 <p>Background SB20053-101</p>	1 $\frac{1}{2}$ y	<p>a. Inner border #1 (4) 1" x WOF strips. Subcut (2) 1" x 31 $\frac{1}{2}$" and (2) 1" x 40 $\frac{1}{2}$" strips.</p> <p>b. Inner border #3 (5) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$" x WOF strips. Subcut (2) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$" x 35 $\frac{1}{2}$" strips from (2) WOF strips. Piece remaining (3) WOF strips and subcut (2) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$" x 43 $\frac{1}{2}$" strips.</p> <p>c. Inner border #4 (7) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$" x WOF strips. Subcut (176) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$" x 1 $\frac{1}{2}$" squares. (2) 5 $\frac{1}{2}$" x WOF strips. Subcut (2) 5 $\frac{1}{2}$" x 15 $\frac{1}{2}$" and (2) 5 $\frac{1}{2}$" x 20 $\frac{1}{2}$" rectangles.</p> <p>d. Inner border #5 (6) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$" x WOF strips. Piece strips and subcut (2) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$" x 49 $\frac{1}{2}$" and (2) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$" x 55 $\frac{1}{2}$" strips.</p>
 <p>Fabric A SB20157-710</p>	$\frac{1}{4}$ y	<p>a. Inner border #4 (2) 3" x WOF strips. Subcut (16) 3" x 3" squares.</p>
 <p>Fabric B SB20171-815</p>	$\frac{7}{8}$ y, includes binding	<p>a. Inner border #2 (4) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$" x WOF strips. Subcut (2) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$" x 33 $\frac{1}{2}$" and (2) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$" x 41 $\frac{1}{2}$" strips.</p> <p>b. Inner border #4 (2) 3" x WOF strips. Subcut (16) 3" x 3" squares.</p> <p>c. Binding (7) 2 $\frac{1}{4}$" x WOF strips. Piece strips to make a continuous binding strip.</p>

 <p>Fabric C SB20268-620</p>	$\frac{1}{4} y$	<p>a. Inner border #4 (2) 3" x WOF strips. Subcut (16) 3" x 3" squares.</p>
 <p>Fabric D SB20395-950</p>	<p>One panel</p>	<p>a. Quilt center (1) 30 1/2" x 40 1/2" rectangle, centering design.</p>
 <p>Fabric E SB20397-100</p>	$\frac{3}{4} y$	<p>a. Outer border (7) 3 1/2" x WOF strips. Piece strips and subcut (2) 3 1/2" x 55 1/2" and (2) 3 1/2" x 59 1/2" strips.</p>
 <p>Fabric F SB20397-950</p>	$\frac{1}{4} y$	<p>a. Inner border #4 (2) 3" x WOF strips. Subcut (16) 3" x 3" squares.</p>
 <p>Fabric G SB20398-725</p>	$\frac{1}{4} y$	<p>a. Inner border #4 (2) 3" x WOF strips. Subcut (16) 3" x 3" squares.</p>
 <p>Fabric H SB20398-925</p>	$\frac{1}{8} y$	<p>a. Inner border #4 (1) 3" x WOF strips. Subcut (8) 3" x 3" squares.</p>
 <p>Suggested backing: SB20401-820</p>	$3 \frac{5}{8} y$	<p>63" x 73" (3 5/8 y of 42" wide fabric, pieced horizontally)</p>

Constructing inner border pieced blocks

<p>1. Block units.</p> <p>Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) 1 1/2" x 1 1/2" background square. Place square, right sides together, at a corner of (1) 3" x 3" print square. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal corner triangle. Repeat with another 1 1/2" x 1 1/2" background square at the diagonal corner of the same print square.</p> 	<p>2. X blocks</p> <p>Noting unit orientations, sew (4) step 1 units together to complete (1) X block. Block measures 5 1/2" x 5 1/2" unfinished.</p>

<p>3. O blocks</p> <p>Noting unit orientations, sew (4) step 1 units together to complete (1) O block. Block measures 5 1/2" x 5 1/2" unfinished.</p> 		
<p>Make a total of number of blocks for the following fabrics.</p> <p><i>Note: Fabrics G & H are directional. If you want to keep the print oriented in the same direction within each block, you will need to sew the background triangles on opposite sets of corners for half of the blocks within each fabric. See image below.</i></p>

Quilt Assembly

1. Inner border #1. Sew (2) 1" x 40 ½" background strips to the opposite long sides of Fabric D quilt center, followed by (2) 1" x 31 ½" background strips to the remaining opposite short sides of quilt center.

2. Inner border #2. Sew (2) 1 ½" x 41 ½" Fabric B strips to the opposite long sides of quilt center, followed by (2) 1 ½" x 33 ½" Fabric B strips to the remaining opposite short sides of quilt center.

3. Inner border #3. Sew (2) 1 ½" x 43 ½" background strips to the opposite long sides of quilt center, followed by (2) 1 ½" x 35 ½" background strips to the remaining opposite short sides of quilt center.



4. Refer to quilt image for block placement guide, arrange and sew (3) X blocks and (3) O blocks to make a column unit.

Add (1) 5 ½" x 15 ½" background rectangle to the bottom of column unit. Make a total of (2) pieced columns and add to the opposite long sides of quilt center.

5. Arrange and sew (3) X blocks and (2) O blocks to make a row unit. Add (1) $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $20\frac{1}{2}$ " background rectangle to the right of row unit. Make a total of (2) pieced rows and add to the remaining opposite short sides of quilt center.



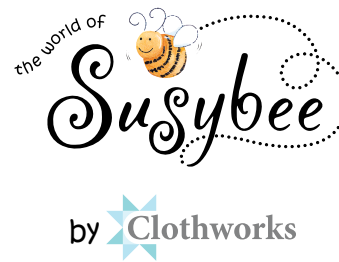
6. Inner border #5. Sew (2) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $55\frac{1}{2}$ " background strips to the opposite long sides of quilt center, followed by (2) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $49\frac{1}{2}$ " background strips to the remaining opposite short sides of quilt center.

7. Outer border. Sew (2) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $59\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric E strips to the opposite long sides of quilt center, followed by (2) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $55\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric E strips to the remaining opposite short sides of quilt center to complete quilt top.



Finishing

1. Layer backing, batting and quilt top.
2. Baste the layers together. Quilt as desired.
3. Bind to complete the quilt.



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
