G	Firefly Twilight 12505P Dark Purple	1-1/8 yds	 (7) 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut (48) 2-1/2" x 5-1/2" strips. (7) 2-1/2" x WOF strips, BINDING.

* SEW STRIPS VIA SHORT ENDS THEN GO TO BORDER ASSEMBLY WOF/LOF=WIDTH/LENGTH OF FABRIC

BLOCK ASSEMBLY PROJECT USES PRECISE 1/4" SEAMS.
TEST YOUR SEAM ALLOWANCE BY CUTTING (2) 2-1/2" X 5"
RECTANGLES. STITCH THEM TOGETHER ALONG THE 5" LENGTH.
AT THE MIDPOINT, MEASURE ACROSS THE UNIT. IT SHOULD BE
EXACTLY 4-1/2" WIDE. IF NOT, ADJUST YOUR SEAM ALLOWANCE
AND REPEAT.

Note: The arrows in the figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components.


1. Place (1) **B** 2-1/2" square on the right side of (1) **C** 2-1/2" x 7-1/2" strip, right sides together. Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner. Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance to make (1) **Unit 1** strip. Repeat to make (12) **Unit 1** strips total.




2. Repeat **Step 1** and refer to the diagram at right for fabric identification, placement and seam direction to make (12) **Unit 2** strips.



3. Sew (1) Unit 1 strip to the left end of (1) Unit 2 strip along the B sides to make (1) Unit 3 strip. Repeat to make (12) Unit 3 strips total.




4. Place (1) **B** 2-1/2" square on the right side of (1) **C** 2-1/2" x 5-1/2" strip, right sides together. Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner. Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a ½" seam allowance to make (1) **Unit 4** strip. Repeat to make (12) **Unit 4** strips total.



5. Repeat **Step 4** and refer to the diagrams below for fabric identification, placement and seam direction to make (12) **Unit 5** strips, (24) **Unit 6** strips and (24) **Unit 7** strips.




6. Sew (1) **Unit 4** to the left end of (1) **Unit 5** strip along the **B** sides to make (1) **Unit 8** strip. Repeat to make (12) **Unit 8** strips.




7. Sew (1) **Unit 6** to the left end of (1) **Unit 7** strip along the **F** sides to make (1) **Unit 9** strip. Repeat to make (24) **Unit 9** strips.




8. Sew (1) **E** 2-1/2" square to each end of (1) **Unit 9** strip to make (1) **Unit 10** strip. Repeat to make (12) **Unit 10** strips total.




9. Sew (1) E 1-1/2" x 8-1/2" strip to each side of (1) D 8-1/2" square. Sew (1) E 1-1/2" x 10-1/2" strip to the top and to the bottom of the D square to make (1) Unit 11 square. Repeat to make (6) Unit 11 squares total.



10. Sew (1) Unit 8 strip to each side of (1) A 10-1/2" square. Sew (1) Unit 3 strip to the top and to the bottom of the newly sewn strip to make (1) 14-1/2" Block One square. Repeat to make (6) Block One squares total.




11. Sew (1) Unit 9 strip to each side of (1) Unit 11 square. Sew (1) Unit 10 strip to the top and to the bottom of the newly sewn strip to make (1) 14-1/2" Block Two square. Repeat to make (6) Block Two squares total.



QUILT ASSEMBLY

- **12.** Sew (1) **Block One** square to each side of (1) **Block Two** square to make **Row One**. Repeat to make **Row Three**.
- **13.** Sew (1) **Block Two** square to each side of (1) **Block One** square to make **Row Two**. Repeat to make **Row Four**.
- **14.** Sew together the (4) **Rows** from **Steps 12-13**, lengthwise and in numerical order from top to bottom, to make the 42-1/2" x 56-1/2" **Center Block**.




BORDER ASSEMBLY MEASURE WIDTH AND LENGTH OF THE QUILT TOP TO ENSURE H, D, J AND I BORDER SIZES, BELOW ARE OUR CUTTING SIZES.

- **15.** Sew (1) H 2" x 56-1/2" strip to each side of the **Center Block**. Sew (1) H 2" x 45-1/2" strip to the top and to the bottom of the **Center Block**.
- **16.** Sew (1) **D** 5-1/2" x 59-1/2" strip to each side of the **Center Block**. Sew (1) **D** 5-1/2" x 55-1/2" strip to the top and to the bottom of the **Center Block**.
- **17.** Sew (1) **I** 2" x 69-1/2" strip to each side of the **Center Block**. Sew (1) **I** 2" x 58-1/2" strip to the top and to the bottom of the **Center Block** to make the quilt top.

FINISHING Cut batting and backing 3" larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind as usual.
