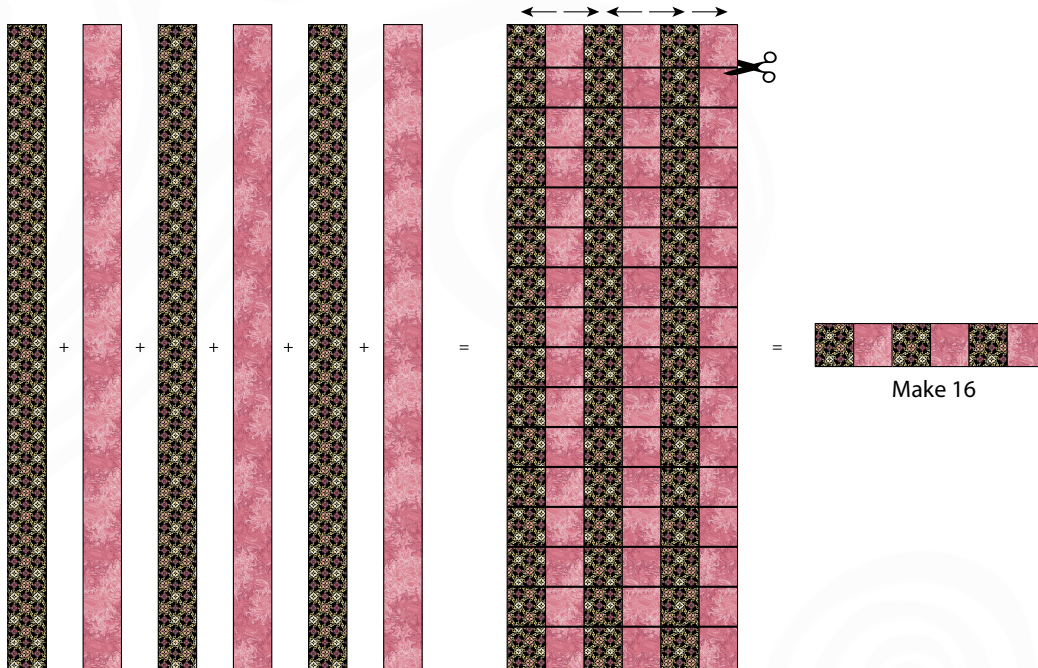


## Sewing

Sew with a scant  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance. Sew with right sides together (RST). Press seams as indicated by arrows.

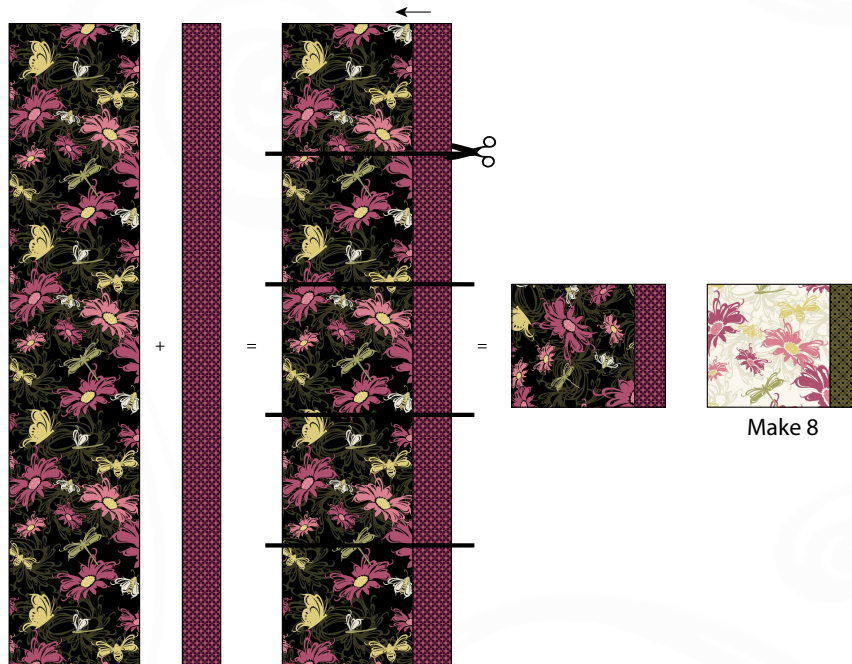
### Making the Block Sections

Alternate the 1723-22 and the 1724-99  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " strips, as shown. Pin and sew together. Square one end and cut 16,  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $12\frac{1}{2}$ " sections.



