Fabrics Needed and Cutting Instructions: BFF Collection by Tracy Lizotte for Elizabeth's Studio LLC

Fabric A
4300—Sepia
3/4 yard (one panel)



One panel—trim to 24-1/2" wide by 42-1/2" long

Fabric B 4301—Sepia 3/4 yard



Fussy cut (12) 7-1/4" squares of desired motifs

Fabric C 4302—Sepia 3/4 yard



Cut (four) 4" strips by WOF for outer side borders

"children playing outdoors" fabric

Fabric D 4303—Sepia 1/2 yard



Cut (two) 6" by 38-1/2" strips for top and bottom borders

"children playing indoors" fabric

Fabric E 231-Sepia 1-1/4 yard



Cut (four) 2-1/2" by WOF strips for inner borders AND (two) 2-1/2" X 38-1/2" strips for inner borders AND (seven) 2-1/2" strips for binding

Fabric F 4303-Brown 3/4 yard



Cut (seven) 2-1/2" by WOF strips for outer borders

Backing—(two) 2 yard cuts (total 5 yards) of your favorite fabric

Batting—twin size

Before you get started:

Remember to read through the directions before you begin to cut your fabrics.

You will be using a 1/4" seam allowance throughout the pattern.

WOF means width of fabric.

PIECING THE CENTER SECTION:

Begin with the center medallion panel (24-1/2" x 2-1/2"). Arrange the 7-1/2" fussy cut blocks as desired. Piece together, using 1/4" seam allowance, to form two rows of six blocks. Following the diagram below, add the rows to either side of the center medallion, then add (two) 2-1/2" x 38-1/2" brown dot strips to the top and bottom, and finally the (two) 6" x 38-1/2" strips of fabric #4303 (children playing indoors), to the top and bottom.



ADDING THE SIDE BORDERS:

Piece four of the 2-1/2" strips of brown dot fabric together, then cut two 2-1/2" by 57-1/2" strips. Repeat steps with four 2-1/2" strips of brown flower fabric, cutting two 57-1/2" strips of brown dot. Repeat with the four 4" x WOF strips of fabric #4302 (children playing outdoors), cutting into two 4" x 57-1/2" strips. See the diagram below for placement of the side borders.



Finally, using (three) 2-1/2" by WOF strips of brown flower fabric, piece as above and cut two strips 2-1/2" x 53-1/2". Add to the top and bottom to complete the quilt top.

Piece together the (two) 2 yard cuts of backing fabric to form back. Layer with batting, and quilt as desired.

Use the remaining 2-1/2" brown dot binding strips to bind the quilt.
