

BH4 Block 13 - Evening Delight

Color/shading options.

Piecing & Cutting Notes:

• To trim the QTSs to size, add 1/4" to the C-D-E squares. Trim to the size of the A/B squares.

Cutting Instructions:

9" Finished Block:

A - (4) squares - 3½" x 3½"

B - (1) square - 3½" x 3½"

C - (2) squares - 41/4" x 41/4"

D - (1) square - 41/4" x 41/4"

E - (1) square - 41/4" x 41/4"

41/2" Finished Block:

A - (4) squares - 2" x 2"

B - (1) square - 2" x 2"

C - (2) squares - 23/4" x 23/4"

D - (1) square - 23/4" x 23/4"

E - (1) square - 23/4" x 23/4"


All seams are a scant $\frac{1}{4}$ " unless specified otherwise.

Assembly

- 1. On the wrong side of the C squares, draw a line from one corner to the opposing corner.
 - Or use Diagonal Seam Tape to guide the square for stitching.



- 2. With right sides together, align one C square to a D square, and one C square to an E square. Stitch a scant 1/4" on both sides of the line. Cut the square apart on the drawn line. Trim seam to 1/4" and press the seam to the darker triangle.
 - The HTSs will measure 3%" x 3%" or 2%" x 2%".



- 3. On the wrong side of the two C/D HTSs, draw a line from one corner to the opposing corner.
 - Or use Diagonal Seam Tape.

Align one C/D to one C/E with the C triangles on opposite sides - C to D and C to E.


Stitch a scant ¼" on both sides of the line. Cut the square apart on the line. Trim seam to 1/4" and press the seam to one side.

The QTSs will measure 3½" x 3½" or 2" x 2".







4. Lay out the units as shown.



5. Join the units to make three rows. Press the seams in the direction of the arrows - or press them open.



- 6. Join the rows to complete the block. Press the seams in the direction of the arrows - or press them open.
 - 9" block block will measure 9½" x 9½".
 - $4\frac{1}{2}$ " block block will measure 5" x 5".



Stitching with Debbie...

- The quilting tip I wish I'd learned when I first started is... accurate cutting is the first important thing to learn.
- My best advice to new quilters is to... enjoy what you are doing. Perfect points will come later... or maybe never.
- When it comes to quilting/sewing tools, don't get between me and my... Sewline Trio marking pencil.
