## **Cutting Instructions:**

Please read all instructions carefully before beginning. Strips are cut across the width of fabric (perpendicular to selvedges) unless otherwise stated. All seams are sewn with a 1/4" seam unless otherwise stated. Label all pieces. LOF = length of fabric.

#### From Fabric A:

- 1. Cut one 12 1/2" strip. Subcut twelve 1 1/2" x 10 1/2" and twelve 1 1/2" x 12 1/2" rectangles. (Pieced Block A)
- 2. Cut two 1 1/2" strips. Subcut two 1 1/2" x 36 1/2" strips. (Sashing Strips)
- Cut five 2 1/2" strips. Subcut two 2 1/2" x 40 1/2" from two strips. Piece remaining strips and subcut two 2 1/2" x 52 1/2" strips. (Inner Border)

#### From Fabric B:

1. Cut six 8 1/2" x 12 1/2" panel rectangles, centering designs. (Pieced Block A)

#### From Fabric C:

1. Cut two 16 1/2" x 16 1/2" squares, centering design. (Pieced Block B)

#### From Fabric D:

- 1. Cut three 1 1/2" strips. Subcut six 1 1/2" x 4 1/2" and six 1 1/2" x 8 1/2" rectangles. (Pieced Block A)
- 2. Cut two 1 1/2" strips. Subcut two 1 1/2" x 16 1/2" and two 1 1/2" x 18 1/2" rectangles. (Pieced Block B)

#### From Fabric E:

1. Cut three 1 1/2" strips. Subcut six 1 1/2" x 4 1/2" and six 1 1/2" x 8 1/2" rectangles. (Pieced Block A)

#### From Fabric F:

1. Cut six 4 3/4" strips. Piece strips and subcut two 4 3/4" x 49" and two 4 3/4" x 56 1/2" strips. (Outer Border)

#### From Fabric G:


- 1. Cut one 4 1/2" strip. Subcut twelve 1 1/2" x 4 1/2" and twelve 1 1/2" x 3 1/2" rectangles. (Pieced Block A)
- 2. Cut two 1 1/2" strip. Subcut two 1 1/2" x 16 1/2" and two 1 1/2" x 18 1/2" rectangles. (Pieced Block B)

#### From Fabric H:


- 1. Cut one 4 1/2" strip. Subcut twelve 1 1/2" x 4 1/2" and twelve 1 1/2" x 3 1/2" rectangles. (Pieced Block A)
- 2. Cut seven 2 1/4" strips. (Binding)

#### Piecing Instructions: Pieced Block A

1. Sew two 1 1/2" x 12 1/2" A rectangles to the opposite long sides of one 8 1/2" x 12 1/2" B rectangle. Sew two 1 1/2" x 10 1/2" A rectangles to the top and bottom of B rectangle. (Figure 1)



- 2. Sew two 1 1/2" x 3 1/2" Fabric 1 rectangles to the opposite short sides of one 1 1/2" x 8 1/2" Fabric 2 rectangle to make a pieced column. Make two pieced columns and sew to the opposite long sides of step 1 unit. (Figure 2)
- 3. Sew two 1 1/2" x 4 1/2" Fabric 1 rectangles to the opposite short sides of one 1 1/2" x 4 1/2" Fabric 2 rectangle to make a pieced row. Make two pieced rows and sew to the top and bottom of step 2 unit to complete one block A. Block measures 12 1/2" x 16 1/2" unfinished. (Figure 3)






#### Pieced Block B




Figure 5 18 1/2" x 18 1/2" unfinished.

- Sew one 1 1/2" x 16 1/2" D rectangle to the left, and one 1 1/2" x 16 1/2" G rectangle to the right of one 16 1/2" x 16 1/2" C elephant square. Sew one 1 1/2" x 18 1/2" D rectangle to the top and one 1 1/2" x 18 1/2" G rectangle to the bottom of the same square to complete one block. Block measures 18 1/2" x 18 1/2" unfinished. (Figure 5)
- 2. Reversing between Fabric D and Fabric G, repeat step 1 to make one zebra block. (Figure 6)

*Figure 6* 18 1/2" x 18 1/2" unfinished.


## Quilt Assembly:

Refer to Quilt Diagram.

- Refer to Quilt Diagram for block placement guide, arrange and sew three A blocks to make a pieced row. Make a total of two pieced rows.
- 2. Sew together two B blocks to make a pieced row.
- 3. Sew together pieced rows made in steps 1 and 2, alternating with two 1 1/2" x 36 1/2 A strips to complete quilt center.
- Inner border. Sew two 2 1/2" x 52 1/2" A strips to the opposite long sides of quilt center. Sew two 2 1/2" x 40 1/2" A strips to the top and bottom of quilt center.
- 5. Outer border. Sew two 4 3/4" x 56 1/2" F strips to the opposite long sides of quilt center. Sew two 4 3/4" x 49" F strips to the top and bottom of quilt center to complete quilt top.

### Finishing:

- 1. Prepare backing with one horizontal seam to measure 56" x 72" Press seam open.
- 2. Layer quilt top, batting, and backing. Baste layers together.
- 3. Quilt as desired.
- 4. Trim layers even with quilt top squaring corners.
- Join seven 2 1/4" H binding strips with diagonal seams. Press seams open. Attach binding using your favorite method
- 6. Make a label and sew to the back of the quilt.
