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Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning.

All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.

1. Cut the following:

PLEASE NOTE: Panels do not always print the size intended. This may change the finished size of the quilt slightly.

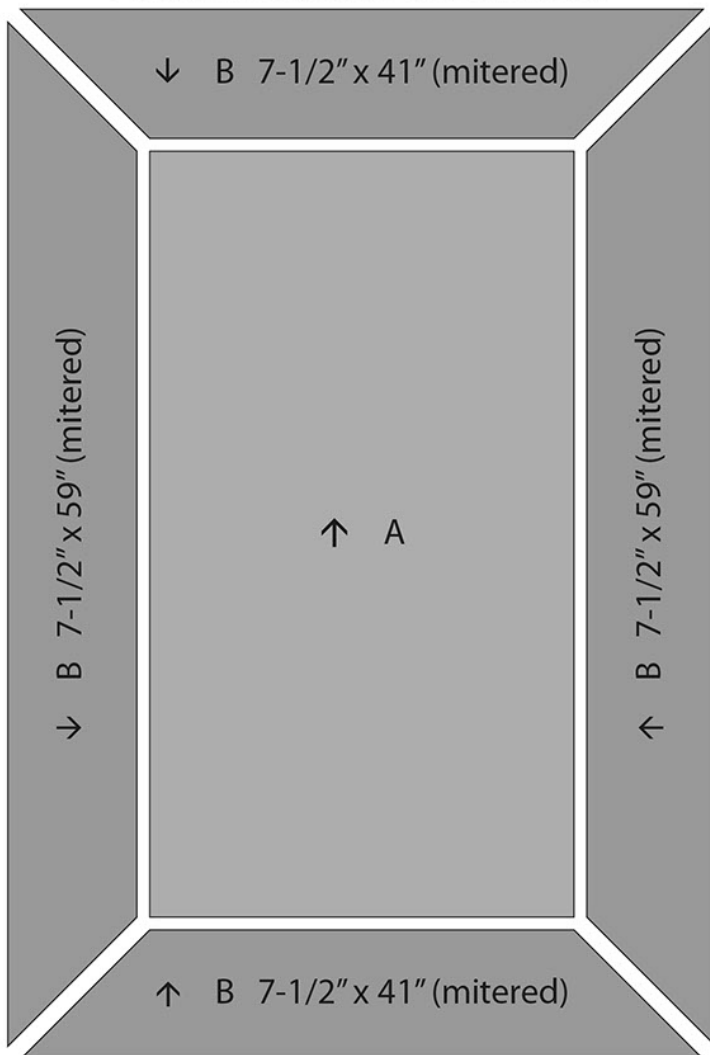
Fussy cut 1/4" beyond outside edges of panel to approximately 23-1/2" x 42"

Fabric B - Referring to the quilt image, fussy cut strips, the length of fabric parallel to selvage: (2) 7-1/2" x 59" and (2) 7-1/2" x 41" sunflower stripe borders

Fabric C - Cut (5) 2-1/2" strips (binding)

QUILT LAYOUT

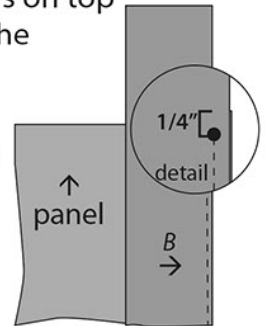
Border measurements are the cut size.
Arrows indicate orientation of directional prints.



2. Piecing Order:

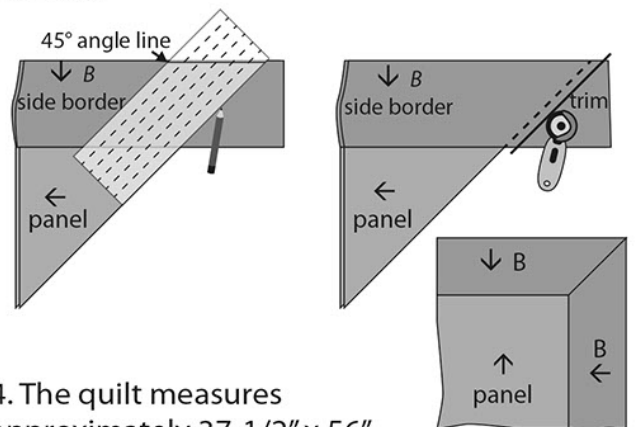
1. Refer to Quilt Layout for arrangement and placement of panel and borders.

2. Center **Fabric B** 7-1/2" x 59" borders on right and left sides of **Fabric B** panel and **Fabric B** 7-1/2" x 41" borders on top and bottom of panel with the top of the stripe next to panel. Stitch borders to sides starting and stopping 1/4" from corners of panel center. Do not trim. Press borders out.



*Letters in italics indicate wrong side of fabric.
Arrows indicate orientation of directional prints.*

3. Working with 1 corner at a time, fold the panel right sides together so the outside edges of the borders line up. Using a 45-degree ruler, mark from the end of border seams to outer edges of borders. Stitch along marked line. Trim seam allowance to 1/4". Press corner seam open. Repeat on remaining corners.



4. The quilt measures approximately 37-1/2" x 56" (unfinished). Make backing (**Fabric D**) approximately 6-8" larger than the top.

5. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric C**) and enjoy!!
