Fabric $B \quad 1 / 2$ yd $8249-77$ Blue Stars $\&$ Circles
Fabric $C \quad 1 / 2$ yd 8250-44 Cream Star Flower Toss
1 fat quarter of the following
8247-66 Green Stripe
8248-55 Brown Star Wreath
8249-66 Green Stars \& Circles
8068-62 Star Flower Basics
$1 / 8 \mathrm{yd}$ of the following:
8245-44, 71 Words \& Stars
8246-35, 55, 71 Swirly Stars
8247-35. 71 Stripe
8248-44. 71 Star Wreath
8249-88 Stars \& Circles
8250-33, 38 Star Flower Toss
8068-33, 46, 87 Star Flower Basics
$11 / 4 \mathrm{yd}$ Backing
Also needed: light weight fusible for appliqué
Recommended: $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ bias bars for stems

Note: Seam allowance is $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$. WOF = width of fabric. Please read through the instuctions before beginning the project.

## Cutting Requirements

Fabric A Red Words \& Stars
(4) $2 \frac{1}{2} \times$ WOF strips, pieced together end to end for binding
Fabric B Blue Stars \& Circles
(1) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 25 \frac{1}{2 \prime}$
(2) $21 / 1^{\prime \prime} \times 20 \frac{1}{2 \prime}$

(1) $2 \frac{1}{2 \prime} \times 15 \frac{1}{2 \prime}$
(2) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 3 \frac{1}{2 \prime}$

Fabric C Cream Star Flower Toss
(1) $16 \frac{1}{2 \prime} \times 16 \frac{1}{2 \prime}$ square for appliqué background

Appliqué (basic appliqué skills are required)
I. Transfer appliqué shapes to template plastic.
2. Follow manufacturer's instructions for fusible webbing. If you are using the needle-turn method, add a seam allowance to the shapes.
3. Trace (5) center pieces from assorted gold fabrics.
4. Trace (25) petal shapes from assorted red fabrics.

## Quilt Top Assembly

1. Sew three blocks together and join to the top of the appliqué block.

2. Sew four blocks together and join to the left side of the appliqué block.
3. Sew (10) assorted $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles into a strip. Sew a $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 20 \frac{1}{2}$ Blue Stars $\&$ Circles border strip to one side of the pieced strips. Make (3).

4. Sew to one to each side of the quilt top as shown:

5. Sew a $2 \frac{1}{2 \prime} \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Blue Stars $\varepsilon$ Circles rectangle to an assorted $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares. Make ( 2 ) end units

6. Join one of the end units to one end of the remaining (10) unit pieced strip.

7. Add a $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 25 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ Blue Stars $\varepsilon$ Circles strip to this unit. Note placement of end unit.
8. Now, sew one of the remaining blocks to the other end of the strip. Sew to the top of the quilt.
