

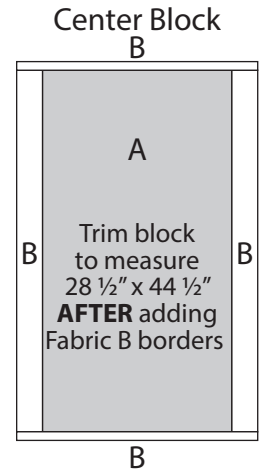
SAMPLE	KEY/SKU	QTY	CUT	CUT PIECES VIA WOF
	A Spring Hill Farm Panel 13244-99 Grey/Multi	1 panel	Fussy cut (1) 22-1/2" x 42-1/2" panel.	
	B Wallpaper Medallion 13250-13 Grey	1 yd	(2) 4" x 42-1/2" WOF strips, piece as needed. (2) 2" x 29-1/2" WOF strips. (3) 2-1/2" x WOF strips.* (2) 2-1/2" x 40-1/2" WOF strips.	
	C Dot Diamond 13253-11 Grey/White	5/8 yd	(12) 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (320) 1-1/2" squares.	
	D Grid Plaid 13252-45 Dark Green	1/3 yd	(3) 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (40) 2-1/2" squares.	
	E Block Print Stripe 13251-10 Red	1/3 yd	(3) 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (40) 2-1/2" squares.	
	F Spring Hill Farm Sunflower 13248-08 Light Grey	1/3 yd	(3) 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (40) 2-1/2" squares.	
	G Block Print Stripe 13251-33 Yellow	1/3 yd	(3) 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (40) 2-1/2" squares.	
	H Spring Hill Farm Animals 13246-04 Light Mint	1-2/3 yds	(2) 4-1/2" x 56-1/2" LOF strips. From the remaining fabric, cut (2) 4-1/2" x 48-1/2" WOF strips, piece as needed.	
	I Grid Plaid 13252-14 Dark Grey	1/2 yd	(6) 2-1/2" x WOF strips, BINDING.	

* SEW STRIPS VIA SHORT ENDS THEN GO TO BORDER ASSEMBLY
WOF/LOF=WIDTH/LENGTH OF FABRIC

BLOCK ASSEMBLY *PROJECT USES PRECISE 1/4" SEAMS. TEST YOUR SEAM ALLOWANCE BY CUTTING (2) 2-1/2" X 5" RECTANGLES. STITCH THEM TOGETHER ALONG THE 5" LENGTH. AT THE MIDPOINT, MEASURE ACROSS THE UNIT. IT SHOULD BE EXACTLY 4-1/2" WIDE. IF NOT, ADJUST YOUR SEAM ALLOWANCE AND REPEAT.*

Note: The arrows in diagrams represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components.

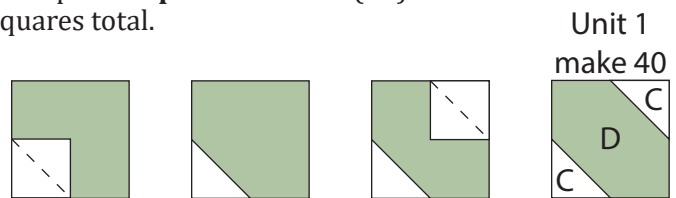
1. Sew (1) **B** 4" x 42-1/2" strip to each side of the **A** 22-1/2" x 42-1/2" rectangle. Sew (1) **B** 2" x 29-1/2" strip to the top and to the bottom of the **A** rectangle to make the **Center Block**. **Trim the block to measure 28-1/2" x 44-1/2"**.



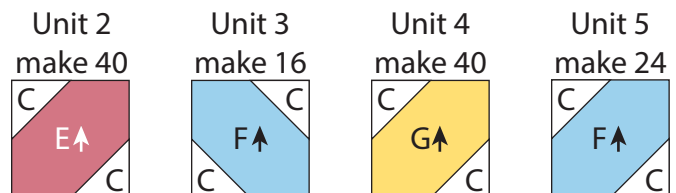
2. Place (1) **C** 1-1/2" square on the bottom left corner of (1) **D** 2-1/2" square, right sides together. Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner. Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle 1/4" away from the sewn seam.

3. Follow the diagram below for the seam direction to add a **C** 1-1/2" square to the upper right corner of the **D** 2-1/2" square to make (1) **Unit 1** square.

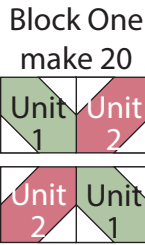
4. Repeat **Steps 2-3** to make (40) **Unit 1** squares total.



