Background SB20053-101	1 ½ y	a. Inner border #1 (4) 1" x WOF strips. Subcut (2) 1" x 31 $\frac{1}{2}$ " and (2) 1" x 40 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips. b. Inner border #3 (5) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Subcut (2) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 35 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips from (2) WOF strips. Piece remaining (3) WOF strips and subcut (2) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 43 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips. c. Inner border #4 (7) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Subcut (176) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares. (2) 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Subcut (2) 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 15 $\frac{1}{2}$ " and (2) 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 20 $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles. d. Inner border #5 (6) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Piece strips and subcut (2) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 49 $\frac{1}{2}$ " and (2) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 55 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
Fabric A SB20157-710	1⁄4 y	a. Inner border #4 (2) 3" x WOF strips. Subcut (16) 3" x 3" squares.
Fabric B SB20171-815	% y, includes binding	<ul> <li>a. Inner border #2</li> <li>(4) 1 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x WOF strips.</li> <li>Subcut (2) 1 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 33 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" and (2) 1 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 41 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" strips.</li> <li>b. Inner border #4</li> <li>(2) 3" x WOF strips.</li> <li>Subcut (16) 3" x 3" squares.</li> <li>c. Binding</li> <li>(7) 2 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" x WOF strips. Piece strips to make a continuous binding strip.</li> </ul>

Fabric C SB20268-620	1⁄4 y	a. Inner border #4 (2) 3" x WOF strips. Subcut (16) 3" x 3" squares.
Fabric D SB20395-950	One panel	a. Quilt center (1) 30 ½" x 40 ½" rectangle, centering design.
Fabric E SB20397-100	3⁄4 y	a. Outer border (7) 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Piece strips and subcut (2) 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 55 $\frac{1}{2}$ " and (2) 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 59 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
Fabric F SB20397-950	1⁄4 y	a. Inner border #4 (2) 3" x WOF strips. Subcut (16) 3" x 3" squares.
Fabric G SB20398-725	1⁄4 y	a. Inner border #4 (2) 3" x WOF strips. Subcut (16) 3" x 3" squares.
Fabric H SB20398-925	1∕8 у	a. Inner border #4 (1) 3" x WOF strips. Subcut (8) 3" x 3" squares.
Suggested backing: SB20401-820	3	63" x 73" (3 <sup>5</sup> ⁄₃ y of 42" wide fabric, pieced horizontally)

#### Constructing inner border pieced blocks



#### **Quilt Assembly**

1. Inner border #1. Sew (2) 1" x 40  $\frac{1}{2}$ " background strips to the opposite long sides of Fabric D quilt center, followed by (2) 1" x 31  $\frac{1}{2}$ " background strips to the remaining opposite short sides of quilt center.

2. Inner border #2. Sew (2)  $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x  $41 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strips to the opposite long sides of quilt center, followed by (2)  $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x  $33 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strips to the remaining opposite short sides of quilt center.

3. Inner border #3. Sew (2) 1  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 43  $\frac{1}{2}$ " background strips to the opposite long sides of quilt center, followed by (2) 1  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 35  $\frac{1}{2}$ " background strips to the remaining opposite short sides of quilt center.



4. Refer to quilt image for block placement guide, arrange and sew (3) X blocks and (3) O blocks to make a column unit.

Add (1) 5  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 15  $\frac{1}{2}$ " background rectangle to the bottom of column unit. Make a total of (2) pieced columns and add to the opposite long sides of quilt center.



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#### Finishing

- 1. Layer backing, batting and quilt top.
- 2. Baste the layers together. Quilt as desired.
- 3. Bind to complete the quilt.



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