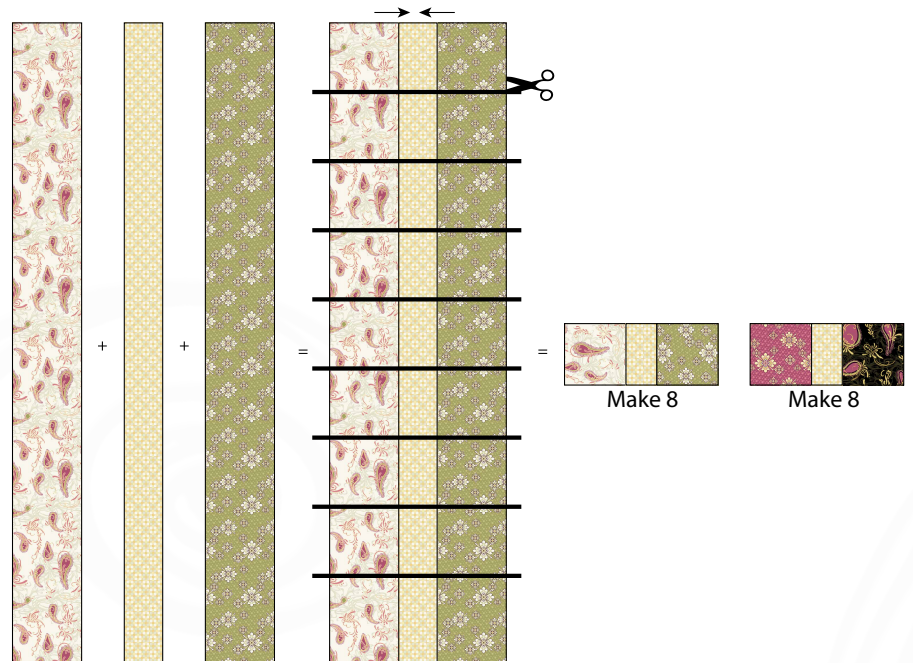
Place one  $8\frac{1}{2}$ " 1720-99 strip and one  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " 1725-22 strip, as shown. Pin and sew together. Square one end and cut four,  $8\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $10\frac{1}{2}$ " sections. Repeat using the remaining two strips for a total of eight.

Repeat with the  $8\frac{1}{2}$ " 1720-100, and  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " 1725-66 strips.



Place one 4 ½" 1721-100 strip, one 2 ½" 1725-44 strip, and one 4 ½" 1722-66 strip as shown. Pin and sew together. Square one end and cut eight, 4 ½" x 10 ½" sections.

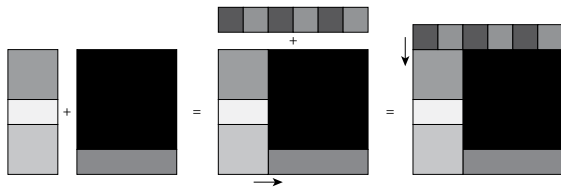
Repeat with the 4 ½" 1722-22, 2 ½" 1725-44, and 4 ½" 1721-99 strips.



