FINISHED QUILT SIZE: 67½" × 67½"

- Measurements include ¼" seam allowance.
- Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated.

The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric.

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

2 – Strength in Pink 5" Stackers (5-12620-42)

1% yards Dark Pink Ribbons (C12450) includes binding

1% yards Blush Floral (C12623)

1⅓ yards All the Pink Blossom (C730)

½ yard Dark Pink Gingham (C12624)

CUTTING REQUIREMENTS

- Please read instructions before cutting fabrics.
- Label pieces as you cut.

Strength In Pink Stackers

Separate prints on white backgrounds (WBK) from all other prints with colored backgrounds (DBK).

From WBK squares cut 16- 2¾" squares. Ε

From DBK squares cut:

 $2-5" \times 2\%"$ rectangles J

4- 2¾" squares

Select 2 pairs of matching DBK squares and cut:

2-2¾" squares from each pair.

Keep together as a set. Н



Dark Pink Ribbons

Cut 3 strips 5" × WOF; subcut:

2-5" × 14" rectangles Α $4-5" \times 7\%"$ rectangles 2-5" squares C Cut 7 strips 2¾" × WOF. Q

From 1 strip cut 4- 2¾" squares. D

Cut 7 strips 2½" × WOF for binding.

Cut 7 strips 5" × WOF.

All the Pink Blossom

Cut 4 strips 5" × WOF; from *each* strip subcut:

1- 5" × 23" rectangle	N
1-5" × 14" rectangle	M
1-5" square	K

Dark Pink Gingham

Cut 6 strips 2¾" × WOF.

Sew strips end-to-end; subcut:

4- 2¾" × 27½" strips	Р

QUILT ASSEMBLY

- Refer to the Cutting Requirements list, quilt photo and Quilt Layout Diagram for the placement of prints.
- Follow pressing arrows as shown.
- Orient the pieces according to their pertinent diagrams. Doing so is essential to following relational instructions such as top, bottom, left, right and so on.
- All angled pieces are constructed using the Stitch & Flip method. This method is described here and referenced throughout the pattern.

Stitch & Flip Method (S&F)

Place the 2 pieces right sides together matching the raw edges in the corner to be replaced. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the top piece across the corner. Sew on the drawn line. Trim the seam allowance above the sewn line to ¼". Flip the top piece away from the bottom piece and press. The original corner has been replaced.



Heart Block A

1. Using the S&F method, replace the top 2 corners of rectangle B with E squares to make Unit 1. Make 2.



2. Sew together 2 Units 1 side-to-side to make Heart Row 1 $(14" \times 5")$.



3. Using the S&F method, replace the 2 bottom corners of rectangle A with E squares to make Heart Row 2.



Heart Row 2

- 4. Using the S&F method, replace the 2 bottom corners of square C with E squares to make Heart Square A.
- 5. Using the S&F method, replace 1 corner of a WBK square with a D square to make Heart Square B. Make 2.




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


6. Sew together side-to-side in a row as shown, Heart Squares B + A + B to make Heart Row 3 (14" \times 5").




7. Sew together from top to bottom, Heart Row 1 + 2 + 3 to make the Center Heart $(14" \times 14")$.




8. Sew together side-to-side, 5- Stacker squares (WBK & DBK) to make Scrappy Border A $(23" \times 5")$. Make 2.



9. Sew together top-to-bottom, 3- Stacker squares (WBK & DBK) to make Scrappy Border B (5" \times 14"). Make 2.




10. Sew a Scrappy Border B to either side of the Center Heart (23" \times 14"). Sew a Scrappy Border A to the top, another to the bottom to make a Scrappy Framed Heart (23" \times 23").

11. Sew a strip F to each side of the Scrappy Framed Heart $(27\%" \times 23")$. Sew a strip G to the top and the bottom to complete Heart Block A $(27\%" \times 27\%")$. Make 2 Heart Blocks A.

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Heart Block B

1. Using the S&F method and a matching set of H squares, replace a corner of square H with an I square. Since the squares are identical you will end up with a Half-Square Triangle (HST). Make 2. Sew the 2 HSTs together side-to-side as shown to make Unit 2.





2. Sew rectangle J to the bottom of Heart Unit 2 to make Unit 3 (5" \times 5").

3. Using the S&F method, replace a corner of a DBK square with square I to make Unit 4. Make 4.

Using the S&F method, replace a corner of square K with an L square to make Unit 5. Make 2.





4. Using the S&F method, replace the bottom corners of a DBK square with 2 I squares to make Unit 6.





5. Sew together side-to-side, Units 4 + 3 + 4 as shown to make Heart Row 1 ($14'' \times 5''$).




6. Sew together side-to-side, Unit 4 + stacker square + Unit 4 to make Heart Row 2 (14" × 5").




7. Sew together side-to-side, Units 5 + 6 + 5 to make Heart Row 3 (14" \times 5").



8. Sew together from top to bottom while nesting seams, Heart Rows 1 + 2 + 3 to make a Heart Center ($14" \times 14"$).




9. Sew a rectangle M to either side of the Heart Center (23" \times 14"). Sew a rectangle N to the top, another to the bottom of the Heart Center to make a Framed Heart



Framed Heart

10. Sew a strip O to each side of the Framed Heart (27½" \times 23"). Sew a strip P to the top, another to the bottom to complete Heart Block B (27½" \times 27½"). Make 2 Heart Blocks B.



Heart Block B

Cut 2 more strips 27%" in length and sew one to the top, the other to the bottom to complete Heart Block B (27%" × 27%"). Make 2 Heart Blocks B.

Quilt Center

- 1. Referring to the Quilt Layout Diagram, arrange Heart Blocks A & B into a 2 x 2 setting as shown.
- 2. Sew blocks together side-to-side into rows.
- 3. Sew rows together nesting seams as you go to complete the Quilt Center (54%" × 54%").

Inner Border

- 1. Sew together end-to-end 3 WOF strips Q. From this strip cut 2 strips 54%" in length. Sew one to each side of the Quilt Center (59" × 54%").
- 2. Repeat Step 1. Cut 2 strips, 59" in length. Sew one to the top, the other to the bottom of the Quilt Center. (59" \times 59").

Outer Border

- 1. Sew together 3 R strips end-to-end. Cut 2 strips 59" in length. Sew one to each side of the quilt top (68" × 59").
- 2. Repeat Step 1 using 2 R strips and cutting 1 strip to 68" in length. Make 2 68" strips. Sew one to the top, the other to the bottom of the quilt top. The quilt now measures $68" \times 68"$.

FINISHING

Finish quilt by layering the quilt top, batting, and backing. Bind with 2½" Dark Pink Ribbons strips.
