


BH4 Block 22 - Star Patch

Color/shading options.

Piecing & Cutting Notes:

- To trim the QSTs to size, add ¼" to the B-C-D squares. Trim to the size of the A squares.
- Sherri recommends cutting the B-C-D squares at $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " or 3" x 3", and trimming them to size after piecing - to 31/2" x 31/2" or 2" x 2".

Cutting Instructions:

9" Finished Block:

- A (4) squares 31/2" x 31/2"
- B (2) squares 41/4" x 41/4"
- C (1) square 41/4" x 41/4"
- D (1) square 41/4" x 41/4"
- E (5) squares 11/2" x 11/2"
- F (4) squares 1½" x 1½"
- G (4) squares 2½" x 2½"

41/2" Finished Block:


- A (4) squares 2" x 2"
- B- (2) squares 23/4" x 23/4"
- C (1) square 23/4" x 23/4"
- D (1) square 23/4" x 23/4"
- E (5) squares 1" x 1"
- F (4) squares 1" x 1"
- G (4) squares 1½" x 1½"

All seams are a scant ¼" unless specified otherwise.

Assembly

1. With right sides together, align one B square to a C square, and one B square to an D square. Stitch a scant ¼" on both sides of the line. Cut the square apart on the drawn line. Trim seam to 1/4" and press the seam to the darker triangle.

The HSTs will measure 3%" x 3%" or 2%" x 2%".





2. On the wrong side of the two B/D HSTs, draw a line from one corner to the opposing corner. Align one B/D to one B/C with the B triangles on opposite sides - B to D and B to C.

Stitch a scant ¼" on both sides of the line. Cut the square apart on the line. Trim seam to ¼" and press the seam to one side.

The QSTs will measure 3½" x 3½" or 2" x 2".

3. Join the (5) E squares and (4) F squares to make a nine-patch. Press the seams in the direction of the arrows.












4. On the wrong side of the remaining (4) E squares, draw a line from one corner to the opposing corner. With right sides together, align one E square in the corner of an A square as shown. Stitch on the line. Trim seam to 1/4" and press the seam to the triangle.




5. Lay out the pieces as shown.



6. Join the units to make three rows. Press the seams in the direction of the arrows - or press them open.



- 6. Join the rows to complete the block. Press the seams in the direction of the arrows - or press them open.
 - 9" block block will measure 91/2" x 91/2".
 - 4½" block block will measure 5" x 5".