### Making the Blocks

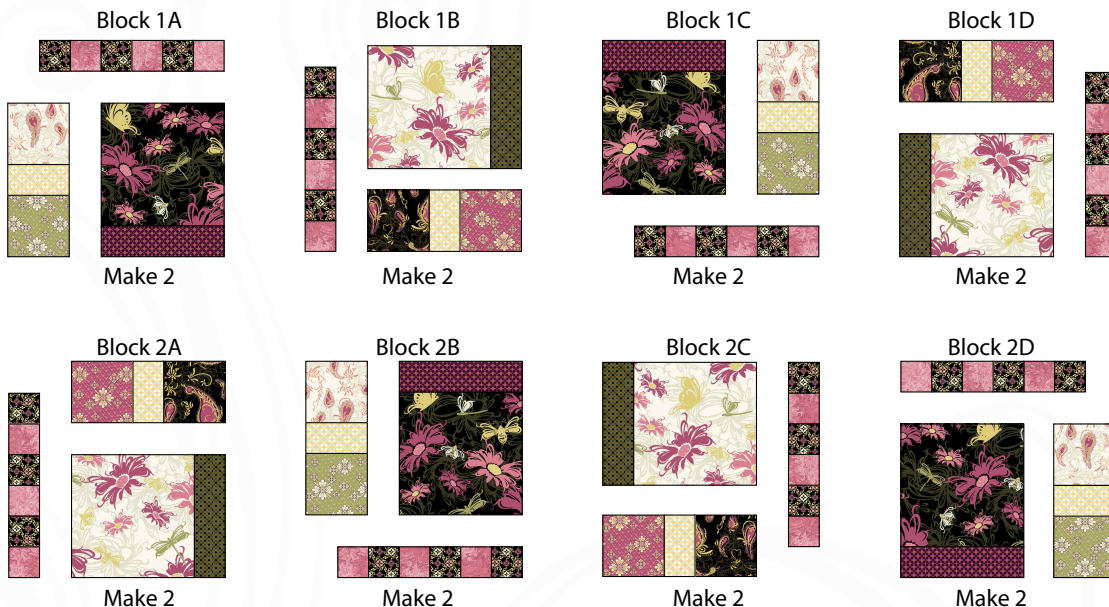
To piece each block, pin and sew the two larger sections together. Pin and sew the pieced strip to the end as shown for each block.

*Note: These are general instructions for piecing the block together.*



*Fabric placement is shown in the diagrams below.*

Arrange the sections made previously into eight 12 ½" x 12 ½" blocks as shown, making two of each arrangement. Label each block.

