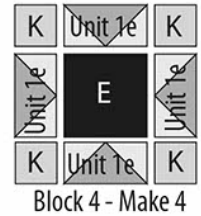


11. Stitch a Unit 5 to each side of Unit 4 to complete **Block 3**. Make 5 **Block 3** (9-1/2" square unfinished).



Letters in italics indicate wrong side of fabric.

12. Arrange 1 **Fabric E** 5" square, 4 Units 1e, and 4 **Fabric K** 2-3/4" squares in 3 rows as shown. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 4 **Block 4** (9-1/2" square unfinished).

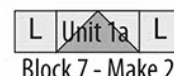


Note: Blocks 5-9 are all 2-3/4" x 9-1/2" unfinished.

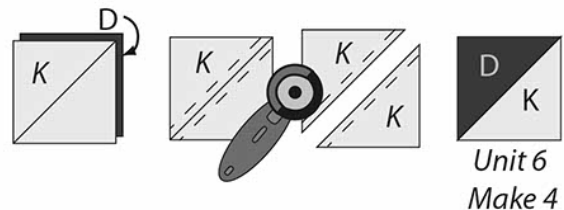
13. Stitch a **Fabric K** 2-3/4" square to each side of a Unit 1e. Make 4 **Block 5**.



14. Repeat step 13 to make 8 **Block 6**, 2 **Block 7** and 4 **Block 8** using fabrics and units shown.



15. Arrange a marked **Fabric K** 3-1/4" square right sides together with a **Fabric D** 3-1/4" square. Stitch 1/4" from each side of the line, then cut apart on the line. Press open. Trim to 2-3/4" square for 2 Unit 6. Make 4 Unit 6.



16. Stitch a Unit 6 on each end of a Unit 1g for **Block 9**. Make 2 **Block 9**.



17. Refer to Quilt Layout (Page 4) for arrangement and placement of blocks and borders.

18. Arrange blocks and 4 each **Fabric L** 2 3/4" x 9-1/2" pieces and 2-3/4" squares in 9 rows. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together completing quilt center (50" x 68" unfinished).

19. Sew **Fabric H** 1-3/4" x 68" borders to right and left sides of quilt center. Add **Fabric H** 1-3/4" x 52-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt center (52-1/2" x 70-1/2" unfinished).

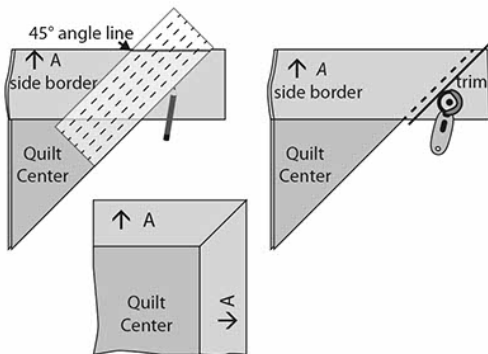
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20. Center **Fabric A** 6-3/4" x 86" borders on right and left sides and **Fabric A** 6-3/4" x 68" borders on top and bottom of quilt center. Stitch borders to quilt center with bottom of border against quilt center, starting and stopping 1/4" from corners of quilt center. Do not trim. Press borders out.

21. Working with 1 corner at a time, fold the quilt center right sides together so the outside edges of the borders line up. Using a 45-degree ruler, mark from the end of border seams to outer edges of borders. Stitch along marked line. Trim seam allowance to 1/4". Press corner seam open. Repeat on remaining corners.

22. The quilt measures approximately 65" x 83" (unfinished). Make backing (**Fabric M**) approximately 8" larger than the top.

23. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric J**) and enjoy!!

