Twin Quilt: 68-1/2" x 83-3/4"

## In Bloom

Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning. All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.

#### 1. Cut the following:

If using FAT CUTS, you may need to cut additional width-of-fabric strips.

Fabric A - Fussy cut 6 panels to 10-1/2" square

**Fabric B** - Referring to the quilt image, fussy cut strips, the length of fabric parallel to selvage: (2) 8-3/4" x 88" and (2) 8-3/4" x 73" multi-stripe borders

Fabric C - Cut (9) 2-1/2" strips (binding) Fussy cut (2) 5-1/2" squares with a flower centered

Fabric D - Cut (2) 5-1/2" strips, subcut (10) 5-1/2" squares

Fabric E - Cut (1) 3-1/2" strip, subcut (2) 3-1/2" squares Cut (10) 3" strips, subcut (44) 3" x 5-1/2" pieces and (44) 3" squares

Fabric F - Cut (1) 3-1/2" strip, subcut (2) 3-1/2" squares and (4) 3" squares

Fabric G - Cut (6) 3" strip, subcut (80) 3" squares and (4) 2-3/8" squares (then cut each in half diagonally twice for a total of 16 triangles) Cut (6) 2-1/2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 2-1/2" x 63-3/4" and (2) 2-1/2" x 52-5/8" borders

Cut (1) 1-1/4" strip, subcut (17) 1-1/4" squares

**Fabric H** - Cut (1) 3-1/2" strip, subcut (4) 3-1/2" squares and (2) 3" squares Cut (1) 3" strip, subcut (4) 3" x 5-1/2" pieces and (6) 3" squares

**Fabric I** - Cut (6) 1-3/4" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 1-3/4" x 61-1/4" and (2) 1-3/4" x 48-5/8" borders

> Note: Not all Fabric G 2-3/8" triangles and Fabric J 15-1/2" triangles are used.

Fabric J - Cut (2) 15-1/2" strips, subcut (3) 15-1/2" squares (then cut each in half diagonally twice for a total of 12 triangles) and (2) 8" squares (then cut each in half diagonally for a total of 4 triangles)

Fabric K - Cut (12) 1-1/4" strips, subcut (48) 1-1/4" x 10-1/2" sashing strips

#### 2. Piecing Order:

1. On the wrong side of all **Fabric H** 3-1/2" squares, draw a diagonal line from corner to corner. Draw 2 lines 1/4" on each side of first line.



Letters in italics indicate wrong side of fabric.

2. Arrange a marked **Fabric H** 3-1/2" square right sides together with a Fabric E 3-1/2" square aligning all edges. Stitch along the 2 outside lines. Cut along the center line. Press the 2 triangle sets open. Centering seam, trim each to 3" square. Make a total of 4 Unit 1a. In the same manner, make 4 Unit 1b with fabrics indicated.











Repeat 2 times for 4 units.



Draw a diagonal line across the wrong side of all Fabrics E, F, G, and H 3" squares.



4. Arrange a marked **Fabric G** 3" square on 1 end of a **Fabric E** 3" x 5-1/2" piece as shown. Stitch along the marked line. Trim seam allowance to 1/4". Press triangle out. Repeat on opposite end of the Fabric E piece. Make a total of 40 Unit 2a (3" x 5-1/2" unfinished).

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5. In the same manner, make 4 each Units 2b and 2c with fabrics indicated.



6. Sew 1 each Units 1a and 1b together as shown. Make a total of 4 Unit 3 (3" x 5-1/2" unfinished).




7. Arrange 1 Fabric D 5-1/2" square, 4 Unit 2a, and 4 Fabric E 3" squares in 3 rows. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 10 Block 1 (10-1/2" square unfinished).

8. Arrange 1 Fabric C 5-1/2" square and 2 each Units 2b, 2c, and 3 in 3 rows. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 2 Block 2 (10-1/2" square unfinished).



- 9. Refer to Quilt Layout (Page 4) for arrangement and placement of Fabric A panels, blocks, Fabric G cornerstones, Fabric J setting triangles, Fabric K sashing strips, and borders.
- 10. Arrange all blocks, Fabric A panels, Fabric G 1-1/4" square cornerstones, Fabric G 2-3/8" triangle cornerstones, Fabric J 8" corner setting triangles, Fabric K sashing strips, and Fabric J 15-1/2" edge setting triangles in 15 diagonal rows. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together completing quilt center (approximately 46-1/8" x 61-1/4" unfinished).
- 11. Sew **Fabric I** 1-3/4" x 61-1/4" borders to right and left sides of quilt. Add Fabric I 1-3/4" x 48-5/8" borders to top and bottom of quilt.

12. Sew **Fabric G** 2-1/2" x 63-3/4" borders to right and left sides of quilt. Add Fabric G 2-1/2" x 52-5/8" borders to top and bottom of quilt.

13. Center **Fabric B** 8-3/4" x 88" borders on right and left sides of quilt center and Fabric B 8-3/4" x 73" borders on top and bottom of quilt center, referring to guilt image for positioning of stripe. Stitch borders to sides starting and stopping 1/4" from corners of quilt center.

Do not trim. Press borders out.



14. Working with 1 corner at a time, fold the quilt right sides together so the outside edges of the borders line up. Using a 45-degree ruler, mark from the end of border seams to outer edges of borders. Stitch along marked line. Trim seam allowance to 1/4". Press corner seam open. Repeat on remaining corners.




- 15. The quilt measures approximately 69" x 84-1/4" (unfinished). Make backing (Fabric L) approximately 8" larger than the top.
- 16. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (Fabric C) and enjoy!!