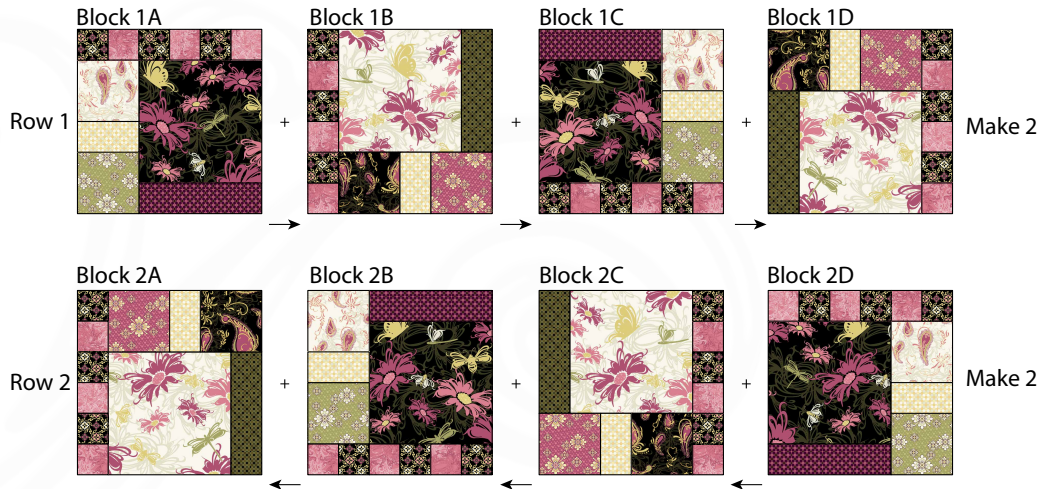




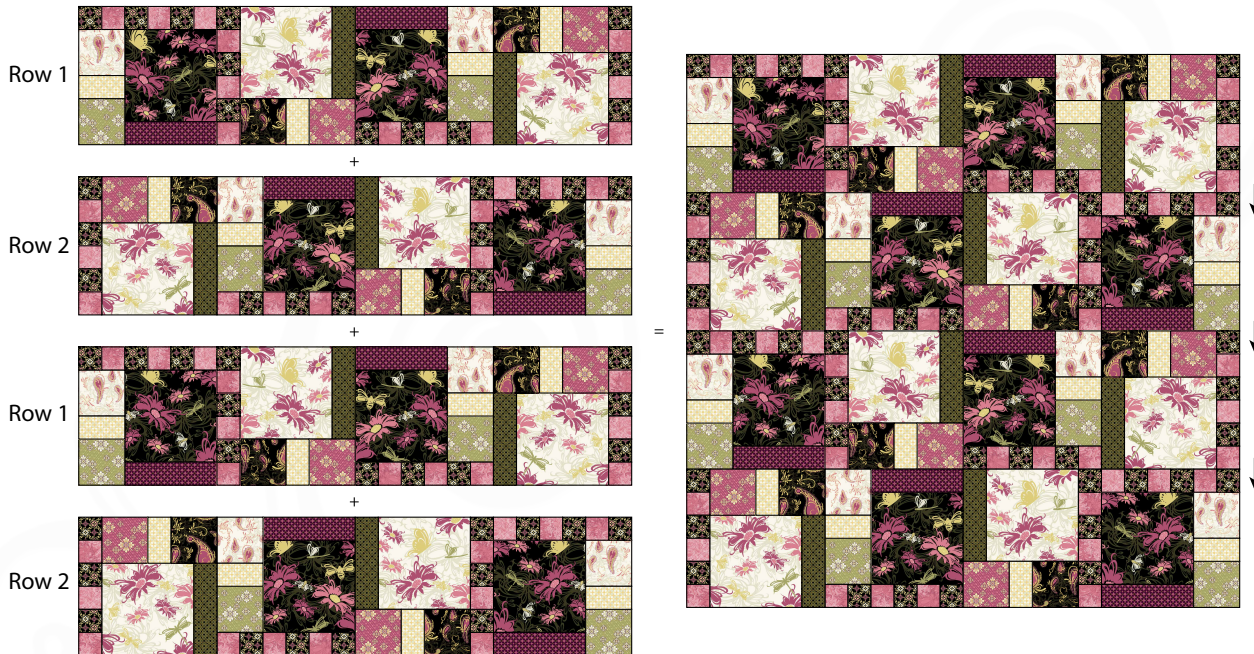


## Piecing the Quilt Top

The top will be put together in rows. Sew Blocks 1A-1D together in a row as shown. Repeat to make two rows. Repeat for the second row with blocks 2A-2D. Press seams in Row 1 in the opposite direction to Row 2.



Lay out the rows as shown below. Sew the rows together, nesting the seams. Press the seams in one direction.



## *Finishing*

### **Quilting**

Piece the backing by cutting the 3 ½" yards into two 40 ½" x 63" pieces (remove selvages). Sew together to make one piece approximately 80 ½" x 63".

Press back and front well. Layer backing (wrong side up), batting, and quilt top (wrong side down), and baste well. Either hand or machine quilt according to personal preference. Quilt in the ditch between the rows and along a grid, or use an overall free motion design. Trim excess batting and backing when quilting is complete.

### **Binding**

Use the five 2 ½" strips from Fabric 1720-99 for the binding. Cut the ends at a 45-degree angle and sew end to end to make one continuous piece of binding approximately 200 inches long. Fold in half lengthwise and press wrong sides together. Sew the binding to the front of the quilt, raw edges together; turn the folded edge to the back and hand stitch in place.