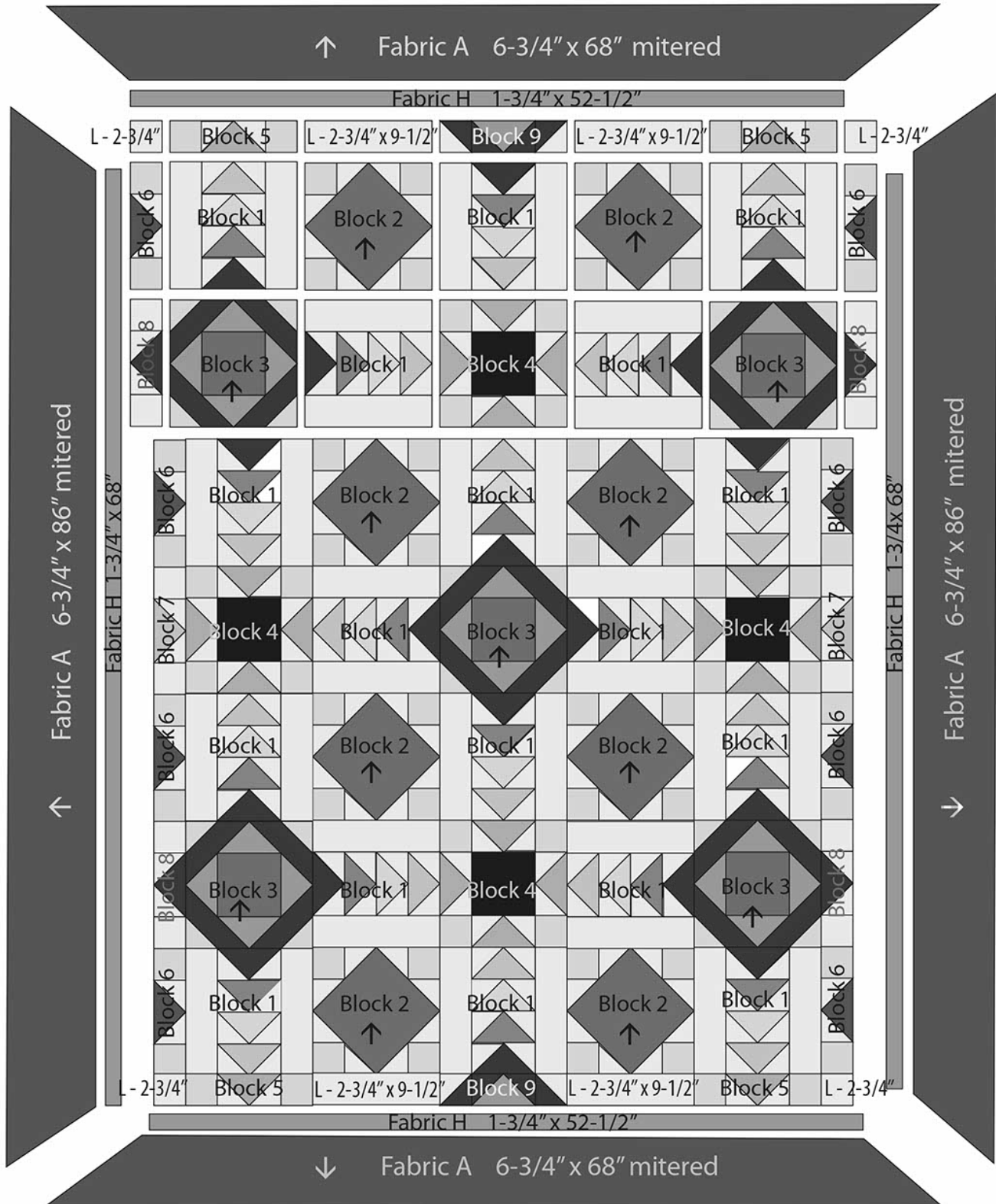


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QUILT LAYOUT

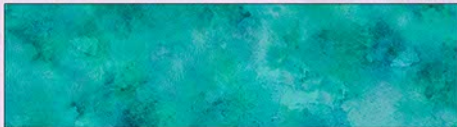

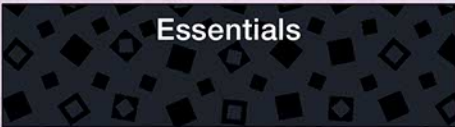

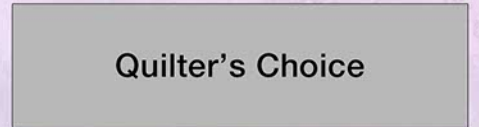
