D	Samsara Jacobea 13064M-12 <i>Black</i>	n 1/2 yd	(3) 3-7/8" x WOF strips. Subcut (30) 3-7/8" squares.
E	Samsara Scroll 13066-44 <i>Green</i>	1 yd	(4) 4-1/4" x WOF strips. Subcut (30) 4-1/4" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (120) 4-1/4" triangles. (6) 2" x WOF strips. Subcut (120) 2" squares.
F	Solid 2045-19 <i>Sand</i>	2 yds	(7) 4-1/4" x WOF strips. Subcut (60) 4-1/4" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (240) 4-1/4" triangles. (6) 3-7/8" x WOF strips. Subcut (60) 3-7/8" squares. (8) 2" x WOF strips.*
G	Samsara Paisley 13063M-07 <i>Cream</i>	2/3 yd	(3) 6-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut (15) 6-1/2" squares.
H	Samsara Allover 13062M-99 <i>Multi</i>	Collage 3/4 yd	(6) 3-7/8" x WOF strips. Subcut (60) 3-7/8" squares. Cut the squares across (1) diagonal to make (120) 3-7/8" triangles.
I	Samsara Daisy 13067M-12 <i>Black</i>	5/8 yd	(4) 4-1/4" x WOF strips. Subcut (30) 4-1/4" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (120) 4-1/4" triangles.
J	Samsara Floral T 13065M-19 <i>Dark Red</i>	rail 1/2 yd	(3) 3-7/8" x WOF strips. Subcut (30) 3-7/8" squares.


BLOCK ASSEMBLY PROJECT USES PRECISE 1/4" SEAMS. TEST YOUR SEAM ALLOWANCE BY CUTTING (2) 2-1/2" X 5" RECTANGLES. STITCH THEM TOGETHER ALONG THE 5" LENGTH. AT THE MIDPOINT, MEASURE ACROSS THE UNIT. IT SHOULD BE EXACTLY 4-1/2" WIDE. IF NOT, ADJUST YOUR SEAM ALLOWANCE AND REPEAT.

Note: The arrows in the figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components.

1. Place (1) D 3-7/8" square on top of (1) F 3-7/8" square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square. Sew 1/4" away from each side of the drawn diagonal line. Cut the (2) squares apart on the drawn diagonal line to make (2) half-square triangles. Trim the half-square triangles to measure 3-1/2" square to make (2) Unit 1 squares. Repeat to make (60) Unit 1 squares total.







2. Repeat **Step 1** and refer to the figure at right for fabric identification and placement to make (60) **Unit 2** squares.





3. Sew (1) **E** 4-1/4" triangle and (1) **F** 4-1/4" triangle together along short sides. Sew (1) **C** 3-7/8" triangle to the long side of the newly sewn triangle to make (1) 3-1/2" **Unit 3** square. Repeat to make (60) **Unit 3** squares total.



4. Repeat **Step 3** and refer to the diagrams below for fabric identification, placement and orientation to make (60) of each unit square for **Unit 4** through **Unit 6**.







5. Place (1) **B** 2" square on the bottom right corner of (1) **Unit 3** square, right sides together. Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner. Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle 1/4" away from the sewn seam to make (1) **Unit 7** square. Repeat to make (60) **Unit 7** squares total.






6. Repeat **Step 5** and refer to the diagrams for fabric identification, placement, seam direction and orientation to make (60) **Unit 8** squares, (60) **Unit 9** squares and (60) **Unit 10** squares.







7. Sew (1) **Unit 7** square to the left side of (1) **Unit 8** square to make (1) **Unit 11** rectangle. Repeat to make (60) **Unit 11** rectangles total.




8. Sew (1) **Unit 9** square to the left side of (1) **Unit 10** square to make (1) **Unit 12** rectangle. Repeat to make (60) **Unit 12** rectangles total.



9. Sew (1) Unit 1 square to each end of (1) Unit 11 rectangle to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) Unit 11 strip to each side of (1) A 6-1/2" square to make the middle row. Sew together the (3) rows lengthwise to make (1) 12-1/2" Block One square. Repeat to make (15) Block One squares total.




10. Sew (1) Unit 2 square to each end of (1) Unit 12 rectangle to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) Unit 12 strip to each side of (1) G 6-1/2" square to make the middle row. Sew together the (3) rows lengthwise to make (1) 12-1/2" Block Two square. Repeat to make (15) Block Two squares total.



QUILT ASSEMBLY

- **11.** Sew together (3) **Block One** squares and (2) **Block Two** squares, alternating them from left to right, to make **Row One**. Repeat to make **Row Three** and **Row Five**.
- **12.** Sew together (3) **Block Two** squares and (2) **Block One** squares, alternating them from left to right, to make **Row Two**. Repeat to make **Row Four** and **Row Six**.
- **13.** Sew together the (6) **Rows** from **Steps 11-12**, lengthwise and in numerical order from the top to bottom, to make the 60-1/2" x 72-1/2" **Center Block**.



BORDER ASSEMBLY MEASURE WIDTH AND LENGTH OF THE QUILT TOP TO ENSURE F, C AND A BORDER SIZES, BELOW ARE OUR CUTTING SIZES.

14. Sew (1) **F** 2" x 72-1/2" strip to each side of the **Center Block**. Sew (1) **F** 2" x 63-1/2" strip to the top and to the bottom of the **Center Block**.


15. Sew (1) **C** 2" x 75-1/2" strip to each side of the **Center Block**. Sew (1) **C** 2" x 66-1/2" strip to the top and to the bottom of the **Center Block**.

16. Sew (1) **A** 6-1/2" x 78-1/2" strip to each side of the **Center Block**. Sew (1) **A** 6-1/2" x 78-1/2" strip to the top and to the bottom of the **Center Block** to make the quilt top.

FINISHING Cut batting and backing 3" larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind as usual.