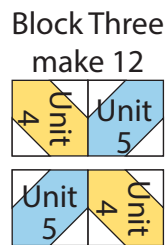
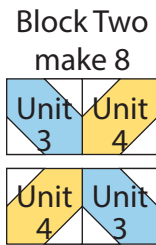
5. Repeat **Steps 2-3** and refer to the diagrams to make (40) **Unit 2** squares, (16) **Unit 3** squares, (40) **Unit 4** squares and (24) **Unit 5** squares.



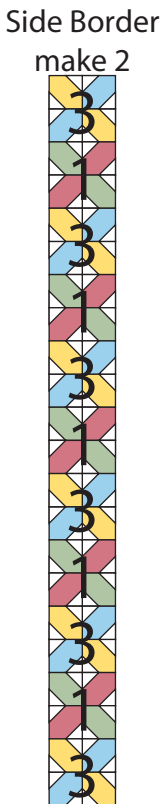
6. Sew (1) **Unit 1** square to the left side of (1) **Unit 2** square to make the top row. Sew (1) **Unit 2** square to the left side of (1) **Unit 1** square to make the bottom row. Sew together the (2) rows lengthwise to make (1) 4-1/2" **Block One** square. Repeat to make (20) **Block One** squares total.



7. Repeat **Step 6** and refer to the diagrams below to make (8) **Block Two** squares and (12) **Block Three** squares.



8. Sew together (6) **Block Three** squares and (5) **Block One** squares, alternating them from the top to the bottom, to make (1) **Side Border**. Repeat to make a second **Side Border**.



9. Sew together (5) **Block One** squares and (4) **Block Two** squares, alternating them from left to right, to make the **Top Border**. Repeat to make the **Bottom Border**.



QUILT ASSEMBLY

10. Sew (1) **Side Border** to each side of the **Center Block**.

11. Sew the **Top Border** and the **Bottom Border** to the top and to the bottom of the **Center Block**.

BORDER ASSEMBLY *MEASURE WIDTH AND LENGTH OF THE QUILT TOP TO ENSURE E, C AND I BORDER SIZES, BELOW ARE OUR CUTTING SIZES.*

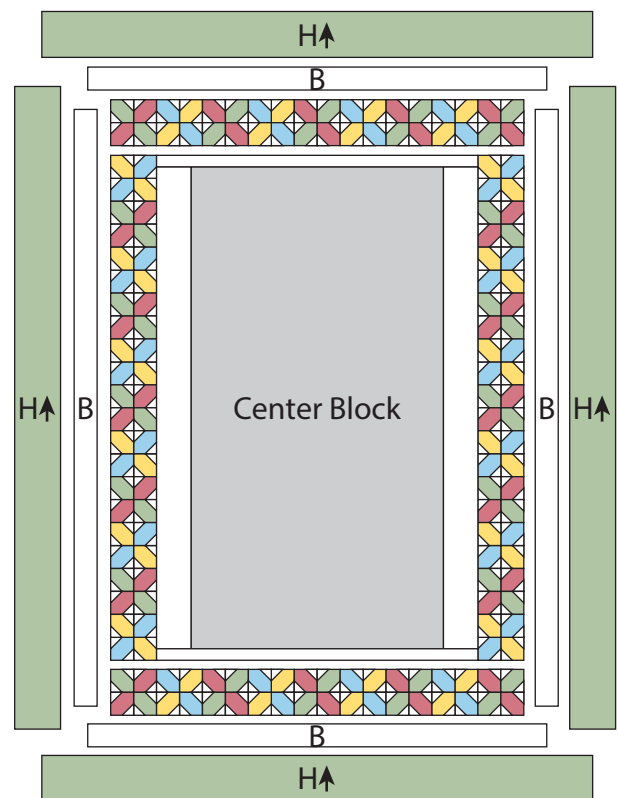
12. Sew (1) **B** 2-1/2" x (52-1/2") strip to each side of the **Center Block**. Sew (1) **B** 2-1/2" x (40-1/2") strip to the top and to the bottom of the **Center Block**.

13. Sew (1) **H** 4-1/2" x (56-1/2") strip to each side of the **Center Block**. Sew (1) **H** 4-1/2" x (48-1/2") to the top and to the bottom of the **Center Block** to make the quilt top.

FINISHING Cut batting and backing 3" larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind as usual.

FINISHED SIZE: 48" x 64"
