If you choose to embroider the panel prior to creating the wall hanging below is a list of suggested DMC floss colors from the Plumcute Designs<sup>™</sup> palette of colors

DMC 355 red DMC 356 medium pink

DMC 433 brown DMC 436 yellow DMC 730 dark green DMC 733 light green DMC 926 medium blue DMC 927 light blue

Creating your wall hanging...

Square up your panel so that it measures 36 X 42-inches

from R560407D tiny dots aqua cut 1½-inch strips to border panel

cut two strips 1½ X 42-inches and sew one to each side of your panel cut two strips 1½ X 38-inches and sew one to the top and one to the bottom of your panel

From R560405D tonal floral cream cut the following for your outer borders eight 3½ X 7¾ -inch rectangles for top and bottom borders eight 3½ X 9¾-inch rectangles for left and right side borders

From each of the following prints cut two 3½ -inch squares for your outer bordersR560408D sprigs greenR560406D diamondsR560407D tiny dots blushR560409D set dots dark roseR560409D set dots yellowR560410D tiny X's green

from R560404D berries blue cut four 3% -inch squares for your outer borders

Refer to finished project image as needed when assembling outer borders starting with the side borders sew alternating 3½ -inch squares to your 3½ X 9¾-inch rectangles to create two side borders each border will begin and end with a 3½ X 9¾-inch rectangle

Outer border continued...

sew your left border to the panel so that the green sprig square is at the top and the dark rose set dots square is at the bottom

sew your right border to the panel so that it is reversed from the left and the dark rose set dots are near the top and the green sprigs are at the bottom

for the top and bottom borders sew alternating 3½-inch squares to your 3½ X 7¾ -inch rectangles each of these borders will begin and end with a R560404D berries blue 3½ -inch square sew your top border to the panel so that the squares are in the order blue, pink, yellow, green, blue (left to right) sew your bottom border to the panel so that the squares are in the order blue, green, yellow, pink, blue (left to right)

gently press out any wrinkles from your project quilt & bind as desired...I used R560402D floral pink for my binding fabric
