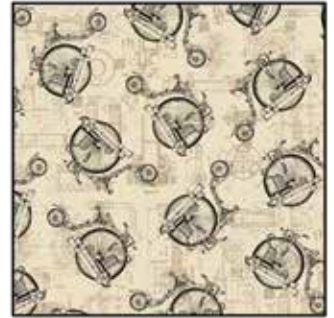

1/2 yard	Gears - Black (C)	2318-99
1/2 yard	Octopus & Gears - Rust (D)	2323-85
1/8 yard	Tonal Gears - Brass (E)	2326-44
1 1/8 yards	Urban Legend - Gray (F)	7101-90
3/8 yard	Keys - Parchment (G)	2320-41
2 3/4 yards	Hot Air Balloons - Parchment (H)	2325-41
1 1/8 yards	Nautical Elements - Gray (I)	2324-90
1 3/4 yards	Urban Legend - Charcoal (J)	7101-99*
7 1/8 yards	Bicycles - Parchment (Backing)	2321-41

### Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

#### From the Hats & Scissors - Parchment (A), cut:

- (2) 8 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 8 1/2" squares.

#### From the Butterflies & Flowers - Black (B), cut:

- (2) 6 1/2" x WOF strips.

#### From the Gears - Black (C), cut:

- (2) 6 1/2" x WOF strips.

#### From the Octopus & Gears - Rust (D), cut:

- (3) 4 1/2" x WOF strips.

#### From the Tonal Gears - Brass (E), cut:

- (1) 2 1/2" x WOF strip.

#### From the Urban Legend - Gray (F), cut:

- (2) 3 1/2" x WOF strips.
- (6) 2 1/2" x WOF strips.
- (8) 1 1/2" x WOF strips.

#### From the Keys - Parchment (G), cut:

- (1) 8 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 8 1/2" squares.

#### From the Hot Air Balloons - Parchment (H), cut:

- (3) 7 1/2" x 92 1/2" Length of Fabric (LOF) strips.

#### From the Nautical Elements - Gray (I), cut:

- (5) 7 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 7 1/2" x 92 1/2" strips.

#### From the Urban Legend - Charcoal (J), cut:

- (23) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (10) 1 1/2" x 92 1/2" strips.
- (9) 2 1/2" x WOF strips for the binding.

#### From the Bicycles - Parchment (Backing), cut:

- (3) 85" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 85" x 100" back.

### Block Assembly

Note: The arrows figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a 1/4" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x WOF Fabric F strip to each side of (1) 6 1/2" x WOF Fabric B strip lengthwise to make (1) Strip Set 1 (Fig. 1). Repeat to make a second Strip Set 1.

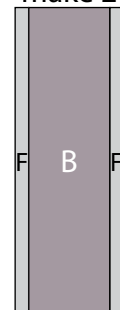

2. Cut the Strip Set 1's into (12) 8 1/2" x 6 1/2" Unit 1 rectangles (Fig. 2).

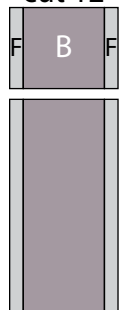

3. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x WOF Fabric F strip to each side of (1) 6 1/2" x WOF Fabric C strip lengthwise to make (1) Strip Set 2 (Fig. 3). Repeat to make a second Strip Set 2.

4. Cut the Strip Set 2's into (12) 8 1/2" x 6 1/2" Unit 2 rectangles (Fig. 4).

5. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x WOF Fabric F strip to each side of (1) 4 1/2" x WOF Fabric D strip lengthwise to make (1) Strip Set 3 (Fig. 5). Repeat to make (3) Strip Set 3's total.

6. Cut the Strip Set 3's into (24) 8 1/2" x 4 1/2" Unit 3 rectangles (Fig. 6).

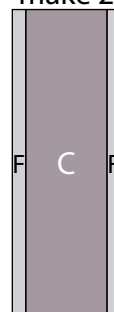

cut 12

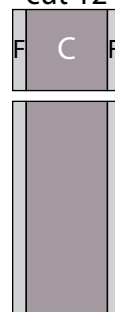

make 3

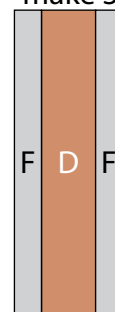

cut 24

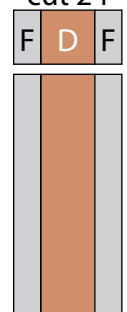

7. Sew (1) 3 1/2" x WOF Fabric F strip to each side of (1) 2 1/2" x WOF Fabric E strip lengthwise to make (1) Strip Set 4 (Fig. 7).

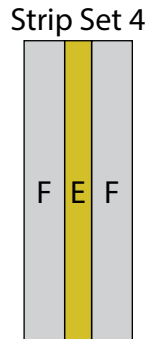

8. Cut the Strip Set 4 into (16) 8 1/2" x 2 1/2" Unit 4 strips (Fig. 8).

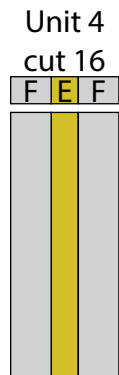

9. Sew (1) Unit 3 rectangle to the top of (1) Unit 1 rectangle to make (1) 8 1/2" x 10 1/2" Unit 5 rectangle (Fig. 9). Repeat to make (12) Unit 5 rectangles total.

