Materials, White Version

Y3421-1	White Terrarium Panel	$\frac{3}{8}$ yd
Y3423-100	Lt Turquoise Forest Floor	$\frac{1}{2}$ yd
Y3422-1	White Forest Animals	$\frac{3}{8}$ yd
Y3425-104	Teal Succulents	$\frac{3}{8}$ yd
	<i>Backing of your choice</i>	1 $\frac{3}{8}$ yds

Materials, Lt Olive Version

Y3421-23	Lt Olive Terrarium Panel	$\frac{3}{8}$ yd
Y3423-1	White Forest Floor	$\frac{1}{2}$ yd
Y3422-23	Lt Olive Forest Animals	$\frac{3}{8}$ yd
Y3425-68	Gold Succulents	$\frac{3}{8}$ yd
	<i>Backing of your choice</i>	1 $\frac{3}{8}$ yds

Cut the Fabrics

From **Panel**:

Centering the design, trim panel to measure 23 $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 40" to prevent piecing the borders.

From **Forest Floor** cut:

(4) strips 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF

From **Forest Animals** cut:

(4) strips 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF

From **Succulents** cut:

(5) strips 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF

Things to Know

- Please note some fabrics are directional
- **WOF**= width of fabric
- **LOF**= length of fabric
- **RST**= right sides together
- Sew all seams at $\frac{1}{4}$ "
- Always press seams toward darker fabric

Instructions

1. Measure the length of the **Panel**. Select two of the **Forest Floor** inner border strips. Trim these to the measured length. Sew one of these strips to each side of the center panel. Press. Measure the panel unit from side to side. Trim the remaining strips to this measurement. Sew these strips to the top and bottom edges of the center panel. Press.
2. Select the **Forest Animals** 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips. As in the previous step, measure the center panel unit length. From outer border fabric, cut two borders for the left and right sides of the quilt. Stitch and press. Measure the center panel unit width. From the remaining border fabric, cut two more borders to measure. Add these to the top and bottom edges of the quilt. Press.
3. Select the (5) **Succulents** 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " binding strips. Sew these strips end to end using a diagonal seam to reduce the bulk. Press seams open. Press & fold the binding lengthwise.
4. Layer backing, batting and quilt top and quilt as desired. Bind.
