



*Fabric must be 42" wide.

Cutting Instructions:

Please read all instructions carefully before beginning. Strips are cut across the width of fabric (perpendicular to selvedges) unless otherwise stated. All seams are sewn with a 1/4" seam unless otherwise stated. Label all pieces.

From Background:

- 1. Cut three 4 1/2" strips. Subcut sixty 1 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles. (Sashing Rectangles)
- 2. Cut four 2 1/2" strips. Subcut two 2 1/2" x 29 1/2" and two 2 1/2" x 33 1/2" strips. (Outer Border)

From Fabric A:

- 1. Cut one 1 1/2" strip. Subcut twenty-five 1 1/2" squares. (Cornerstones)
- 2. Cut five 2 1/4" strips. (Binding)

From one 5" square package:

1. Sort and divide 5" squares into eighteen pairs each containing Fabric 1 (lighter) and Fabric 2 (darker). "Light" and "dark" are relative to each other - see Quilt Diagram. There will be six squares leftover.

Piecing Instructions: **Constructing Pieced Blocks**

1. Draw a diagonal line on Fabric 15" square from a fabric pair. Place square, right sides together, on Fabric 25" square. Sew 1/4" away from both sides of drawn line. Cut along drawn line to yield two Half-Square-Triangle (HST) units. Open and press. Align diagonal seam of HST units against 45-degree line of guilting ruler. Trim units to measure 4 1/2" x 4 1/2" unfinished. Make a total of thirty-six HST units. (Figure 1)

Quilt Assembly:

1. Pieced rows. Noting seam orientation of blocks in guilt image, arrange and sew six pieced blocks and five 1 1/2" x 4 1/2" Background rectangles to make a pieced row. Make a total of six pieced rows. Row 1 is shown in Figure 2.

2. Pieced sashing rows. Sew together six 1 1/2" x 4 1/2" Background rectangles and five 1 1/2" Fabric A squares to make a pieced sashing row. Make a total of five pieced sashing rows. (Figure 3)

- 3. Quilt center. Sew together pieced rows, alternating with pieced sashing rows, to complete quilt center. (Quilt Diagram)
- 4. Outer border. Sew two 2 1/2" x 29 1/2" Background strips to the opposite sides of auilt center, followed by two 2 1/2" x 33 1/2" Background strips to the remaining opposite sides of quilt center to complete quilt top. (Quilt Diagram)

Finishing:

1. Remove selvages from backing fabric and press well.

- 2. Layer quilt, batting, and backing. Baste layers together.
- 3. Quilt as desired.
- 4. Trim layers even with quilt top.
- 5. Join five 2 1/4" A binding strips with diagonal seams. Press seams open. Attach binding using your favorite method. Tip: Lav binding on the guilt before sewing to make sure that binding seams do not meet any of the corners.
- 6. Make a label and sew to the back of the auilt.