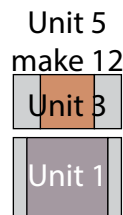

10. Sew (1) Unit 2 rectangle to the top of (1) Unit 3 rectangle to make (1) 8 1/2" x 10 1/2" Unit 6 rectangle (Fig. 10). Repeat to make (12) Unit 6 rectangles total.

11. Sew together (1) Unit 6 rectangle, (1) Unit 4 strip and (1) Unit 5 rectangle, in that order from top to bottom, to make (1) Unit 7 strip (Fig. 11). Repeat to make (8) Unit 7 strips total.

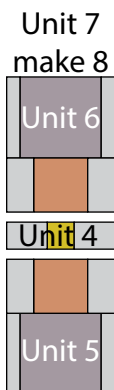

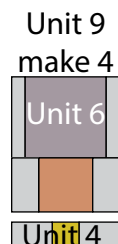

14. Follow Figure 14 and sew together (1) Unit 8 rectangle, (2) 8 1/2" Fabric A squares, (2) Unit 7 strips, (1) 8 1/2" Fabric G square and (1) Unit 9 rectangle to make (1) Block One column (Fig. 14). Repeat to make (4) Block One columns total.

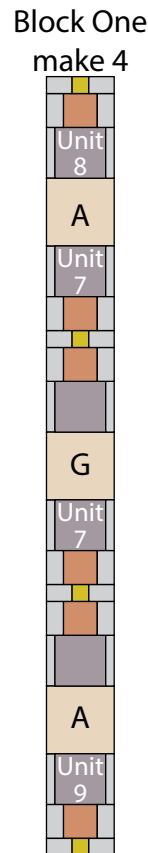

15. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 92 1/2" Fabric J strip to each side of (1) 7 1/2" x 92 1/2" Fabric H strip lengthwise to make (1) Block Two column (Fig. 15). Repeat to make (3) Block Two columns total.

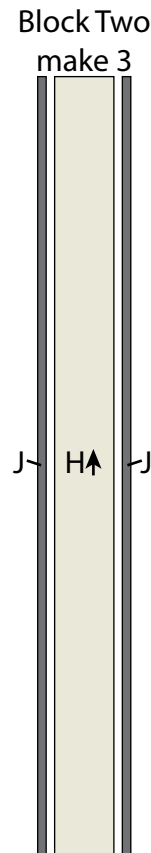

16. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 92 1/2" Fabric J strip to each side of (1) 7 1/2" x 92 1/2" Fabric I strip lengthwise to make (1) Block Three column (Fig. 16). Repeat to make a second Block Three column.

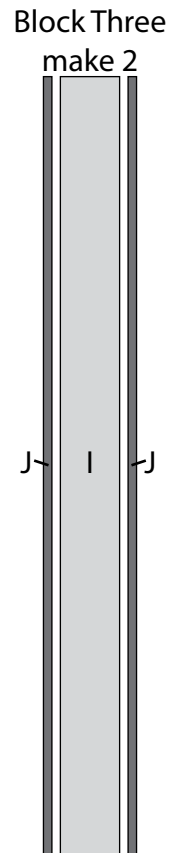

## Quilt 2

### Quilt Top Assembly

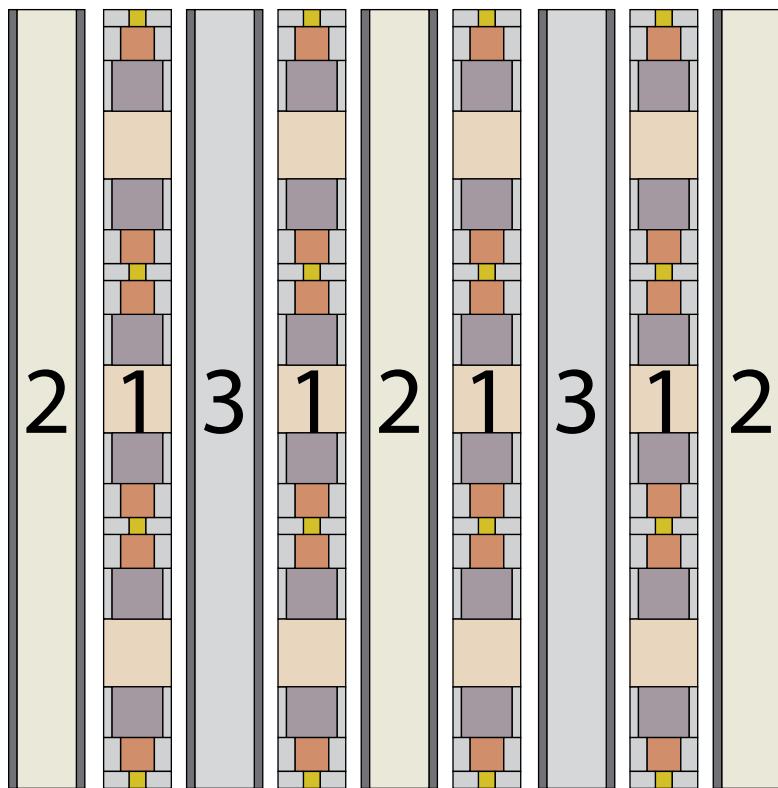
*(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)*

17. Sew together the (3) Block Two columns, (4) Block One columns and (2) Block Three columns as shown in the Quilt Layout to make the quilt top.

18. Layer and quilt as desired.

19. Sew the (9) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric J strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

20. Bind as desired.
